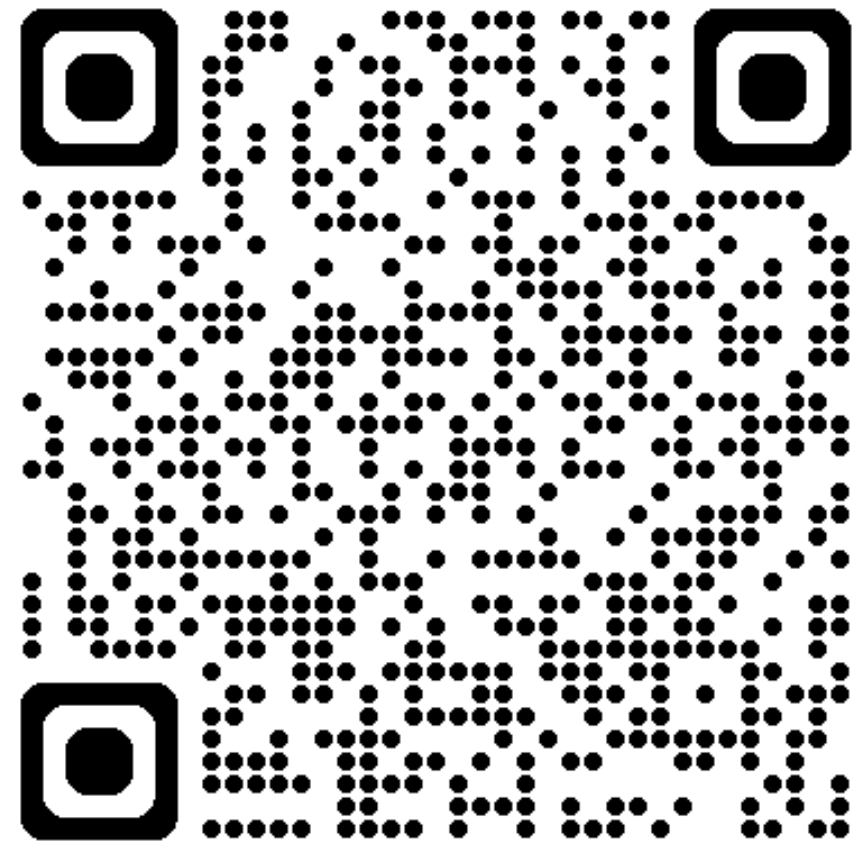

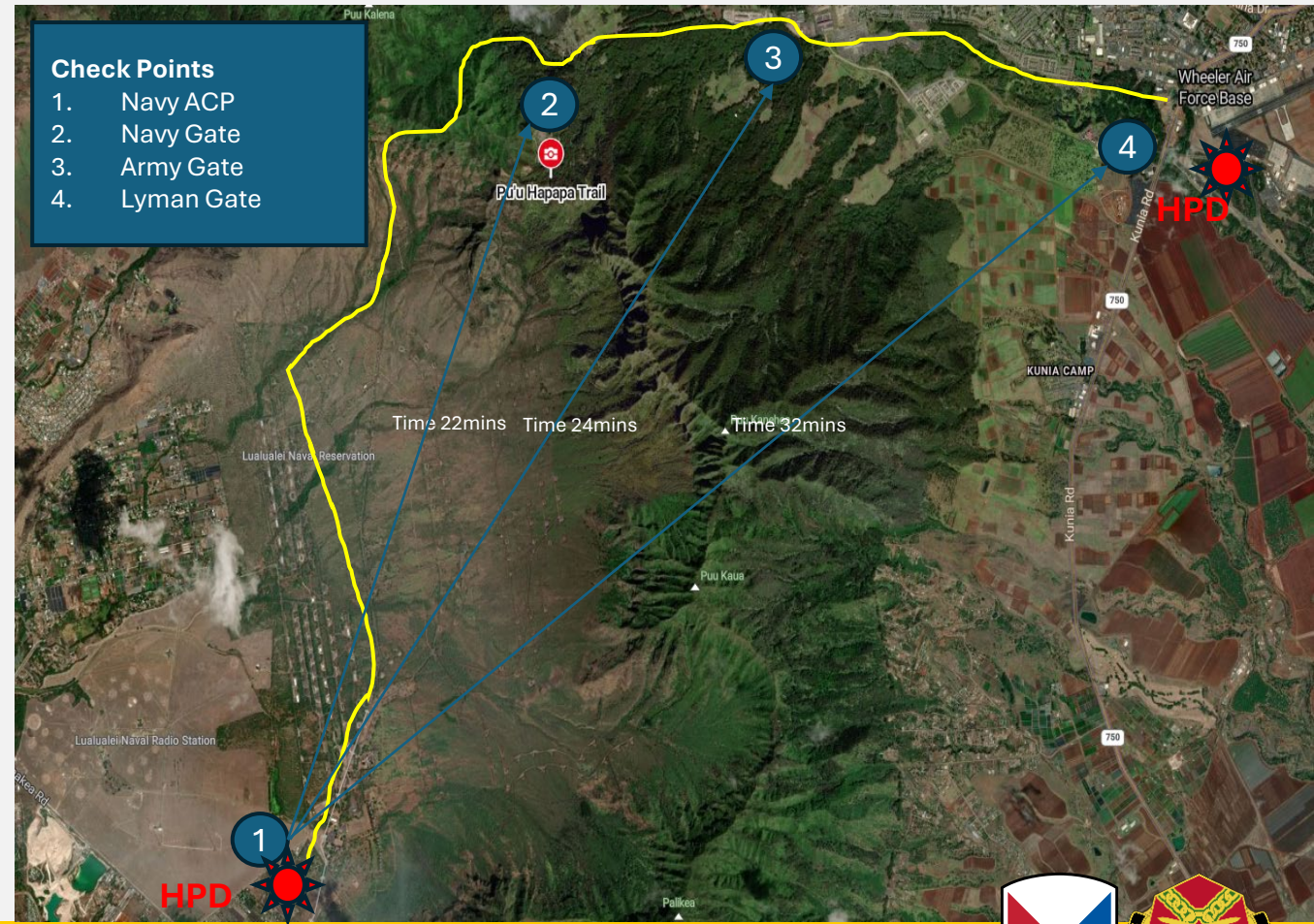

- IPC's partner vendor will install charging stations at their cost
- Residents sign up for a monthly subscription, paying for kWh at the local electric rate
- This program is solely for IPC residents

➤ In-Home Residential EV Charging

- Level 2 EV charger installation in garages or carports, available for most homes at IPC
- Can take as little as 5-6 hours to charge to full battery

➤ Community EV Charging

- Level 3 DC fast chargers will come on-line in the future at select locations

➤ Installs are anticipated to be available in Qtr2 CY25

- **Set boundaries and develop a plan:** know when to say “This is not for me”



