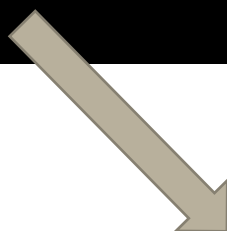

Help us meet the **1 Dec. deadline!**

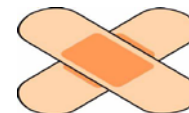

COVID Child Care Relief Program



Purpose: to assist parents of **school age children** with unforeseen childcare expenses **resulting from reduced capacity of CDC's and Childcare providers**, and unbudgeted expenses **associated with COVID school options**.

General Guidelines

- Expenses must be for child(ren) 12 years old and younger
- Spouse must be employed, going to school, or pursuing professional licensure/certification.
- Child care needs is unforeseen (child care center closure or reduction in capacity or hours)
- Assistance will be **needs-based** (must show proof of financial need)
- Assistance will be provided as a **loan, grant, or combination of both**.



Required Documents

- AER Application Form 101
- Current End of Month LES
- ERB/ORB
- Budget Worksheet
- Form 575 Electronic Funds Transfer
- Pay stub or school schedule required for spouse
- Proof of unforeseen child care need (ex: waitlist verification, statement of non-availability from on-post childcare center, childcare center notice of closure or reduced capacity, school closure notice with school option selection)

