\$10,000 REWARD

FOR INFORMATION REGARDING DISAPPEARANCE

The Department of the Army Criminal Investigation Division is offering a reward of \$10,000 for credible information leading to the recovery of Mrs. Mischa Mabeline Kaalohilani Johnson.



Army CID was notified on 01 Aug 24 that Mrs. Mischa Johnson was reported missing from her home on Schofield Barracks, O'ahu, Hawai'i. Mrs. Johnson was reportedly last seen on the evening of 31 Jul 24 inside her home. Mischa is described as 5'2", approximately 170 lbs., six months pregnant, and of Filipino descent. Mischa has a large dragon tattoo on her back. It is unknown what clothing or footwear she might be wearing.

You must be 21 years or older to register a firearm

- ☐ Privately Owned Weapons include but are not limited to pistols, revolvers, rifles, and shotguns.
- ☐ Personnel who reside on and off-post are authorized to have privately owned weapons in their residence.
- ☐ Privately owned weapons are required to be **registered with the State of Hawaii** after purchase or weapons arrival (within 5 days) to the island.
- ☐ Personnel who reside on USARHAW installations are required to register privately owned weapons at Police Stations on Schofield Barracks or Fort Shafter **after** registering with Honolulu Police Department. Note: Owner may register at either Police Station regardless of address.
- ☐ Privately owned weapons should be stored in a secure location away from children, preferably in a safe or locked box
- ☐ Hawaii law that authorizes licensed individuals to carry concealed handguns ***does not apply on military installations*** or in Island Palm Communities.
- ☐ Under no circumstances will the transportation of loaded or concealed weapons be permitted on any USARHAW installations except by authorized law enforcement personnel or by military personnel in the performance of official duties.

Common Safety Tips

- ❖ Swimming is a great way to get exercise and cool down on a hot day. If you or your child intends to swim, pool and ocean safety is a must.
- ❖ **Follow these three simple steps before hopping in the pool:**
 1. First, if your child is not a strong swimmer, be vigilant of the depth of the pool or body of water that you will be swimming in.
 - a. Be cautious of pools that have a shallow end and a deep end.
 - b. Set the standard for preliminary safety by conducting a standing test.
 2. Second, check for a lifeguard on duty.
 3. Third, make sure your child takes regular breaks to avoid getting exhausted.

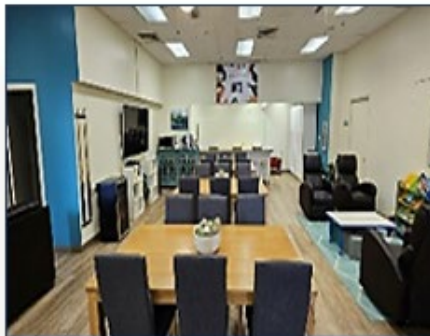

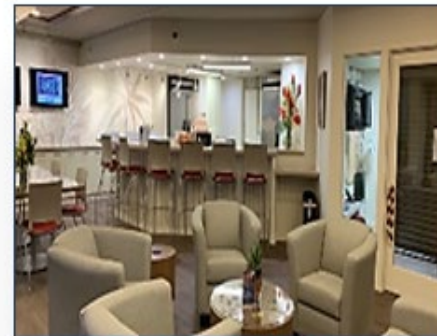
