CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH



All “LEADERS” as well as all installation law enforcement personnel, physicians, nurses, social workers, school personnel, Child Development Center (CDC) and Child and Youth Services (CYS) personnel, psychologists and other Medical personnel WILL report information about known and suspected cases of child and spouse abuse to the Reporting Point Of Contact (RPOC) as soon as information is received.

Every Soldier, employee, and member of the military community should be ENCOURAGED to report information about known or suspected cases of spouse and child abuse to the reporting point of contact (RPOC) or the appropriate military law enforcement agency as soon as the information is received.




COMMUNITY INFORMATION EXCHANGE

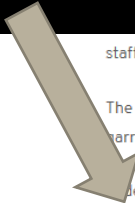
ABOUT U.S. ARMY GARRISON HAWAII

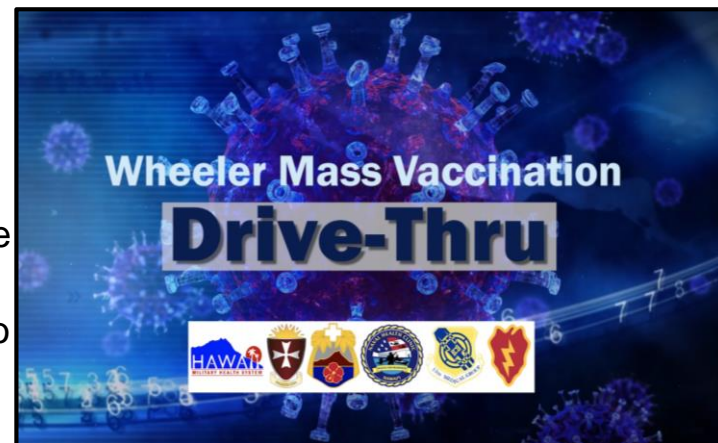

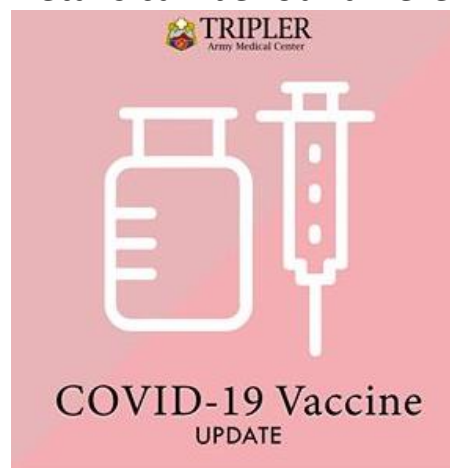

World Immunization Week - April 24-30

- COVID-19 vaccines were evaluated in tens of thousands of participants in clinical trials and met the FDA's rigorous scientific safety standards for Emergency Use Authorization
- Over 92 million doses of COVID-19 vaccine were administered in the United States from December 14, 2020, through March 8, 2021
- All eligible persons are strongly urged to receive the COVID-19 vaccination
- This was also one of the lowest seasons on record for flu cases – likely due to both higher flu vaccination rates, and measures taken to reduce COVID-19 spread

COVID-19 VOLUNTEER RESEARCH STUDY

PURPOSE:

To better understand the risk factors for COVID-19 and its impact on the health of military beneficiaries.

YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IF YOU MEET EITHER OF THESE CRITERIA:

- Have been tested or meet criteria for COVID-19 testing according to CDC guidelines
- Have received vaccine for the virus that causes COVID-19

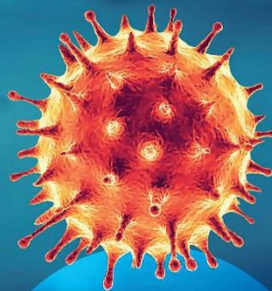
- DoD Beneficiary (Active Duty, Non-Active Duty, or Beneficiary)
- At least 18 years of age
- Able to receive and respond to emails and complete online questionnaires

WHAT'S INVOLVED:

- Today: Visit [EPICC.USUHS.EDU](https://epicc.usuhs.edu) to complete a voluntary online consent and a questionnaire (about 20 minutes).
 - If selected, we may also ask you to collect a small blood sample at home (a few drops from your fingertip or arm) using a simple kit and instructions that we provide.
- 1, 3, 6, 9, and 12 months from now:
 - Complete online questionnaire that takes about 10 minutes. We will send you a reminder with the web link as it gets closer to the time.
 - If selected, we may also ask you to collect a small blood sample at home (a few drops from your fingertip or arm) using a simple kit and instructions that we provide.
- Compensation will be provided for your participation in accordance with DoD 3216.02.

All visitors must reside in the same household as the patient and make every effort to limit their movement around the hospital.

