Schofield Barracks death investigation underway

SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, Hawaii (Jan. 13, 2020) — The spouse of a Soldier was found deceased in on-post military housing, here, at approximately 8 a.m. today by Military Police conducting a welfare check requested by a family member.

Special Agents from the U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command (CID) are leading the ongoing investigation.

According to CID agents, at this point in the investigation they have reason to believe this is an isolated death and there is no cause for public alarm.

Out of respect to the family, the Army will not confirm or release the identity of the deceased until 24 hours after the next of kin have been notified.

No further details are available at this time in order to protect the integrity of the investigation.