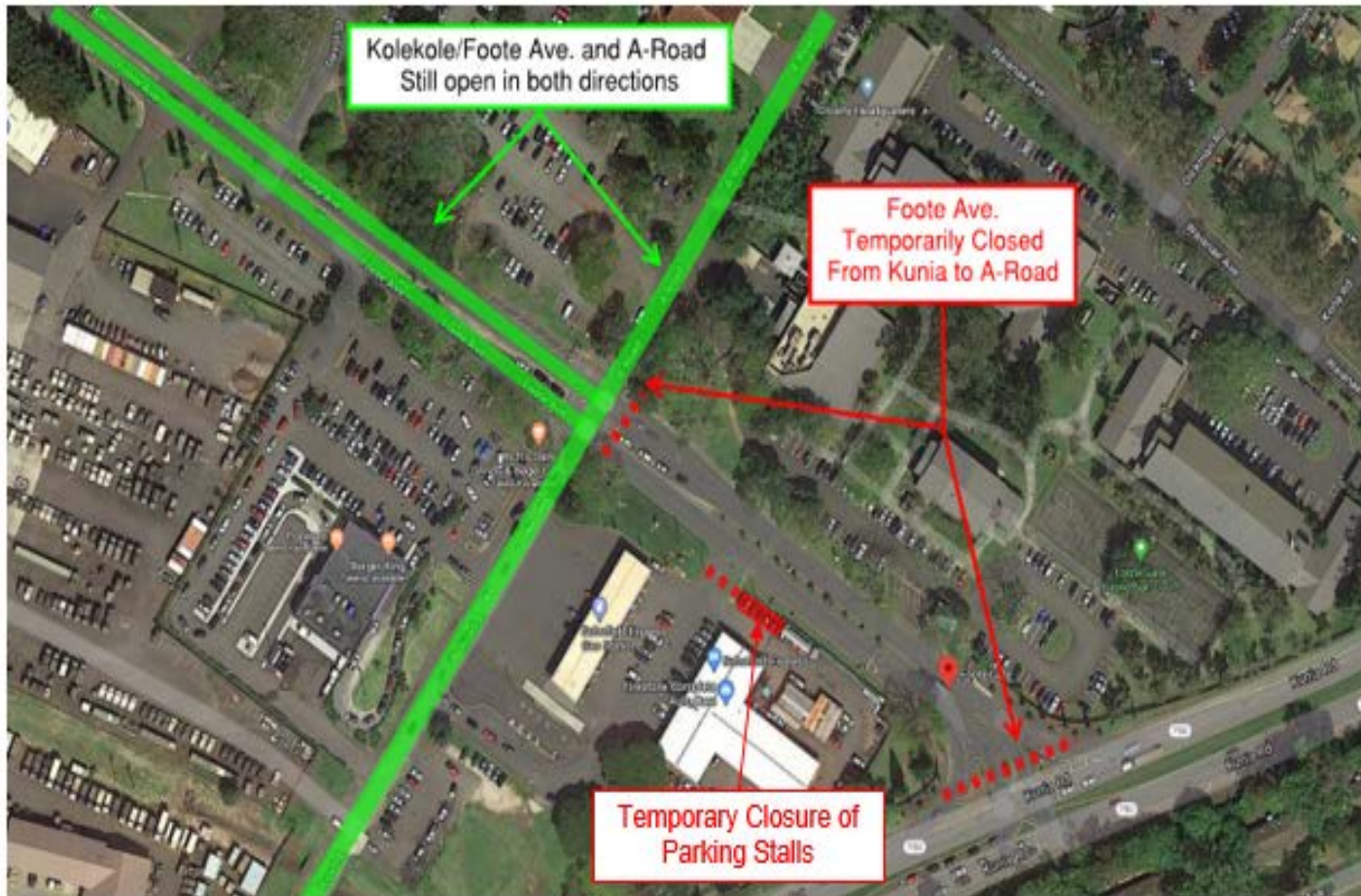

Alcohol Abuse

- Over the previous year we have had over 260 alcohol related incidents throughout USAG-HI.
- These incidents include drunk driving, assaults, domestic violence, and suicide attempts.
- Alcohol has been a factor in the vast majority of violent offences occurring within our population.
- Over the previous two months we have had three Soldiers pass away as a result of vehicle accidents.

Directorate of Emergency Services

Starting December 01, 2020, DES will begin registering all vehicles on US Army Hawaii installations.

- Drivers must keep a copy of the registration in their vehicle at all times (no vehicle decals)
- After the initial registration period, the installation gates may conduct checks at any time
- During out-processing, Soldiers must show proof of disposition for all vehicles (such as bill of lading, title transfer paperwork, or proof of disposal).

Soldiers

- Soldiers in USARHAW units will register their vehicles with their unit S1 starting in January 2021. This is the primary method of registration for Soldiers and their families.
- Soldiers or other military members who are not in USARHAW units will register their vehicles at the Visitor Control Center or at a DES hosted "Vehicle Registration Drive-Thru" event starting in January 2021.

Family Members

- Family member vehicles will be registered under the Sponsor's name.
- If the Sponsor is unable to register the vehicle (due to deployment or extended TDY), vehicles can be registered at the Visitor Control Center (VCC) at Leilehua Golf Course.

DA Civilians and Contractors

- DA Civilians and Contractors can register their vehicles at the Visitor Control Center.
- Contractors may register work vehicles at the Vehicle Processing Centers (VPC) when coming onto the installation for a work order.
- DES will be hosting "Vehicle Registration Drive-Thru" events starting in January 2021.

Visitors

- Visitors will continue to register their vehicles at the Vehicle Processing Centers (VPC) and Visitor Control Center (VCC).
- There will be no more handwritten paper passes; starting December 01, all visitor passes will be entered into a database with a printed visitor pass.

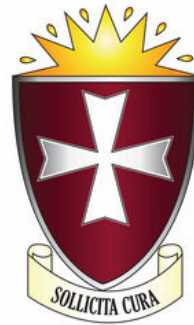

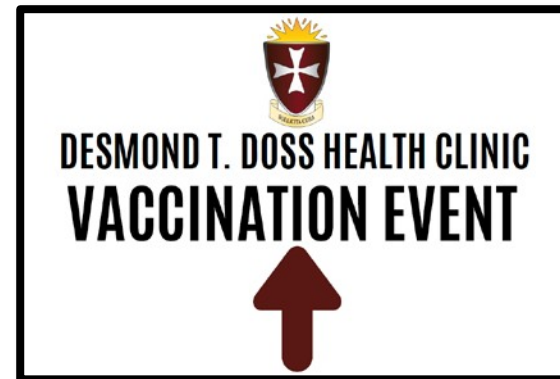

Step 2: Present prescription (which can be obtained by calling your PCM through the TAMC appointment line at: 808-683-2778 or use TRICARE Online)

Step 3: To update MEDPROS, provide documentation of flu vaccination (including name/vaccine lot/injection site/expiration date) to Supervisor/NCOIC; Supervisor/NCOIC will then verify and submit the documentation to SSG Dickson Kurgat, NCOIC of Allergy & Immunology Clinic

1. Keep the feast on the table.
The fatty food can lead to pancreatitis
2. Put the trash where the pets can't get to it. Turkey bones can kill
3. Remember onions, raisins, grapes are toxic for your pet

If your pet is experiences signs of tremors, lethargy, vomiting, anorexia seek veterinary care immediately.