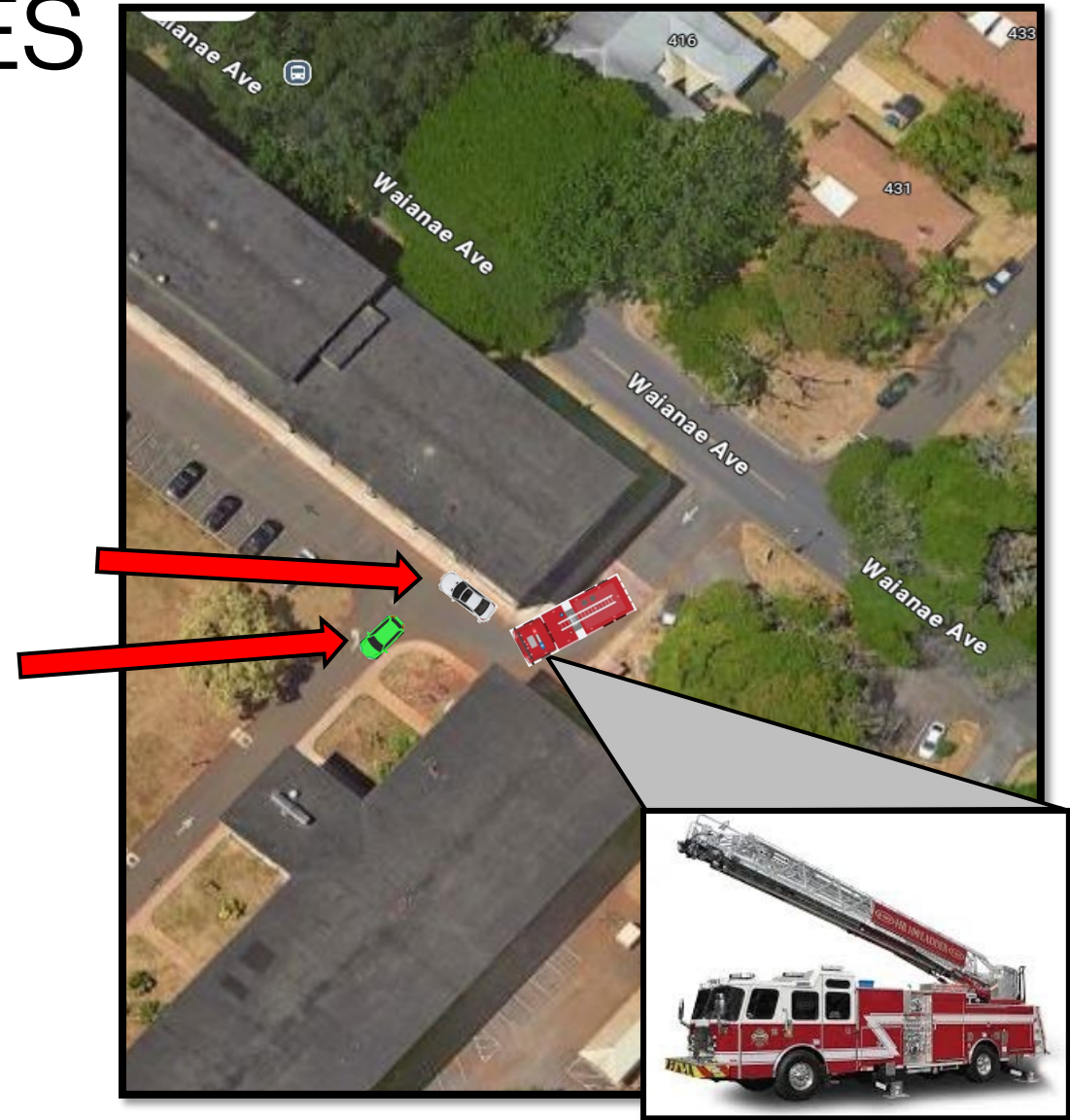

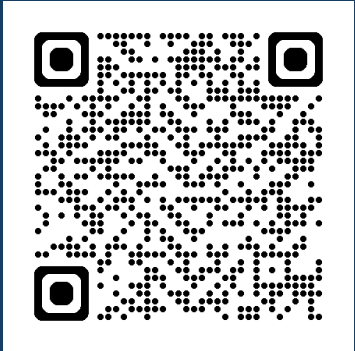

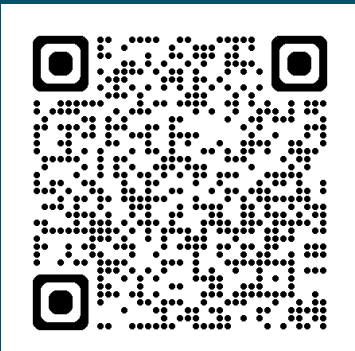

Bulk items Island Palm Communities Residents:

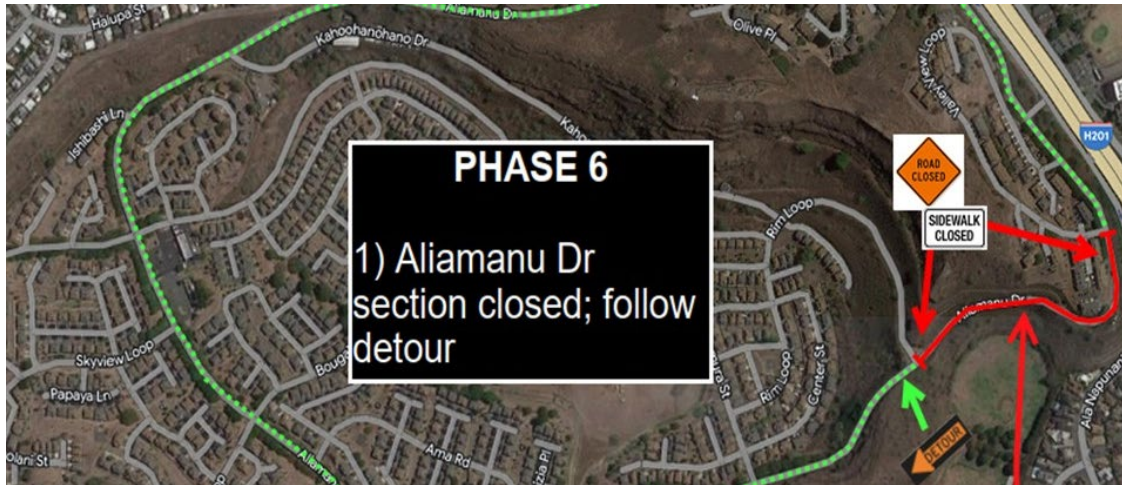
- Residents have access to curbside bulk pick-up service
- Bulk items should be placed curbside **after 5 pm** the evening prior to scheduled trash pick-up day.

