



Spouse Professional Licensure – HB 961

Bill was signed by Gov. David Ige, May 25

- Allows military spouses in specific professions to apply for licensure on an expedited basis in Hawaii.
- Exempts spouses from requirement to be State residents to apply for jobs with the State

Thefts

- There have been 81 reported larcenies on USAG-HI installations since the beginning of the year
- The majority of the thefts occur during nighttime hours.
- The majority of the thefts are crimes of opportunity involving unsecured and unattended property.

Prevention

- Lock all house doors, windows, and garages when unattended (especially at night).
- Do not leave valuables out! Lock them up out of sight.
- Call the Military Police if you see anything suspicious. This
 includes individuals testing door handles, looking into cars
 and homes, or looking over house fences.

Speeding

- Operation Slow Down is still in effect Monday through Friday (0630 – 0800) on Schofield.
- Military Police issued 69 traffic tickets for speed-related offenses this quarter.
- Speed is a significant factor in serious traffic accidents on our installations.

Prevention

 Leave early and anticipate delays, especially during PT hours.

Vehicle Registration Update

- U.S Army Hawaii Soldiers, family members, and Department of the Army civilians assigned to
 organizations, and anyone living on an Army installation in Hawaii are required to register their privately
 owned vehicles with the garrison
- Fort DeRussy, Pililaau Army Recreation Center and Tripler Army Medical Center are excluded from the vehicle registration requirement.
 - Anyone assigned to a unit or office headquartered on Fort DeRussy, Pililaau Army Recreation Center or Tripler Army Medical Center does not need to register their vehicle (unless they fall into another category, such as living on another Army installation)
 - Soldiers or families who live on Tripler do not need to register their vehicles unless they are assigned to an Army unit or officer on another Army installation.

Unauthorized Child Care Ten Hour Rule – You Can Still Be Neighborly

It's okay to be neighborly and the "ten hour rule" does not eliminate "good neighbor" favors!

Examples of <u>occasional</u> care that does <u>not</u> occur on a <u>regular basis</u>. Regular basis means <u>routinely</u> for an <u>extended period of time</u>.

- You can host a sleepover in your home with your children's friends.
- You can care for your neighbors children in your home overnight as a favor while they enjoy a weekend get-away.
- You can care your friend's children while they attend an appointment.
- You can be on a Family Care Plan for a friend or family member and provide care for their children when they are called away for weekend training or temporary duty.

Age 10-11: Yes, up to 4 hrs. in a 24-hr period (not overnight) w/access to adult

Age 12-13: Yes, up to 6 hrs. in a 24-hr period (not overnight) w/access to adult

Age 14-15: Yes, but not overnight. No longer than 9 hours with ready access to adult supervision Age 16-17: Yes, no more than two consecutive overnight periods with access to adult supervision



Unattended Outside

Birth to age 5: No

Age 6-9: Yes, if in a playground/yard w/ immediate access to adult supervision (to include being within sight and hearing distance). Children 6 years old and older are exempt from the "outside unattended" rule when walking to and from school, school bus stop, or CYS activity. Walk cannot be longer than 1 mile or cross a busy street.

Age 10-11: Yes, with ready access to adult supervision. Sponsors checks on child or child checks in hourly. Adult must respond within 30 minutes or less to a child in crisis.

Age 12-13: Yes, with ready access to adult supervision. Sponsors checks on child or child checks in via phone or in person every 2 hrs., must know child's location/activity, and respond within 1hr.

Age 14-15: Yes, with access to adult supervision via phone within 2 hrs. Contact made every 3 hrs. Follow curfew.

Age 16-17: Yes, follow curfew guidance.

Babysitting Siblings & Other Children

Birth to 10: No

Age 11: Yes, may only care for siblings age 6 and older. Not to exceed 3 hrs.

Age 12-13: Up to 6 hrs. with access to adult.

Children must be age 2 and older.

Age 14-15: Up to 9 hrs. (not overnight) with access

to adult. Non-siblings must be age 2 and older

Birth to age 6): No





- It is Army policy that if an individual has a government travel card, it will be used for all relocation expenses up to the limit of their entitlements. A centrally billed account is only available for Soldiers who do not have a government travel card. Account type must be indicated to Reassignments Office prior to orders being cut.

DHR - Family Travel Office

Due to the COVID travel restrictions, the process to request orders for all Government Funded Travel now requires additional steps. (Early Return of Dependent, Dependent Travel, Space A Travel and Student Travel.)

All Government Funded Travel requests are processed as follows:

- 1. Service Member submits the packet to their Chain of Command (packet checklists provided on the Garrison Webpage)
- 2. Chain of Command submits the packet to Schofield Family Travel Section Military-Personnel Division (SFTS-MPD)
- 3. After tentatively approving the request for travel, the SFTS-MPD provides the S-1 a Memorandum to be used as a justification to request a Travel Exception to Policy (ETP) signed by the first General Officer in the Chain of Command.
- 4. Chain of Command submits the signed ETP to SFTS-MPD
- 5. SFTS-MPD then provides the final order to S-1 and Service Member

Transportation and Carlson Wagon-lit (SATO) will require a copy of the final orders and signed Travel ETP to book HHG shipments and flights

Early Return of Dependents

•Only used for unusual/emergency circumstances like marital difficulties, financial difficulties, divorce, hardship, etc.

Dependent Travel

 The Soldier acquired a Family member (married) before the effective date of the PCS order & is entitled to transportation of the Family member at Government expense.

Space Available Travel

• Soldier acquired a Family member (married) after the effective date of the PCS order and is not entitled to transpiration of Family members at Government expense but may be authorized space-available transportation once command sponsorship is approved by the overseas command.

Command Sponsorship


