Parking

Illegal parking contributes to congestion and slows traffic

The best way to avoid or become subject to parking enforcement is to park legally

Suspension or Revocation of Installation Driving Privileges IAW USARHAW Regulation 190-5

An accumulation of 12 traffic points within 12 months or 18 traffic points within 24 months will result in a suspension of installation driving privileges for a period of six months


Receipt of four parking tickets within one year results in a 90 day suspension of on-post driving privileges

Driving while suspended results in revocation of on-post driving privileges for five years

- Includes suspensions of state law and suspensions in conjunction with USARHAW 190-5



Prescribed Burn 20-29 May 2019



- Provide protection to endangered species
 - Reduce fuels near firebreak and Elepaio habitats
- Protection of archeological and cultural sites
 - Wildland urban interface protection and range facilities
- Smoke is a natural product of prescribed fire
 - Ability to manage and plan smoke production by altering fire behavior




