

Spouse Reimbursement Program

State Licensure and Certification Costs for the Spouse of a Soldier Arising From a Permanent Change of Station. Effective Date: The policy found in Army Dir 2019-18 is effective retroactively to the date of the NDAA 2018 (12 December 2017)

Eligibility

- U.S. Regular Army, Army National Guard and Army Reserve Soldiers whose spouse require a State relicensing or recertification to continue their profession in a new place of residence pursuant to the PCS or permanent change of assignment of a sponsor from one State to another State
 - ✓ The Soldier is reassigned, either as a PCS or Permanent Change of Assignment, from a duty station in one state to a duty station in another state
 - ✓ The movement of the Soldier's dependents is authorized at the expense of the United States as part of reassignment, IAW the PCS orders
- Qualified Relicensing Cost Term "Qualified relicensing cost" means cost, including examination and registration fees, that are imposed by the state of the new duty station to secure a license or certification to engage in same profession the Soldier's spouse engaged in while in the state of the original duty station and are paid or incurred by the Soldier or spouse to secure the license or certification from the state of the new duty station after the date on which the orders directing the reassignment are issued.

√ Spouse Reimbursement Program

- How do Soldiers apply for reimbursement? By visiting their unit S-1 and providing at a minimum, the following support documents
 - ♣ Standard Form (SF) 1034
 - Copy of Permanent Change of Station orders
 - Copy of Spouse's previous state license and/or certification (<u>is NOT required to have held the license in the immediately preceding duty station state</u>. So long as the spouse, while married to the soldier, held the <u>license at any prior duty station state</u>)
 - Copy of new state license and/or certification (an approval letter from the certifying agency, which must include license number and date is acceptable
 - ♣ Proof of fees paid for relicensing and/or recertification from current permanent duty station

NOTE: The Unit S-1 will ensure the soldier's name is on the SF 1034, not the spouse's; verify marriage to a civilian spouse through the interactive personnel electronics records management system (iPERMS)

Reimbursement

- Qualified relicensing costs provided to a soldier may not exceed the amount established by applicable law, \$1,000.
- This is taxable income. DFAS will issue a separate W-2 during tax season and will be available on the Soldier's MyPay account

IAW with the FY2020 NDAA, the authority to provide reimbursement expires on 31 December 2024



Home-Based Business (HBB) On-Post Housing, USAG-HI



Requirements to Become a HBB



Oct. 27, 2022

- HBBs Applicants must obtain approval from the USAG-HI, Garrison Commander.
- HBBs are required to comply with and are subject to inspection by the appropriate city, county, state, or USAG-HI, Federal agency, office or department for compliance with applicable laws, codes, regulations and requirements.
- HBBs DOES NOT pertain to on-post home childcare. Interest in providing childcare in on-post housing must register, receive training, complete background checks and home inspections, as well as receive certification by the installation Child, Youth, and School (CYS) Services office as part of the Family Child Care (FCC) provider system. Contact CYS Office at (808) 655-1521.
- Exceptions: If you work remotely from your home or exclusively through online means, you probably don't need approval. Contact the Business and Nonprofit Liaison to review proposed business.





Urgent Care Center

- Our Urgent Care Center is experiencing an increase in wait times.
- Tricare beneficiaries have several options for same-day care, including:
 - <u>DrOnDemand</u> 24/7 access to a licensed provider from any web-connected device. Simply download the app, enter the required information, and you're set! Soldiers require a referral.
 Dependents do not require a referral.
 - <u>Tricare Nurse Advice Line</u> 24/7 access to a licensed nurse who can provide medical advice. Call 1-800-874-2273, Option 1 to speak to a nurse.
 - Secure Message your Provider send your provider a secure message through the MHS Genesis Patient Portal. Providers typically reply within 24-48 hours.

- Orders are published up to <u>6 Months</u> from departure date, if all required documents are submitted to include the PCS ETP. S1 submits completed Levy Packets to: usarmy.schofield.id-pacific.list.reassignments-hi@mail.mil
- Reassignments Office provides S1's and SGM/CSMs a Missing Documents log weekly.
- It is Army policy that if an individual has a government travel card, it will be used for all relocation expenses up to the limit of their entitlements. A centrally billed account is only available for Soldiers who do not have a government travel card. Account type must be indicated to Reassignments Office prior to orders being cut.

DHR - Family Travel Office

Due to the COVID travel restrictions, the process to request orders for all Government Funded Travel now requires additional steps. (Early Return of Dependent, Dependent Travel, Space A Travel and Student Travel.)

All Government Funded Travel requests are processed as follows:

- 1. Service Member submits the packet to their Chain of Command (packet checklists provided on the Garrison Webpage)
- 2. Chain of Command submits the packet to Schofield Family Travel Section Military-Personnel Division (SFTS-MPD)
- 3. After tentatively approving the request for travel, the SFTS-MPD provides the S-1 a Memorandum to be used as a justification to request a Travel Exception to Policy (ETP) signed by the first General Officer in the Chain of Command.
- 4. Chain of Command submits the signed ETP to SFTS-MPD
- 5. SFTS-MPD then provides the final order to S-1 and Service Member

Transportation and Carlson Wagon-lit (SATO) will require a copy of the final orders and signed Travel ETP to book HHG shipments and flights

Early Return of Dependents

 Only used for unusual/emergency circumstances like marital difficulties, financial difficulties, divorce, hardship, etc.

Dependent Travel

 The Soldier acquired a Family member (married) before the effective date of the PCS order & is entitled to transportation of the Family member at Government expense.

Space Available Travel

•Soldier acquired a Family member (married) after the effective date of the PCS order and is not entitled to transpiration of Family members at Government expense but may be authorized space-available transportation once command sponsorship is approved by the overseas command.

Command Sponsorship

- Must meet eligibility requirements to qualify 36-month tour or 12 months remaining after approval
- Dependent(s) must be on island to qualify
- Exceptions given for bona fide local residents

Student Travel

- An entitlement for Command Sponsored children of Active-Duty Soldiers stationed overseas (Hawaii) who are full time students attending an accredited college/university.
- One fully-funded round trip per fiscal year for dependent student between the student's school and the sponsor's duty station.
- Application should be submitted no later than 60 days
