✓ Abandoned Vehicles (AVs):

• Question: Residents expressed concern that abandon vehicles on the streets in their communities were creating safety issues for families and reducing availability of limited on-street parking

Update 1:

U.S.ARN

 Since the conception of the DES abandoned vehicle task force, we have removed over 700 abandoned vehicles from our installations. Additionally, "Operation Cleansweep" occurred during 9-13 MAY which removed several hundred AVs from our installations. We anticipate removal of several hundred more in the next few months.

Abandoned Vehicle Removal Campaign.

- Community Involvement and Partnership: DES is informing the community on the AV problems on USAG-HI and providing tools and knowledge to the community on how to properly turn-in unwanted vehicles, as well as, proper vehicle registration for new arrivals.
- This is accomplished through our USAG-HI FB page. Several videos highlighting the AV issue within the community, vehicle disposal, and vehicle registration have been posted to the page during "Operation Cleansweep".





On-going Key Issues/Concerns

✓ Crime:

 Question: Several residents voiced concerns about crime, physical security of AMR (lack of gate guards and cameras, and unsecured walking gates, leading outside the community), lack of synchronization between law enforcement agencies (8th MP, Honolulu Police Department (HPD)), lack of communication regarding law enforcement / emergency service responses to incidents, etc.

Update 1:

Since the last town hall, residents should have seen more robust patrol presence in the AMR/ Red Hill communities. Further, we have increased our presence at selected gates during the hours of darkness. Although, we have heard from some community members who are unhappy about inconvenience caused by many the gates in the evening, we are confident that this presence will further deter crime. We want to reassure our community members that we do communicate frequently with our HPD partners and that any perceived lack of synchronization were isolated incidents.