Winter PCS



1. Acclimation certificate is only valid for temperatures down to 35°F
2. Health Certificates are valid for 10 days and pet must be free of internal/external parasites and up-to-date on vaccines
3. Packing can cause significant stress on animals. (i.e. inappropriate urination, escaping, licking/biting at self, behavioral issues)

Holiday Decoration and Lighting Policy

USAG-HI Holiday Decoration and Lighting Policy:

- Policy Memorandum USAG-HI-25, Holiday Lighting
- The following policy shall apply to all reimbursable tenants and users on USAG-HI installations, to include housing residents. Sponsors and contracting officer representatives are charged with the responsibility for ensuring that family members and contractors are aware of, and abide by, the contents of this policy.
- Outside, holiday lighting (electrical AC source powered or LED) shall be placed not earlier than the day after Thanksgiving and removed not later than January 15th.
- Avoid excessive use of both interior and exterior decorative lighting.
- Exterior electrical lighting shall be turned on no earlier than 1800 and turned off no later than 2200. The exception to this standard applies on Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve and New Year's Day. Electrical lighting timers are recommended.
- Holiday electrical lighting shall not be turned on during periods when facilities or residences are not occupied.

IPC's resident policy typically states that exterior holiday ornaments and lights can be installed no sooner than two weeks prior to each holiday. To boost the spirits of our residents during these challenging, unprecedented times, Island Palm Communities is pleased to announce an exception to this policy and invite our families to decorate their homes and front yard areas to help spread some holiday cheer! ([Resident communication link here.](#))

When decorating your home, please be sure to observe IPC's policy on ornamental lighting and decorations for the holidays, as outlined in [IPC's Resident Guide](#) p. 38, Section 6.17.):

1. Residents are not allowed on second-story and roofs for any reason.
 2. All decorations must be in good taste.
 3. Decorations must not impede maintenance and landscaping work.
 4. Residents will carefully inspect and control ornamental lighting to avoid fire.
 5. Residents may use clips or tape that is specifically designed to install temporary holiday lighting.
 6. Extension cords are intended for occasional use and shall not be used on a permanent or semi-permanent basis inside or outside of any home.
 7. Outdoor lighting and electrical cords must be Underwriter Laboratory (UL) approved and designed for outdoor use.

Unauthorized Child Care

If you provide more than ten hours of on-post child care a week and have not been certified as a Family Child Care Provider your sponsor (military member) and you can be penalized.



- Military members who knowingly allow unauthorized child care in their quarters may be subject to discipline under the UCMJ or adverse administrative action under U.S. Army Hawaii Regulation 1.
- Offenses could result in debarment (losing installation access and privileges) from US Army Hawaii military installations.
- Major Violations of the Resident Occupancy Agreement or the “Island Palm Communities Resident Guide & Community Standards Handbook” of a serious nature may result in immediate eviction.

Ten Hour Rule – You Can Still Be Neighborly

It's okay to be neighborly and the “ten hour rule” does not eliminate “good neighbor” favors!

Examples of occasional care that does not occur on a regular basis.

Regular basis means routinely for an extended period of time.

- You can host a sleepover in your home with your children's friends.
- You can care for your neighbors children in your home overnight as a favor while they enjoy a weekend get-away.
- You can care your friend's children while they attend an appointment.
- You can be on a Family Care Plan for a friend or family member and provide care for their children when they are called away for weekend training or temporary duty.

Unauthorized child care settings do not apply to care being provided to your children in your own home.

