IF A STUDENT IS FOUND WITHOUT ONE OF THESE ITEMS ON DAY 1, THEY WILL RECEIVE A MAJOR MINUS SPOT REPORT AND WILL NOT HAVE THE CHANCE TO RECEIVE THE ITEM FROM A SPONSOR. All critical items must be packed in the rucksack or equivalent. All mandatory and optional items must be packed in the duffel bag(s). No packing list items may be carried in civilian luggage.