Dumping of bulk waste at unauthorized locations is a punishable offense (UCMJ Articles 92).

- Citations will be issued if proper evidence of illegal dumping is provided to Military Police

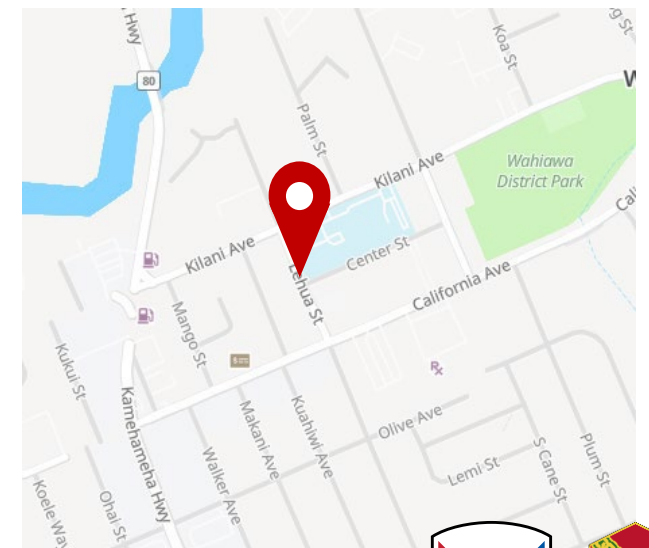
Post Office Relocation

**You will be issued a
General Office Memorandum of Reprimand if you:**

- Are convicted by a court, or receive NJP,
- for an offense of drunk/impaired driving;
- **Refuse to take, or failure to complete field sobriety tests;**
- **Driving or being in physical control of a motor vehicle with a BAC of .08 or higher on or off post, irrespective of other charges; or**
- Driving or being in physical control of a motor vehicle on or off the installation when lawfully conducted chemical tests reflect the presence of illegal drugs

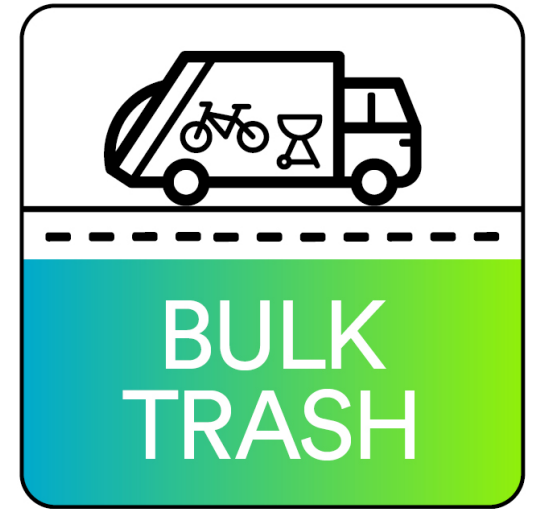
Bulk Refuse Reminder

Island Palm Community's refuse/recycling collections and bulk pick-up services are provided to residents weekly on designated days.

