SUBJECT: 25th Infantry Division (25ID) Policy Letter # 1 - Commander's Guidance for Change of Command and Change of Responsibility Ceremonies and Receptions

- 1. Applicability. This policy applies to all Soldiers in 25ID.
- 2. Policy. Receptions are to be modest and minimal. Any receptions hosted by commanders, command sergeants major, and first sergeants following their change of command or change of responsibility will consist of a cake and beverages only. These receptions will not exceed \$300 in cost. This will standardize receptions across the Division and keep the focus of each event on the ceremony and Soldiers within the unit.
- 3. Brigade and above ceremonies may have professionally printed programs, but commanders must keep the cost of these one-time-use items in mind.
- 4. Units will use the approved template in the enclosure for ceremonies below brigade level and will not have them professionally printed. The approved template is also located at https://armyeitaas.sharepoint-mil.us/sites/USARPAC-25ID/25ID%20SGS/Forms/AllItems.aspx. Changes to font and size are authorized. Exception to policy authorization is the 25ID Chief of Staff.

5. Proponent. The 25ID Secretary of the General Staff is the proponent for this policy. Questions should be directed to the Secretary of the General Staff at 808-787-2526.
