Suspicious Packages

- **BLUF:** Events over the last few weeks show it is plausible to carry out attacks using packages containing IEDs or chemicals against government or military targets. All personnel, and their Families need to exercise caution and be aware of the threat from suspicious packages. Because of these events, there is an increased need to raise awareness among the Army community on the handling of suspicious packages and precautionary steps to protect personnel and their Families.

(U) Indicators:

- Rigid or bulky
- Lopsided or uneven
- Wrapped in string
- Badly written or misspelled labels
- Generic or incorrect titles
- Excessive postage
- No postage
- Foreign writing, postage, or return address
- Missing, nonsensical, or unknown return address
- Leaks, stains, powders, or protruding materials
- Ticking, vibration, or other sound

(U) Recommended Actions:

- Leave the package or mail where it was found. Do not try to clean any substances. Do not disturb.
- Evacuate and isolate the area
- Wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water
- Keep personnel who were possibly exposed in a designated area
- List the names of persons in the immediate area
- If believed to be a chemical substance, shut off fans or HVAC systems
- Contact authorities and emergency services.

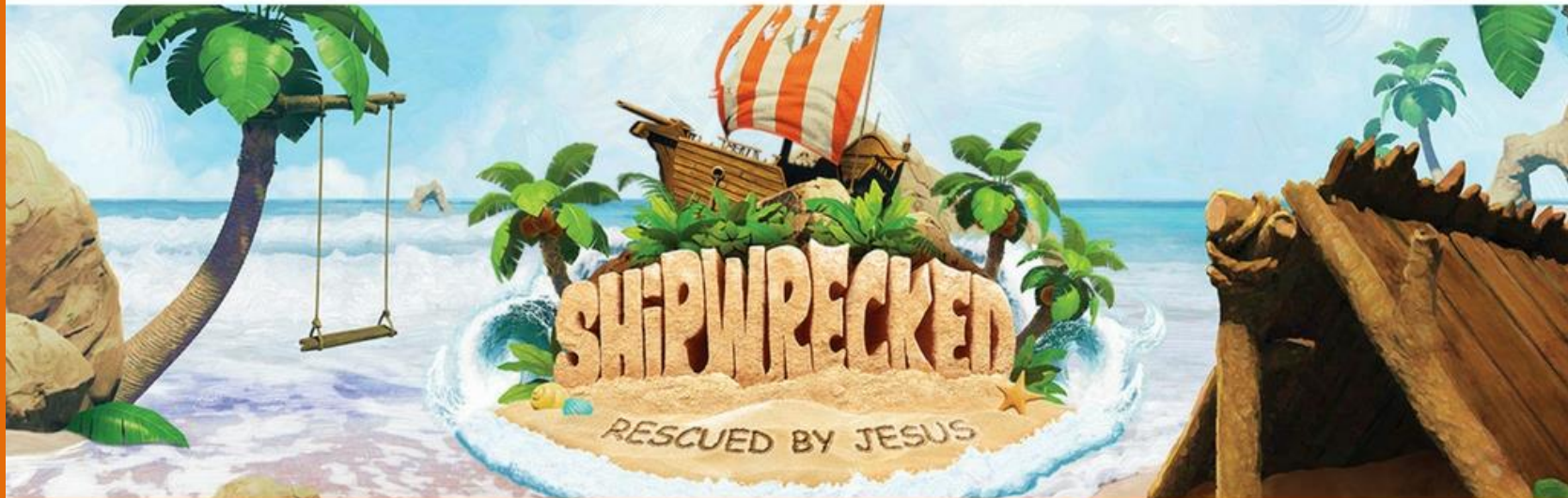

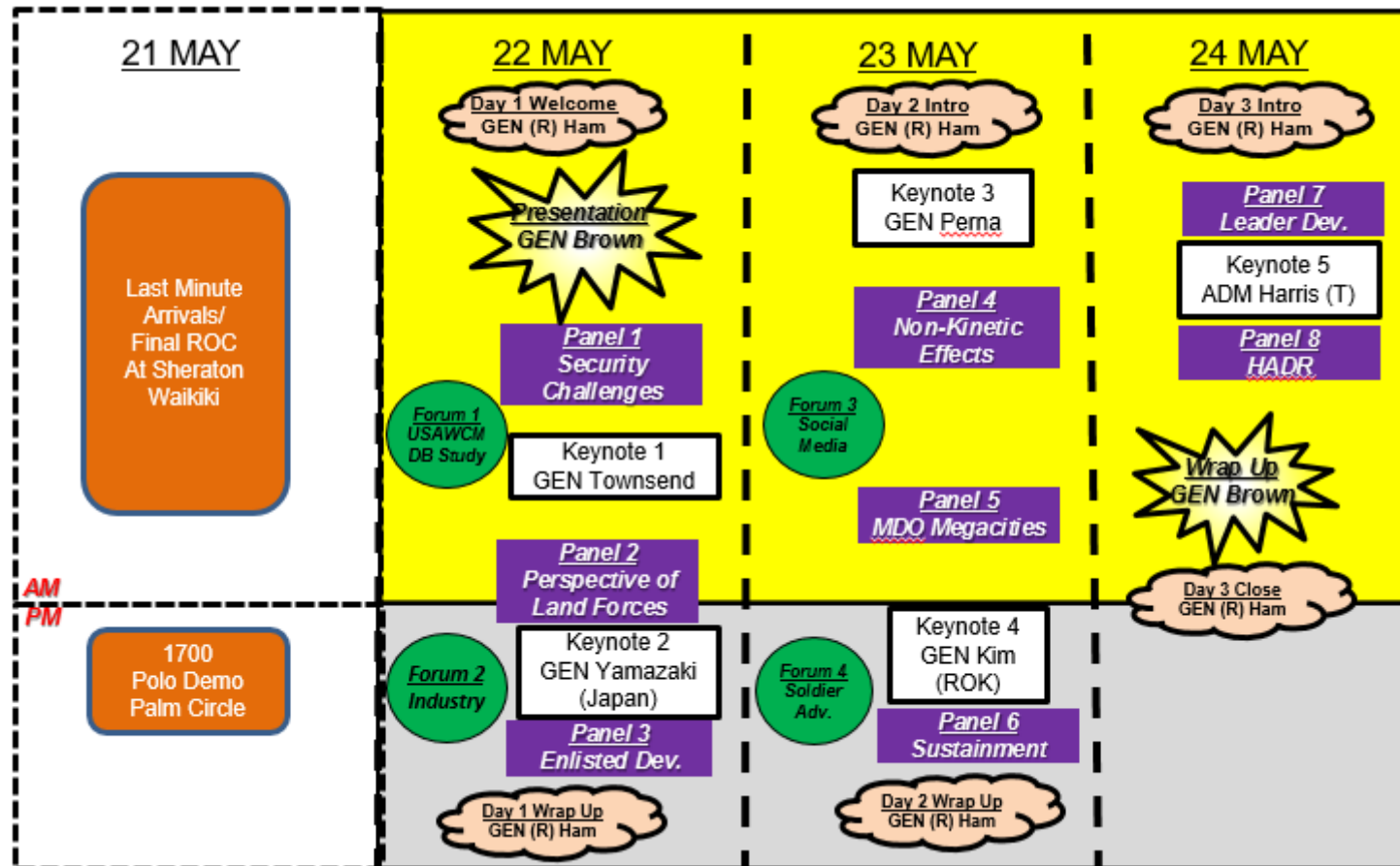
