

COMMUNITY INFORMATION EXCHANGE

Meetings are not held in December. They are also streamed live on the garrison's Facebook & page.

Community Information Exchange meetings inform Soldiers and families on installation and community matters. The primary responsibility for conducting Community Information Exchange meetings rests with the garrison commander and staff to develop the agenda of installation-wide and community-wide topics of interest and concern.

The garrison commander and/or the U.S. Army Hawaii senior commander attends and supports the meetings, along with garrison subject-matter experts and directors.






Schofield Barracks Agent Card

The Agent Card authorizes patrons to purchase items at the U.S. Army - Hawaii Exchange, Commissary and MWR facilities as the agent for the Sponsor. This Agent Card (U.S. Army Garrison – Hawaii) is only acceptable for usage at the main exchange, commissary and MWR facilities located on Schofield Barracks.

All Non-Army Commissaries DOES honor U.S. Army – Hawaii Agent Card (Air Force, Navy and Marine Corps Exchanges and Commissaries)



- Single or Dual Military parents Deployment or TDY orders (for Dual Military, both parents must be off-island simultaneously)
- Minor Child reside with a Non-Military Parent Divorce decree or court document showing custody.
- Active Duty Member Signed physician's letter stating the Patron is incapable of shopping for themselves.



Installation/Unit Clearing

Family Member Out-Processing for a Absence Service Member

- Family members require a Special Power of Attorney (SPOA) stating the Soldier authorizes the Family member to clear the Installation (DA 137-2).
- Unit Commanders must designate a Service Member to clear the Unit (DA 137-1) in the absence of a Service Member.
- Family member should have multiple copies of orders, any amendments, and DA-31.

Visitor Policy



• The Directorate of Emergency Services will provide professional and timely customer service and accurate verification of customer information.

Visitors

- To ensure the security and safety of all U.S. Army Garrison Hawaii installations, all non-military affiliated visitors requesting unescorted access will be properly vetted through the National Crime Information Center (NCIC III), Automated Installation Entry (AIE) and ALERTS, prior to being issued an installation visitor pass.
- Guests remain the responsibility of their sponsor at all times. The sponsor must be 18 years or older and possess a valid Department of Defense ID card.
- Anyone entering a U.S. Army Garrison Hawaii installation must have a Department of Defense ID card, (to include Common Access Card (CAC), DoD retiree ID cards, Transportation Workers Identification Card (TWIC) and Gold Star Family ID cards); or a Visitor Pass.
- ALL VISITORS must present their full name, date of birth and social security number in order to obtain a background check.
- All visitors will provide a valid and original form of ID, to include a federal identification card, state driver's license, state identification card, or passport which complies with Public Law 109-13 (The REAL ID Act of 2005).

VEHICLES

 Drivers must possess a valid operator's license, vehicle safety inspection, registration, and proof of no-fault insurance. Operators of rental vehicles must have the rental agreement.

All Passes-

Apply at a Visitor Control Center (VCC) or Vehicle Processing Center (VPC). All visitors will provide a valid and original form of ID, to include a federal identification card, state driver's license, state identification card, or passport which complies with Public Law 109-13 (The REAL ID Act of 2005). Otherwise, access will be denied.


Extended Pass can be obtained by Veteran Health Identification Card holders, Dept. of Education (DOE) teachers and bus drivers, agent card holders, au pair/child care providers, family (non-DoD), and contractors/vendors

Apply at a Visitor Control Center (VCC). All visitors will provide a valid and original form of ID, to include a federal identification card, state driver's license, state identification card, or passport which complies with Public Law 109-13 (The REAL ID Act of 2005). Otherwise, access will be denied. Please note: House guests staying in on-post family housing for more than six days must be registered at the resident's community center.

Domestic Violence Reporting

- Law Enforcement personnel will immediately notify the Family Advocacy Program (FAP) Victim Advocate (VA) and Behavioral Health (BH) departments of the incident to prompt a thorough risk assessment and begin safety planning.
- Special Victims and Prosecution (SVIP) capability covered offenses will be investigated by the military criminal investigative organization (MCIO) in accordance with DoDI 5505.19.
- All Domestic Violence incidents will be reported to the local Provost Marshal's Office (PMO).



- Visitors to Military installations and Uniformed and Non-Uniformed Personnel working in recognized welfare service organization offices within an Activity of the Military Service
 - Are authorized to purchase all food and beverages sold at exchange locations, if consumed on post.
- Civilian Students and Faculty Members at Service Schools
 - May purchase books, supplies and materials related to the educational process, only at exchange facilities that support the school.
- DoD Civilian Employees using Government-authorized vehicles for official business may purchase gasoline for those vehicles.





All members must complete 4 monthly work hours at stables.







 - ✓ Units are required to assign a sponsor 120 days prior to report date.

 - Mandatory and voluntary workshops to prepare individuals and families for success after the Army



Sept. 29, 2022

- Levy Notifications are sent within 5 days of MPD receiving notification of assignment via CAP Cycle. MPD notifies via email to the Soldier, S1, and SGM/CSM. Soldiers are to complete the Levy Packet NLT 30 days from notification.
- Orders are published up to <u>6 Months</u> from departure date, if all required documents are submitted to include the PCS ETP. S1 submits completed Levy Packets to: <u>usarmy.schofield.id-pacific.list.reassignments-hi@mail.mil</u>
- Reassignments Office provides S1's and SGM/CSMs a Missing Documents log weekly.
- It is Army policy that if an individual has a government travel card, it will be used for all relocation expenses up to the limit of their entitlements. A centrally billed account is only available for Soldiers who do not have a government travel card. Account type must be indicated to Reassignments Office prior to orders being cut.

DHR - Family Travel Office

Due to the COVID travel restrictions, the process to request orders for all Government Funded Travel now requires additional steps. (Early Return of Dependent, Dependent Travel, Space A Travel and Student Travel.)

All Government Funded Travel requests are processed as follows:

- 1. Service Member submits the packet to their Chain of Command (packet checklists provided on the Garrison Webpage)
- 2. Chain of Command submits the packet to Schofield Family Travel Section Military-Personnel Division (SFTS-MPD)
- 3. After tentatively approving the request for travel, the SFTS-MPD provides the S-1 a Memorandum to be used as a justification to request a Travel Exception to Policy (ETP) signed by the first General Officer in the Chain of Command.
- 4. Chain of Command submits the signed ETP to SFTS-MPD
- 5. SFTS-MPD then provides the final order to S-1 and Service Member

Transportation and Carlson Wagon-lit (SATO) will require a copy of the final orders and signed Travel ETP to book HHG shipments and flights

 Only used for unusual/emergency circumstances like marital difficulties, financial difficulties, divorce, hardship, etc. The Soldier acquired a Family member (married) before the effective date of the PCS order & is entitled to transportation of the Family member at Government expense. Soldier acquired a Family member (married) after the effective date of the PCS order and is not entitled to transpiration of Family members at Government expense but may be authorized space-available transportation once command sponsorship is approved by the overseas command. Must meet eligibility requirements to qualify 36-month tour or 12 months remaining after approval Dependent(s) must be on island to qualify One fully-funded round trip per fiscal year for dependent student between the student's school and the sponsor's duty station. An entitlement for Command Sponsored children of Active-Duty Soldiers stationed overseas (Hawaii) who are full time students attending an accredited college/university. One fully-funded round trip per fiscal year for dependent student between the student's school and the sponsor's duty station. Application should be submitted no later than 60 days