Here are some important notes to remember:

- Refuse and recycling cans and bulk items should be placed curbside, not earlier than 5 p.m., the evening prior to pick-up.
- Please do not place any trash in locations/containers/bins/dumpsters other than the refuse or recycling receptacles assigned to your home.
- Please refrain from placing refuse and bulk trash items in commercial refuse containers or dumpsters.
- **Both live and artificial Christmas trees can be placed at the curb on your scheduled refuse collection day.**

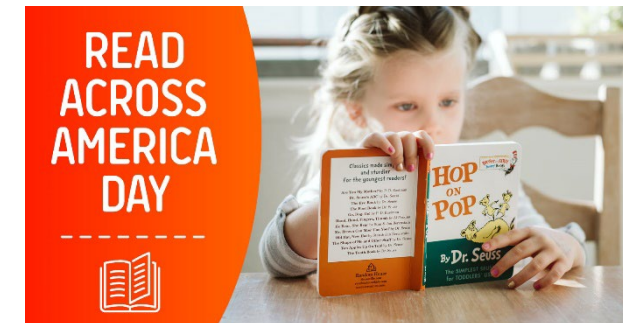

TUITION ASSISTANCE (TA) CHANGES

- The fiscal year (FY) cap is increased to 18 semester hours and \$4,500.
- Soldiers must complete Army Ignited 101 Brief and Career Path Decide.
 - Schofield Barracks: Tuesdays at 0900 & Thursdays at 1500
 - Tripler: Wednesdays at 1000

CREDENTIALING ASSISTANCE (CA) CHANGES

- The fiscal year limit is decreased from \$4K to \$2K per Soldier.
- Soldiers are limited to one credential per FY; three credentials per ten years of service.
- Soldiers who receive CA funding for training must take the associated exam.
- Soldiers must complete CA 101 Brief and MilGears prior to requesting CA.

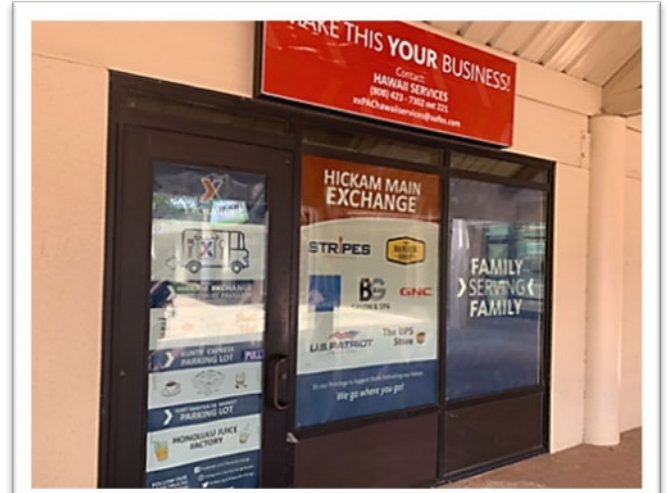

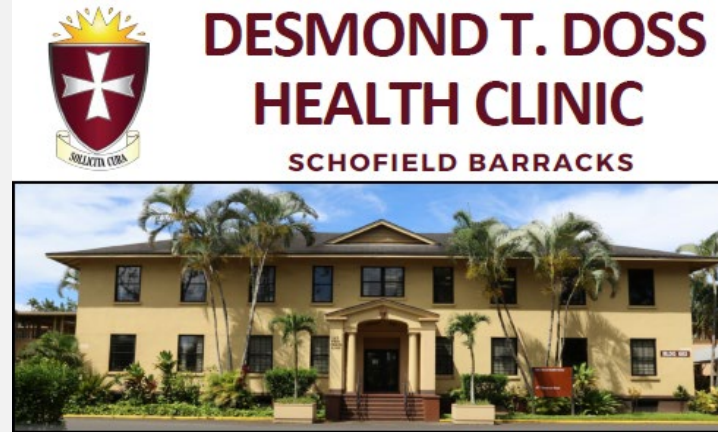

This includes Sick Call. *All other patients may proceed directly to your clinic.

E-Bike Guidance

Helmets are MANDATORY 

- ☐ Must have headlight if riding during limited visibility
- ☐ Must have a red reflector mounted on rear of bike
- ☐ Must have a reflector mounted on each side of the bike
- ☐ Reflective body-wear gear is recommended
- ☐ Bicyclists using roadway have all the rights/duties applicable to the driver of a motor vehicle and must follow same rules/laws
- ☐ Carry one rider only
- ☐ Ride single file and far right of lane
- ☐ All bicycles with 20-inch wheels or greater diameter are required to be registered on Oahu (\$15.00)

