Q: AFAP Submissions Process Changes: Are there an updates in the Army Family Action Plan submission processes? (DFMWR)

- AFAP issues can be submitted year-round thru the Issue Management System in the Army Family Web Portal at https://ims.armyfamilywebportal.com/ (Anonymous submissions are no longer available which improves gathering of information to research issues.)
- AFAP submissions can also be made in person at Army Community Service during regular operating hours.

Q: Student Travel Information: What efforts are being made to streamline the service? (DHR)

- Family Travel Office streamlined the workflow process to give units greater autonomy in completing Student Travel actions by leveraging tools within IPPS-A and the Defense Travel System. More details are presented in DHR section of the CIE slides.

Q: Community Readiness Expo: What plans are there for upcoming and ongoing projects? (DFMWR/Replacement Co.)

- The DFMWR Weekly Community Readiness Expo is held at the 604 Banquet Center on Schofield Barracks on Thursdays from 9-11 a.m. A schedule of upcoming CRE's is presented in the DFMWR section of the CIE slides. Q: DPW Support Consolidation: What are the correct contact numbers for the Directorate of Public Works for repairs, outages, issues? (DPW)

- All others need to be submitted in the Army Maintenance Application (ArMA) https://home.army.mil/hawaii/garrison/dpw/work-orders
- Housing work orders need to be submitted to Island Palm Communities at 808-457-4075

Q: 24-Hour Gas Stations: Are there any enhancements of service availability? (AAFES)

- There are no plans at this time to have a 24-hour gas station on Schofield Barracks. The immediate customer enhancement once the Schofield Express w/gas reopens is that ALL grades of fuel will be available for purchase (premium, mid, regular unleaded and diesel). In addition, the dispensers will be new and fully functional.

Q: Speeding in School Zones: What is being done about speeding on base? (DES)

- DES and Military Police regularly monitor high traffic areas. When an issue is observed or reported, traffic units are placed in select locations to temporarily enforce speed limits. To report concerns of speeding in certain areas, please call the MP Desk at (808) 655-5555.

Q: Barracks: Can we get a barracks update on improvements and timely repairs? (DPW)

- Five barracks (three on Schofield and two on Fort Shafter) completed renovations in 2022 and 2023. Currently four barracks are under renovations on Schofield Barracks and Wheeler Army Airfield, with completion projected between 2025 and 2027. Two additional barracks are scheduled for renovations to start in 2024.



Bicycle/pedestrian accident statistics (National) Last 5 years

- 50% of fatalities occurred in limited visibility conditions
- 70% of fatalities occurred at non intersections
- 60% of fatalities and injuries involve persons under 25 years of age

Cause statistics (National) Last 5 years

- 25% are due to pedestrian/cyclist failure to yield
- 36% are due to vehicle operators failure to yield





Dependent Student Travel

Overview

 The Soldier is entitled to one Government funded round trip per fiscal year (1 October to 30 September) for his or her dependent student between the student's school and the sponsor's duty station or other such location to meet the Family for vacation, not to exceed the cost to the permanent duty station.

Eligibility

- Permanently Stationed OCONUS
- Command Sponsored
- Attending or will be attending a school in the United States to obtain a secondary (grades 9–12) or undergraduate college education
- An unmarried dependent child under 23 years old

Personnel Action Request (PAR) should be initiated in IPPS-A NET 60 days and NLT 30 days to projected travel date to allow ample processing time



What to Expect During Installation

Timeframe: ~3 weeks per "cluster" of 2-6 addresses

Electrical Work:

- A 2-hour power outage is necessary to connect the system to the grid and home.
- Residents will receive prior notice a minimum of 48 hours ahead of this scheduled power outage.

Preparatory Work:

- Ahead of work beginning, underground utilities will be identified and marked
- Exclusion zones will be set up first to ensure your safety, these will be identified by metal fencing or orange snow fencing.
 - For your safety, access to backyards and/or side-yards will be limited during work hours while this work is being performed.
 - Household members, including children and pets, must not enter the exclusion area during work hours: 8am – 5pm, M-F.
 - When safe to do so, at the end of the workday, crews will open the backyard exclusion zone areas to allow for your use during the evenings and on weekends / holidays.

Roof Work:

Workers will be on the roof installing solar panels which will require them to go up and down
in a lift, generating equipment noise as well as the pitter-patter of work-boots on the roof.


 Workers will also install electrical equipment on the back and/or side yards of your home and garage which may be noisy due to power-tools.

Dirt / Yard Work:

 The workers will need to dig trenches in your backyard or side yard to connect the systems together. This may be loud due to digging machinery and other power tools.



Know the Rules

A **10-hour child care limit** has been established by the Department of the Army to protect children from being in unregulated child care settings on a regular basis.

This means any Family member living in Government Quarters providing child care for more than 10 hours per week on a regular basis may be penalized.









Home-Based Business (HBB) On-Post Housing, USAG-HI



Requirements to Become a HBB



- ✓ HBBs Applicants must obtain approval from the USAG-HI, Garrison Commander.
- ✓ HBBs are required to comply with and are subject to inspection by the appropriate city, county, state, or USAG-HI, Federal agency, office or department for compliance with applicable laws, codes, regulations and requirements.
- ✓ HBBs DOES NOT pertain to <u>on-post home childcare</u>. Interest in providing childcare in on-post housing must register, receive training, complete background checks and home inspections, as well as receive certification by the installation Child, Youth, and School (CYS) Services office as part of the Family Child Care (FCC) provider system. Contact CYS Office at (808) 655-1521.
- ✓ Exceptions: If you work remotely from your home or exclusively through online means, you probably don't need approval. Contact the Business and Nonprofit Liaison to review proposed business.