1 adult visitor per day for:

- Inpatients
- Surgical patients
- Outpatient clinic appointments

2 adult visitors per day for:

- Pediatric Inpatient Ward
- Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU)
- Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU)
- Labor & Delivery
- Mother-Baby Unit

Visitors under the age of 18 are not permitted.

Unauthorized Child Care



If you provide **more than ten hours of on-post child care a week** and have not been certified as a Family Child Care Provider your sponsor (military member) and you can be penalized.

- Military members who knowingly allow unauthorized child care in their quarters may be subject to discipline under the UCMJ or adverse administrative action under U.S. Army Hawaii Regulation 1.
- •Offenses could result in debarment (losing installation access and privileges) from US Army Hawaii military installations.
 - •Major Violations of the Resident Occupancy Agreement or the “Island Palm Communities Resident Guide & Community Standards Handbook” of a serious nature may result in immediate eviction.

Unauthorized Child Care

Ten Hour Rule – You Can Still Be Neighborly

It's okay to be neighborly and the “ten hour rule” does not eliminate “good neighbor” favors!

Examples of occasional care that does not occur on a regular basis.

Regular basis means routinely for an extended period of time.

- You can host a sleepover in your home with your children's friends.
- You can care for your neighbors children in your home overnight as a favor while they enjoy a weekend get-away.
- You can care your friend's children while they attend an appointment.
- You can be on a Family Care Plan for a friend or family member and provide care for their children when they are called away for weekend training or temporary duty.

Unauthorized child care settings do not apply to care being provided to your children in your own home.

Home Alone

Birth to age 9: No

Age 10-11: Yes, up to 4 hrs. in a 24-hr period (not overnight) w/access to adult

Age 12-13: Yes, up to 6 hrs. in a 24-hr period (not overnight) w/access to adult

Age 14-15: Yes, but not overnight. No longer than 9 hours with ready access to adult supervision

Age 16-17: Yes, no more than two consecutive overnight periods with access to adult supervision



Unattended Outside

Birth to age 5: No

Age 6-9: Yes, if in a playground/yard w/ immediate access to adult supervision (to include being within sight and hearing distance). Children 6 years old and older are exempt from the "outside unattended" rule when walking to and from school, school bus stop, or CYS activity. Walk cannot be longer than 1 mile or cross a busy street.

Age 10-11: Yes, with ready access to adult supervision. Sponsors checks on child or child checks in hourly. Adult must respond within 30 minutes or less to a child in crisis.

Age 12-13: Yes, with ready access to adult supervision. Sponsors checks on child or child checks in via phone or in person every 2 hrs., must know child's location/activity, and respond within 1hr .

Age 14-15: Yes, with access to adult supervision via phone within 2 hrs. Contact made every 3 hrs. Follow curfew.

Age 16-17: Yes, follow curfew guidance.

Babysitting Siblings & Other Children

Birth to 10: No

Age 11: Yes, may only care for siblings age 6 and older. Not to exceed 3 hrs.

Age 12-13: Up to 6 hrs. with access to adult.

Children must be age 2 and older.

Age 14-15: Up to 9 hrs. (not overnight) with access to adult. Non-siblings must be age 2 and older

Age 16-17: Yes

Unattended In Car

Birth to age 6): No

Age 7-9: Yes, up to 10 minutes if the keys have been removed and hand brake applied

Age 10-11: Yes, up to 20 minutes, keys removed and handbrake applied

Age 12-17: Yes

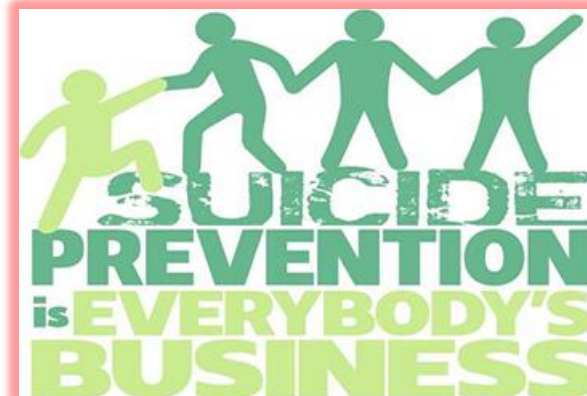

Total Army Sponsorship Program

- Sponsorship is **required** in order to process permanent change of station (PCS) orders to Hawaii and other regions.
- **Soldiers (E1-O6)**
 - ✓ Soldiers must log onto the Army Career Trackers Total Army Sponsorship Program to initiate DA Form 5434 and request a sponsor.
 - ✓ Units are required to assign a sponsor 120 days prior to report date.
- **Department of Army Civilians**
 - ✓ DA Civilians can fill out the PDF version of the DA Form 5434 and email it to their gaining organization.
- **ACS Sponsorship Classes**
 - Classes held every Thursday at 1200 hrs via MS TEAMS.
 - Required for all assigned sponsors and volunteers.

