What is BOLT? BOLT is a CG's initiative to provide a top-notch integration experience for service members entering the 25th Infantry Division. **Each service member, regardless of rank or MOS, entering the 25th ID will attend BOLT the week following in-processing at Reception Company.** The goal of BOLT is to increase operational readiness, establish and uphold the Division's standards and discipline, embody the culture, and preserve the rich legacy of the Tropic Lighting Division.

Uniforms/equipment: (Daily uniform listed above for each day of the POI) All participants will need at least 1x set of APFU (short sleeves and shorts) and 1x set of OCPs. It is recommended that you have an additional set of "field" OCPs that are faded/worn for Day 2 and Day 3 of the BOLT POI. You will be issued a canteen prior to PT on Day 1, this will be the only authorized water source throughout BOLT. No other equipment is required.

Absence Requests: Attendance will be taken daily, and any unexcused absences will be reported to BDEs and DIV. If you need to be rescheduled/excused from BOLT for any reason, you will need approval from your BDE command team. Use your chain of command, or your sponsor, to let your BDE command team know if you need to be excused/rescheduled. If rescheduling, please provide a week you will be able to attend.
