ALL ITEMS IN RED ARE CRITICAL, AND WILL BE LAYED OUT ON DAY ONE AT WEYAND FIELD. ALL CRITICAL ITEMS MUST BE PACKED IN RUCKSACK OR EQUIVALENT. IF A STUDENT IS FOUND WITHOUT A CRITICAL ITEM, THEY WILL BE IMMEDIATELY RELEASED FROM THE COURSE. THE STUDENT'S SPONSOR WILL BE ALLOWED TO BRING THE MISSING ITEMS UNTIL COMPLETION OF THE CWSA. IF A STUDENT RECEIVES MISSING ITEMS, THEY WILL BE MOVED TO THE BOTTOM OF THE STANDBY LIST AND PERMITTED INTO THE COURSE PENDING AVAILABILITY. ALL ITEMS IN YELLOW ARE MANDATORY. THESE ITEMS WILL BE PACKED IN A DUFFEL BAG AND BE LAYED OUT UPON ARRIVAL TO CAMP LIGHTNING. IF A STUDENT IS FOUND WITHOUT ONE OF THESE ITEMS ON DAY

1, THEY WILL RECEIVE A MAJOR MINUS SPOT REPORT AND WILL NOT HAVE THE CHANCE TO RECEIVE THE ITEM FROM A SPONSOR. All critical items must be packed in the rucksack or equivalent. All mandatory and optional items must be packed in the duffel bag(s). No packing list items may be carried in civilian luggage.
