# Residential Communities Initiative Office

- Currently hired 5/8 personnel to conduct inspections
  - Conduct inspections of between occupancy maintenance
  - Contact residents to follow up with Life/Health/Safety work orders
    - 100% Follow up on all L/H/S and Command Hotline issues
    - 5% follow up on all work orders submitted
- Ongoing repairs to homes
  - HVAC upgrades to 5,091 homes are ongoing in multiple communities. This includes the replacement of the through wall systems with a central air-conditioning system in the 1990s era homes.
  - Exterior paint is ongoing at Canby and Aliamanu. We will be mobilizing at Leaderfeild in the next month with Castner Village and Kalakaua communities coming up next.
  - Roofing is ongoing at Wheeler, Solomon and Helemano
  - Kitchen and bathroom upgrades, carports, and fencing continue at Wheeler
  - Demolition of the first phase of the Patriot Community began in March and is ongoing. Building demolition will be complete by the end of July.

## Access Control

## Weapon Registration

All privately owned firearms must be registered with HPD within 5 calendar days of arriving on island. If residing on the installation, registration is also required with the PMO within 5 calendar days.

- Registration with HPD must be done in person at the Main Police Station (801 South Berentania St., Honolulu). Bring all firearms in a case without ammunition.

- Registration with HPD must be completed prior to registration with the PMO on Schofield Barracks or Fort Shafter. Do not bring firearms to the PMO.

Motor Vehicle Licensing & Permits Division  
City and County of Honolulu

In any given month, the city tows between **300-350** vehicles as abandoned, for traffic violations and from accidents.

If your vehicle is towed for a traffic violation or because it appears abandoned on a public street, you could incur substantial towing and storage charges, and significant court fees and fines.

If you sell your car but do not file a completed **Notice of Transfer** with the Motor Vehicle, Licensing & Permits Division, you may be held potentially responsible for traffic tickets and for auto accident caused by the buyer.

# Licensure and Certification Costs Reimbursement

**What:** Army Directive 2019-18 authorizes reimbursement for state relicensing and recertification associated with PCS relocations for Army spouses

- Reimbursement of examination and registration fees (\$500 cap per PCS)
- Policy is retroactive to Dec. 12, 2017
- Continued work with all 50 states to make licenses transfers easier

**Who:** All Army Spouses are eligible - Active, Guard and Reserve

**How:** Reimbursement filing instructions forthcoming

**Why:** Army has championed spouse employment issues and recognizes the employment challenges resulting from frequent relocations

# Get A Kit (Cont.)

- Make sure your emergency kit also includes items specific to your special needs, for example:
  - Eyeglasses
  - Medications
  - Infant formula/diapers
  - Food and extra water for pets/service animals
- Additional Items to consider:
  - Important family documents in a waterproof container
  - Cash, change or traveler's checks
  - Local maps



# Make A Plan

Making a plan is simple... just think of the 5 Ws!

- Who: Gather input from all family members
- What: Plan for all hazards that could effect your family
- Where: Establish plans for evacuation and meeting places
- When: Review plan annually or as major changes occur
- Why: Having a plan will enable your family to respond to an emergency more quickly

Making an emergency plan is just the first step; you must practice and adjust it to meet your current needs.



# Be Informed

The following are the methods used to warn of an impending danger due to an emergency:

- Mass Notification/Giant Voice Warning System
- AtHoc Telephonic Alerts
- Hawaii State Siren and Emergency Alert System
- TV/Radio Broadcasts
- Island Palm Communities Call Max System
- Garrison Website/Facebook/Twitter




