- Regular updates will be provided via social media and at your Community Center










How to get your PCS orders.

Step 1 – Attend Levy Brief within 30 calendar days of assignment notification. (BLDG 750, Thursdays at 0900 on the Lanai)

Step 2 – Submit Packet within 30 days of attendance

Reassignment Checklist

IPPS-A member elections

Proof of Command Sponsorship if applicable

Step 3 – Family Travel Preparation (OCONUS Only) Family Member Travel Screening DA For 4787 DA Form 5121 DA Form 4036

Step 4 – Submit completed levy packet via IPPS-A PAR (Admin Records Correction > Other > Enter "Levy Packet". Packet will route to the S1 Pool, S1 to MPD **Orders will be published within 10 business days**

- The goal is for Soldiers to have orders in hand NLT 120 days prior to report date.
- Upon receipt of orders, Soldier should visit Transportation to schedule HHG and the Passport office if going to another OCONUS Location.

Army Field Support Battalion-Hawaii (AFSBn-HAW) PCS Peak Season (14MAR-01SEP25)

Personal Property Processing Office (PPPO) (1of2)

□ CHALLENGES

- Limited moving vendors on-island (10 companies).
- Reducing customer wait times and processing during PCS peak season.
- Customers coming in without orders or receiving their orders late.

□ ACTIONS TO MITIGATE PEAK SEASON OPTEMPO

- Mass PCS group counseling on Wednesdays & Fridays.
- Fridays reserved strictly for group counseling (No Walk-ins).
- Workstations increased from 2-4 for service members to set up their *MOVE.MIL* accounts.
- Service members should have PCS Orders on hand IOT be assisted.

□ SATO Office

- Priority given to PCS, ETS & Emergency leave for servicemembers and their families.
- TDY processing should be done in DTS as much as possible or calling the helpdesk @ 888-435-7146.

ITO Ask

- Customer patience.
- Treat PPPO staff with dignity and respect.
- HHG pickup is scheduled by the Joint Personnel Property Shipping Office (JPPSO) not PPPO staff.



Army Field Support Battalion-Hawaii (AFSBn-HAW) PCS Peak Season (14MAR-01SEP25)

Personal Property Processing Office (PPPO) (2of2)

- □ What impact to the family move process due to current RIF and hiring freeze?
 - No impact to the PCS process due to Reduction in Force (RIF) as DA Civilian levels remain unchanged currently.
 - New EAGLE contract started on 05FEB25. PPPO currently has 3 Counselors and 3 QAQC personnel to process all PCS/ETS packets.
 - Appointment is currently booked 3 weeks out with priority for Category 1 & 2 Threat to Life, Blue Bark, and SHARP personnel. Booking time is subject to change as the PCS season begins.
- □ What will be the average customer wait-time for HHG movement?
 - At the height of peak season FY24, longest wait times was 7 ¹/₂ weeks for HHG pack up/pick up
 - Average wait time is 2.5 weeks, and it's expected to surpass 7.5 weeks at the peak of the season for FY25.

- Expect an increase of Fire and Emergency Service personnel/vehicles in the Schofield Range areas







BE SAFE AND SMART!

A LETTER OF REPRIMAND FOR A DUI MAY BE THE LEAST OF YOUR WORRIES!

You will be issued a General Office Memorandum of Reprimand if you:

- Are convicted by a court, or receive NJP,
- for an offense of drunk/impaired driving;
- Refuse to take, or failure to complete field sobriety tests;
- Driving or being in physical control of a motor vehicle with a BAC of .08 or higher on or off post, irrespective of other charges; or
- Driving or being in physical control of a motor vehicle on or off the installation when lawfully conducted chemical tests reflect the presence of illegal drugs




