



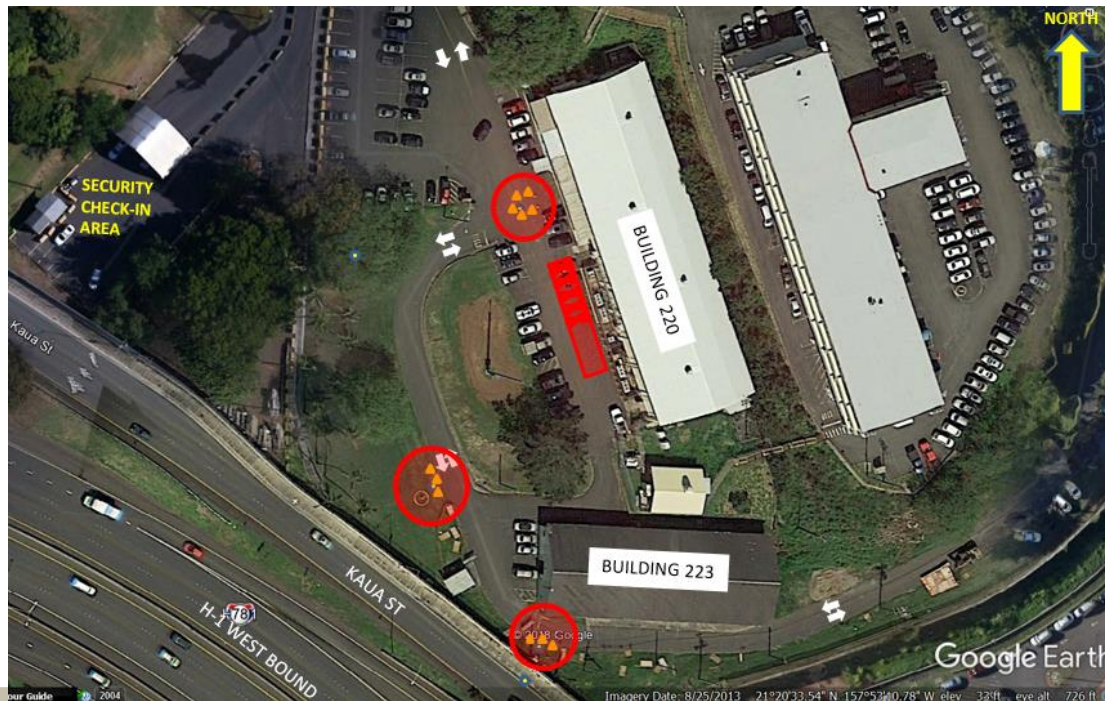

## Closure and Demolition of Parking Lot, Sidewalks and Green Space

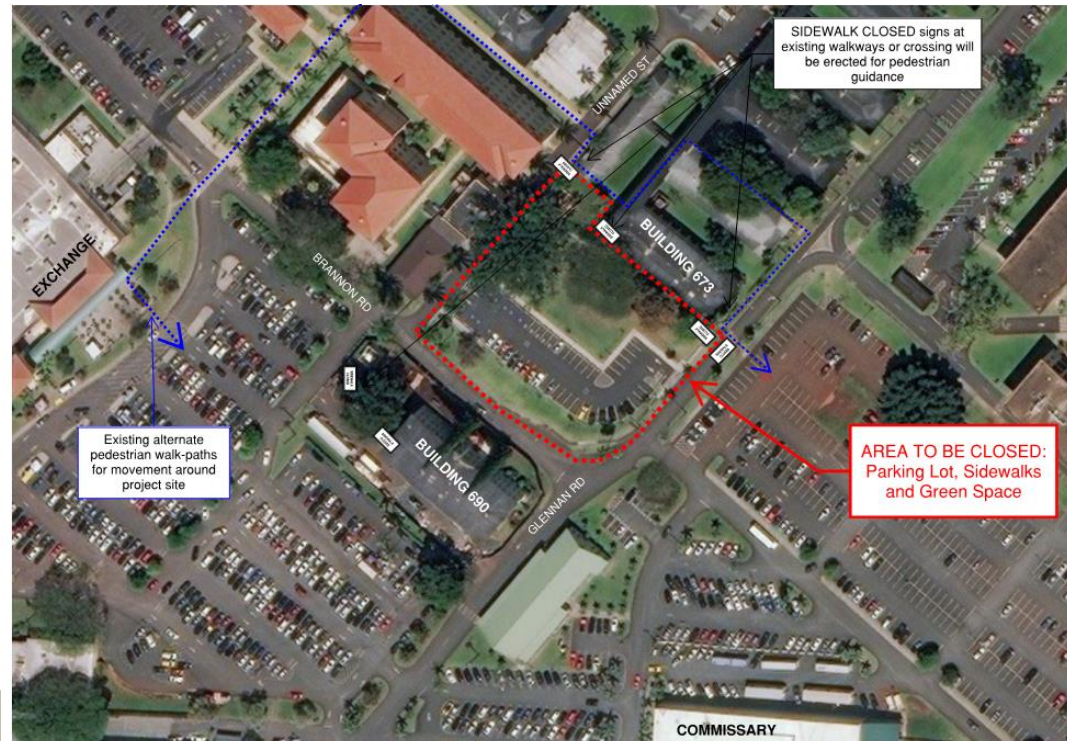
10Sept, 2018 thru 20 May, 2020

SUBJECT: Closure and demolition of parking lot, sidewalks and green space adjacent to Glennan Road, Brannon Road and Unnamed Street.

