

25th ID Small Unit Ranger Tactics Program

1. Training provided by The Lightning Academy, HHBN, 25th ID, Schofield Barracks, Hawaii.

2. Description. The 25th ID Small Unit Ranger Tactics (SURT) program serves as a progressive physical and tactical preparation program designed to prepare 25th ID Soldiers to be successful during the Ranger Assessment Phase and Darby Phase of Ranger School. All graduations will occur at Lightning Academy on the last day of the course at 0930 unless otherwise posted on the Lightning Academy website, <https://home.army.mil/hawaii/index.php/25thID/lightning-academy>, or the Lightning Academy Facebook Page, <https://www.facebook.com/LightningAcademy25ID/>.

3. Eligibility. All 25th ID Soldiers attending Ranger School.

4. Prerequisites. Soldiers attending this course must meet all prerequisites listed under the Fort Benning Airborne and Ranger Training Brigade (ARTB) Website and volunteer to attend the Ranger Class date immediately following the SURT program.

5. Location/Time. Post Conference Room (PCR), Lightning Academy Classroom, or Schofield Barracks Tropic Lightning Museum NLT 1300 hours on day zero of each course. G3 Schools will push day zero location one week prior based on availability.

6. Administrative.

- a. Students attending the course will report to Post Conference Room (PCR), The Lightning Academy Classroom, or Schofield Barracks Tropic Lightning Museum NLT 1300 hours on day zero of each course.
- b. Uniform for reporting to day zero brief is ACU/OCPs with Ranger School packet complete, LA 100, and sponsor. **This is a resident course and sponsor attendance is mandatory.**
- c. Students must have their SRB and Ranger School Packet on hand when reporting on day one to confirm remaining time until DEROS. Students must have the full Ranger School Packing list found under the ARTB website in the Student Information folder on day one of the SURT program as well as the additional SURT TA-50 packing list.
- d. Students with a physical profile will not be allowed to enter the course.
- e. Each SURT class is aligned to graduate one week prior to the start of the next Ranger Class, which all graduating students will then be slotted to attend –there is no deferment to subsequent Ranger Classes.

7. Enrollment. Submit Student's name for inclusion into the SURT program by submitting an LA 100 and Ranger School Packet, complete, to 25th ID Schools NLT 5 days prior to day zero. Off-island students will submit the complete packet NLT 14 business days prior to day one.