**Properly fitted helmet is

- ☐ E-Bike motor must be less than < 750 watts
- ☐ Hawaii electric bicycle law: An E-bike is a low-speed electric bicycle whose assisted maximum speed on a paved level surface, when powered solely by its motor, is less than 20 mph”
- ☐ **MUST BE 15 YEARS OR OLDER to legally operate**

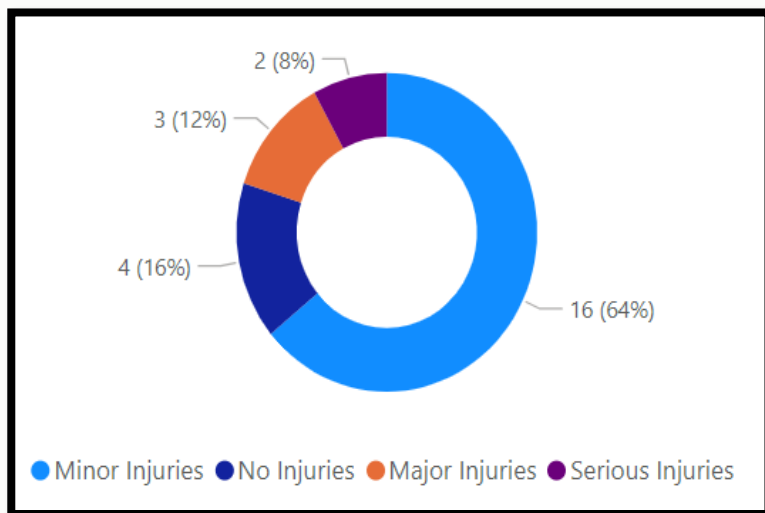

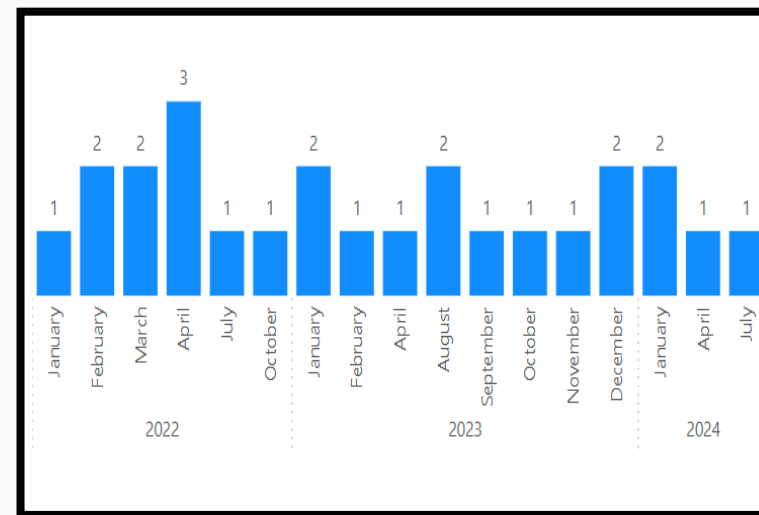


Bike/Cycle Accident Breakdown

Injuries Description

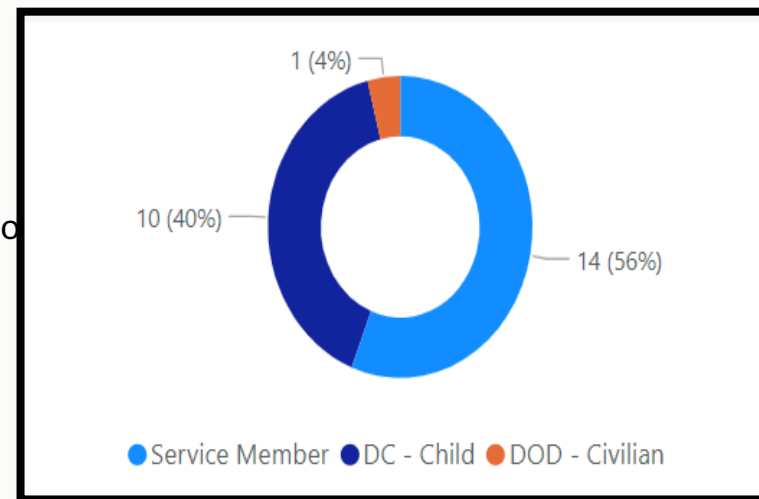