The medical campus parking lot, opposite buildings 673 and 690 and the adjacent sidewalks and green space that are bordered by Glennan Road, Brannon Road and Unnamed Street will be closed on Monday September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018 and will be demolished to make way for the new Behavioral Health and Dental Clinic Project. This area will be closed until the new building is completed on May 20, 2020. Construction fencing will be installed along the perimeter of the project and will remain in place until the completion of the project.

The area will be signed in the lead up to the closure.

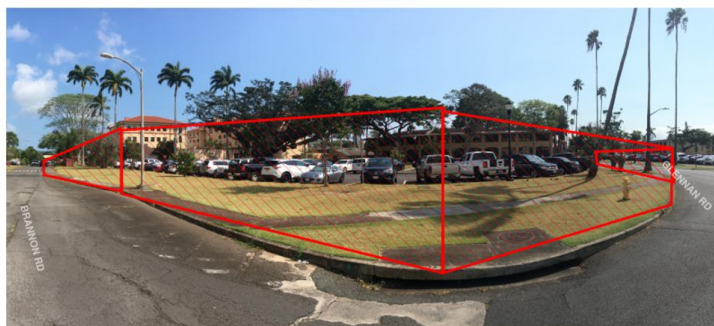




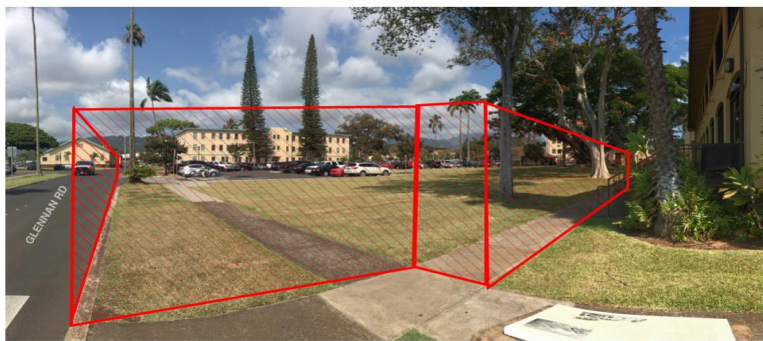

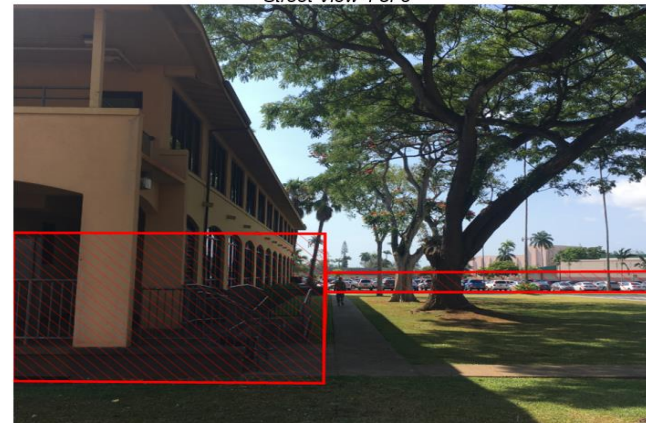

Phase 4: September 21 – September 26

Phase 1: October 9 – October 17

Phase 2: September 27 – October 5

Phase 3 : October 18 – October 26

Work Hours: 8AM-3PM

There will be an extension for road work at the intersection of McCornack Rd. and Waianae Ave. for a traffic signal installation. The four legs of the intersection will be closed for an additional 28 working days from September 12, 2018, to October 26, 2018 due to unforeseen underground obstacles and rain delay from Tropical Storm Olivia. The work will be performed M-F in the following periods:

Phase 4: East side of the intersection on McCornack Rd. from Sept 21 – Sept 26

Phase 2: West side of the intersection on McCornack Rd. from Sept 27 – Oct 5

Phase 1: South side of the intersection on Waianae Ave. from Oct 9 – Oct 17

Phase 3: North side of the intersection on Waianae Ave. from Oct 18 –Oct 26

This will occur between the work hours of 8AM-3PM. During all phases, traffic must detour around the road closure. The contractor will have appropriate signs and barriers for closing each side of the roadway.