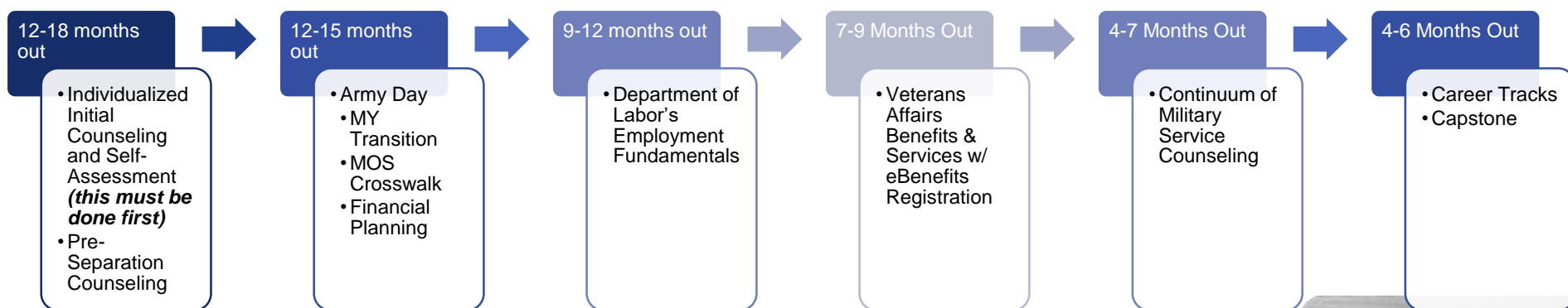


Transition Assistance Program (TAP)

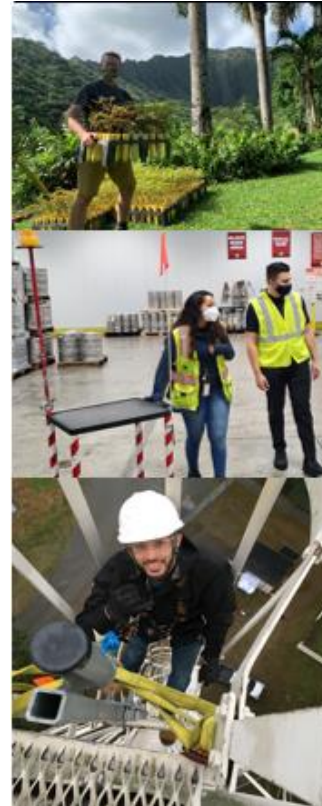

Reassignment Office

- Process & Publish the Following:
 - ✓ PCS Orders
 - ✓ IPCOT/COT Travel Orders
 - ✓ Excess Leave Orders
 - ✓ Confinement Transfer Orders
 - ✓ Deletion or Deferment of Assignments- Non PSDR units
- Levy Notifications are sent within 5 days of MPD receiving notification of assignment via CAP Cycle. MPD notifies via email to the Soldier, S1, and SGM/CSM. Soldiers are to complete the Levy Packet NLT 30 days from notification.
- Orders are published up to 6 Months from departure date, if all required documents are submitted to include the PCS ETP. S1 submits completed Levy Packets to:
usarmy.schofield.id-pacific.list.reassignments-hi@mail.mil
- Reassignments Office provides S1's and SGM/CSMs a Missing Documents log weekly.
- It is Army policy that if an individual has a government travel card, it will be used for all relocation expenses up to the limit of their entitlements. A centrally billed account is only available for Soldiers who do not have a government travel card. Account type must be indicated to Reassignments Office prior to orders being cut.

Family Travel Office

Due to the COVID travel restrictions, the process to request orders for all Government Funded Travel now requires additional steps. (Early Return of Dependent, Dependent Travel, Space A Travel and Student Travel.)

All Government Funded Travel requests are processed as follows:

1. Service Member submits the packet to their Chain of Command (packet checklists provided on the Garrison Webpage)
2. Chain of Command submits the packet to Schofield Family Travel Section Military-Personnel Division (SFTS-MPD)
3. After tentatively approving the request for travel, the SFTS-MPD provides the S-1 a Memorandum to be used as a justification to request a Travel Exception to Policy (ETP) signed by the first General Officer in the Chain of Command.
4. Chain of Command submits the signed ETP to SFTS-MPD
5. SFTS-MPD then provides the final order to S-1 and Service Member

Transportation and Carlson Wagon-lit (SATO) will require a copy of the final orders and signed Travel ETP to book HHG shipments and flights
