## **RAPPEL MASTER**

## 1. Training provided by the Lightning Academy, HHBN, 25th ID

2. Description. The Lightning Academy (LA) Rappel Master Course (RM) is accredited by the United States Army Infantry School (USAIS) and is run by the Rappel Master Cadre of the Lightning Academy, HHBN, 25<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, in vicinity of East Range Training Area, Schofield Barracks, Hawaii. It is designed to provide parent units with subject matter expert NCOs and Junior Officers in the full spectrum of Rappel Master Duties. All Students who complete the Rappel Master Course will be certified to conduct Rappel Master duties to include the Rappel Master Personnel Inspection (RMPI), rappel tower training execution, rappeler sustainment training, and rotary wing operations.

**3.** Eligibility. The Lightning Academy Rappel Master Course is open to all NCOs and Officers in the grade of E-4 (CPL only) to E-9 and O-1 to O-4. There is a maximum of 30 participants in each class. 25<sup>th</sup> ID personnel have priority for this course. Other installations (incl. Reserve and National Guard) must contact 25<sup>th</sup> ID G3 Schools for availability and enrollment. Foreign partners must contact their embassy or security cooperations cell for enrollment. Students must have a periodic health assessment within the last 12 months (IAW AR 40-501), have a minimum profile serial of 111121 (PULHES), meet Army height and weight standards IAW AR 600-9, and have passed the ACFT within 12 months of class start date. Applicants must have one year service remaining on active duty upon completion of the course. Applicants must have completed either Air Assault, Ranger School, Sapper School, or the Basic Military Mountaineer Course and have documentation of this completion to attend the Rappel Master Course.

**4. Location/Time**. The Rappel Master Course is located at the Lightning Academy Air Assault Compound, formerly known as the Combat Readiness Center (CRC), Building T-2064, 125 Riley Road, Schofield Barracks, HI 96857-5000. Report time is NLT 0800 on Day One of training in duty uniform at Building T-2064.

**5.** Administrative. Students will report with the completed Student packet (LA 100, STP, documented completion of either Air Assault, Ranger School, Sapper School, or the Basic Military Mountaineering Course IAW the packing list). Students are responsible for their own billeting and transportation to and from the training area. Lightning Academy does not provide transportation or lodging to students.

a. Equipment. Soldiers are required to supply all equipment IAW the most current packing list. Students will report to Day One with all items on the Rappel Master packing list. Off-island Students are extremely encouraged to pack civilian attire, as all Students are released each day. The course packing list can be found on the Lightning Academy Website listed below.

b. All slots are reserved in ATRRS through G3 Schools, however, wait status packets will be accepted prior to the enrollment suspense date after all ATRRS slots are filled. Walk-ons are accepted if all ATRRS slots are not filled. Students attempting to walk on must coordinate with their school's representative to be placed on the Order of Merit (OML) list. Walk-ons will be subsequently enrolled in ATRRS.