PLEASE ALWAYS EXERCISE DUE DILIGENCE

Child Supervision & Babysitting:

Home Alone

Birth to age 9: No

Age 10-11: Yes, up to 4 hrs. in a 24-hr period (not overnight) w/access to adult

Age 12-13: Yes, up to 6 hrs. in a 24-hr period (not overnight) w/access to adult

Age 14-15: Yes, but not overnight. No longer than 9 hours with ready access to adult supervision

Age 16-17: Yes, no more than two consecutive overnight periods with access to adult supervision



Unattended Outside

Birth to age 5: No

Age 6-9: Yes, if in a playground/yard w/ immediate access to adult supervision (to include being within sight and hearing distance). Children 6 years old and older are exempt from the "outside unattended" rule when walking to and from school, school bus stop, or CYS activity. Walk cannot be longer than 1 mile or cross a busy street.

Age 10-11: Yes, with ready access to adult supervision. Sponsors checks on child or child checks in hourly. Adult must respond within 30 minutes or less to a child in crisis.

Age 12-13: Yes, with ready access to adult supervision. Sponsors checks on child or child checks in via phone or in person every 2 hrs., must know child's location/activity, and respond within 1hr .

Age 14-15: Yes, with access to adult supervision via phone within 2 hrs. Contact made every 3 hrs. Follow curfew.

Age 16-17: Yes, follow curfew guidance.

Babysitting Siblings & Other Children

Birth to 10: No

Age 11: Yes, may only care for siblings age 6 and older. Not to exceed 3 hrs.

Age 12-13: Up to 6 hrs. with access to adult.

Children must be age 2 and older.

Age 14-15: Up to 9 hrs. (not overnight) with access to adult. Non-siblings must be age 2 and older

Age 16-17: Yes

Unattended In Car

Birth to age 6): No

Age 7-9: Yes, up to 10 minutes if the keys have been removed and hand brake applied

Age 10-11: Yes, up to 20 minutes, keys removed and handbrake applied

Age 12-17: Yes

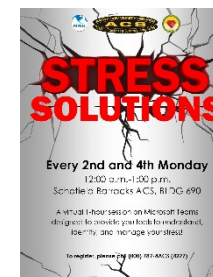
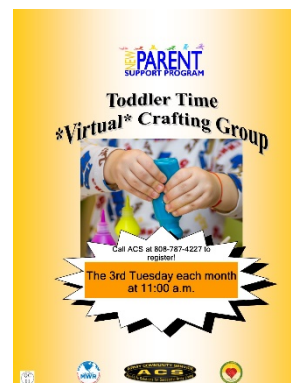
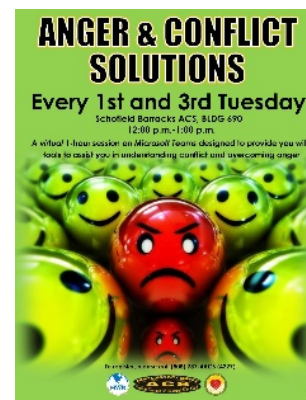

Army Family Housing - Tenant Bill of Rights

The Military Housing Privatization Initiative ***Tenant Bill of Rights*** requires the Garrison Housing Office provide a *Plain Language Brief* to all Tenants prior to lease signing for on-post housing.

1. All PCSing inbound personnel desiring on-post housing will receive a Plain Language Brief following their Temporary Lodging and Allowance (TLA) Brief given by the Housing Service Office (HSO). The briefing is intended to cover Tenant Bill of Rights and review Tenant Responsibilities. Additionally, prospective Tenants will be asked if they require a Housing Official to attend the pre-assessment walkthrough on their behalf. The Plain Language Brief is not required should a Tenant decide to reside off-post
2. At 15 days after signing for quarters, the Tenant will receive an email from the HSO soliciting feedback regarding their satisfaction with on-post housing.
3. At 30 days after signing for quarters, the Tenant will receive and invite from the HSO to attend the second required Plain Language Brief. The HSO gives the brief every 1st & 3rd Wednesday of the month, beginning at 2 p.m., at <https://conference.apps.mil/webconf/PlainLanguageBrief> or via phone bridge at (410) 874-6300, Pin 846132141.
4. At 60 days after signing for quarters, the Tenant will receive a final email from the HSO soliciting feedback regarding their overall satisfaction with on-post housing and the services rendered by Island Palms Communities.
