



SUBJECT: **TEMPORARY CLOSURE of Sergeant Elmelindo Rodrigues Smith Theatre**, Schofield Barracks **(SGT Smith Theater)**

Effective March 12th through October 31st 2018, the SGT Smith Theatre will be closed for renovation. Renovation contractor Anderson Burton, in conjunction with the United States Army Corps of Engineers, will assume control of the building during this time. The entirety of the building interior will be an active construction zone. Temporary closures of the pedestrian pathway in front of the theatre are also anticipated. Due to the hazards associated with construction activities, access to the building during this period can only be granted by Anderson Burton personnel. Anderson Burton will post appropriate signage during this period.



<u>Traffic Signal Installation at McCornack Rd. and Wainae Ave.</u>

26 February – April 20, 2018 8:00 am – 4:30 pm

There will be full road closures at the intersection of McCornack Rd. and Waianae Ave. for a traffic signal installation. The four legs of the intersection will be closed in 2 week durations from February 26, 2018, to April 20, 2018. The work will be performed in 4 Phases.

Phase 1 – will occupy the West side of the intersection along McCornack Rd from February 26th- March 9th Phase II - will occupy the South side of the intersection on Waianae Ave from March 12th – March 23rd Phase III - will occupy the East side of the intersection along McCornack Rd from April 9th – April 20th Phase IV - will occupy the North side of the intersection along Waianae Ave , from March 26th -April 6th

- Wildland Prescribed Fire Burn
 - Scheduled between April 23 and 06 May.
 - Location will be Schofield Barracks Range Complex
 - Start times will vary depending on weather conditions
 - End times will be approximately 1600 daily
 - Approximately 1500 acres will be burned during time allotted
- Prescribed fire burns allow for a safe and effective way to reduce fuels which
 increase the potential and severity of wildland fires. By reducing the fuel
 loading on the ranges, the chances of an uncontrollable wildland fire starting
 are significantly reduced, which allows for more productive and extensive
 training periods for Army units using the ranges.




