



Major General Joseph Ryan

Originally from New York, Major General Joseph Ryan graduated from the United States Military Academy in 1991 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Engineering Physics and was commissioned into the Infantry. He is married with three children.

He began active service at Fort Bragg, North Carolina and has served in the 1st Armored Division (Baumholder, Germany); the 75th Ranger Regiment; the 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault); the 82nd Airborne Division; Headquarters Department of the Army and in the 4th Infantry Division. Recently he served as the Chief of Staff of the XVIII Airborne Corps before assuming duties as the Deputy Chief of Staff, Operations - United States Forces-Afghanistan. Beginning in 2001, he commanded units at various levels in both Afghanistan and Iraq and has deployed globally throughout his career for operations and exercises. MG Ryan currently serves as the Commanding General of the 25th Infantry Division and U.S. Army Hawaii.

He is a graduate of the Infantry Officer's Basic and Advanced Courses, the Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas, the Joint and Combined Warfighting School, and the Army War College where he served as a Fellow at Columbia University in New York City.
