MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: 25th Infantry Division and U.S. Army Hawaii Policy Letter #15 – Authorization to Wear the Jungle Tab

1. References:

- a. Army Regulation (AR) 670-1, Wear and Appearance of Army Uniforms and Insignia, dated 10 April 2015.
- b. Department of the Army Pamphlet (DA PAM) 670-1, Guide to Wear and Appearance of Army Uniforms and Insignia, dated 1 July 2015.

2. General. The 25th Infantry Division (ID) Jungle Operations Training Course (JOTC) is designed to train an infantry rifle company and its habitual attachments to operate effectively in a jungle environment with an emphasis on decentralized mission command and small unit operations. The 3-week course includes instruction on individual jungle skills, squad and platoon jungle tactics, and ends with a culminating company field training exercise.

3. Purpose. This policy will outline the wear of the Jungle Tab for the 25th ID and U.S. Army Hawaii (USARHAW) based units.

4. Applicability. This policy applies to all Soldiers assigned or attached to the 25th ID and USARHAW-based units.

5. The basic eligibility criteria for wear of the Jungle Tab is (must meet one of the below requirements):

- a. Successfully completes the JOTC conducted the U.S. Army Jungle School conducted at the JOTC on Oahu, Hawaii.
- b. Successfully completes a jungle course conducted by Jungle Operations Training Battalion in Panama, the Jungle Warfare Training Center on Oahu, or the RECONDO course on Oahu.

c. Represents the U.S. Army at a foreign jungle course recognized by the JOTC while assigned to the 25th ID.

6. Wear Policy.

a. The tab will be centered on the left shoulder pocket flap above the unit shoulder sleeve insignia. The tab will be positioned below the four Department of the Army skill tabs (President's Hundred, Special Forces, Ranger, and Sapper) in the order of precedence outlined in AR 670-1.

b. The Jungle Tab is a temporary tab and is authorized for wear within the state of Hawaii while assigned or attached to the 25th ID or USARHAW-based unit. Temporary tabs are an integral part of the shoulder sleeve insignia and Soldiers are not authorized to wear them when they are outside of the state of Hawaii or reassigned from the organization that prescribed wear of the should sleeve insignia with tab.
