SMOKE TESTING SEWER LINES

Underground Services, Inc., a subcontractor to Aqua Engineers, Inc., is conducting smoke testing of the sanitary sewer system.

Work crews will be in your area - Wheeler Army Airfield

Beginning July 20, 2022 for approximately 2 weeks (August 2, 2022)

A "SMOKE TEST" survey will assist our inspection crews in locating breaks and defects in our sewer system. The smoke you see coming from the vent stacks on houses or holes in the ground is NON-TOXIC, NON-STAINING, HAS NO ODOR, WHITE TO GRAY IN COLOR AND CREATES NO FIRE HAZARD.

The smoke should not enter your home unless you have defective plumbing or dried up drain traps.

It is advisable for the resident of each home to pour a gallon of water into each floor drain a minimum of 1 hour prior to scheduled testing. If smoke enters your home, there is good reason to assume that an improper sewer connection has been made for your home or business, which should be corrected by the responsible agency. In the event that smoke enters your home during the testing, you are advised to notify our work crew and/or Aqua Engineers, Inc. at 808-240-2207 and open windows to increase ventilation of the building. If you are not home during the scheduled testing and discover smoke when you return, please call Aqua Engineers, Inc.

Smoke used for testing is not harmful to pets, those with raspatory problems, or immobile individuals. In the event that any discomfort is experienced due to smoke entering your building, you are advised to vacate the area and find an area that is free of smoke.

What:

 IPC installed new higher efficiency A/C systems with smart thermostats and recently made adjustments to the thermostats establishing a low-end threshold of 72 degrees or above



Hawaii Vehicle Registration

- Vehicles must be registered within 30 days of arriving in Hawaii. You'll need:
 - Current out-of-state registration
 - Title/lien information
 - Shipping documents with vehicle identification number (VIN)
 - Failed safety inspection certificate (after you register your vehicle, the safety check station will issue your valid inspection emblem and certificate)
 - Completed Non Resident or Resident Certificate (CS-L (MVR) 50 or CS-L (MVR) 50A)
 - To keep your out-of-state plates: Out-of-state permit application form CS-L (MVR) 27, which are available at the satellite city hall or motor vehicle registration office
- Engage your unit S1 for Non Resident or Resident Certificate
 - Form lowers service members' registration fees to \$20.50 for non residents or \$72.50 for Hawaii residents instead of a fee based on vehicle's weight

 - 1st: \$15 \$35
 - 2nd w/in one year: \$35 \$75
 - 3rd w/in one year: \$75 \$99. (Rev. Ord. Hon. Sec. 15-24.23)
- ✓ Under 21 years old cannot purchase or possess any tobacco products or electronic smoking devices:
 - \$10 first offense
 - \$50 subsequent offenses
 - Or 48-72 hours of community service. (HRS § 712-1258)








DHR - Career Skills Program

DHR - Reassignment Office

- Process & Publish the Following:
 - ✓ PCS Orders
 - ✓ IPCOT/COT Travel Orders
 - ✓ Excess Leave Orders
 - ✓ Confinement Transfer Orders
 - ✓ Deletion or Deferment of Assignments- Non PSDR units



- Levy Notifications are sent within 5 days of MPD receiving notification of assignment via CAP Cycle. MPD
 notifies via email to the Soldier, S1, and SGM/CSM. Soldiers are to complete the Levy Packet NLT 30 days
 from notification.
- Orders are published up to <u>6 Months</u> from departure date, if all required documents are submitted to include the PCS ETP. S1 submits completed Levy Packets to: <u>usarmy.schofield.id-pacific.list.reassignments-hi@mail.mil</u>
- Reassignments Office provides S1's and SGM/CSMs a Missing Documents log weekly.
- It is Army policy that if an individual has a government travel card, it will be used for all relocation expenses up to the limit of their entitlements. A centrally billed account is only available for Soldiers who do not have a government travel card. Account type must be indicated to Reassignments Office prior to orders being cut.

DHR - Family Travel Office

Due to the COVID travel restrictions, the process to request orders for all Government Funded Travel now requires additional steps. (Early Return of Dependent, Dependent Travel, Space A Travel and Student Travel.)

All Government Funded Travel requests are processed as follows:

- 1. Service Member submits the packet to their Chain of Command (packet checklists provided on the Garrison Webpage)
- 2. Chain of Command submits the packet to Schofield Family Travel Section Military-Personnel Division (SFTS-MPD)
- 3. After tentatively approving the request for travel, the SFTS-MPD provides the S-1 a Memorandum to be used as a justification to request a Travel Exception to Policy (ETP) signed by the first General Officer in the Chain of Command.
- 4. Chain of Command submits the signed ETP to SFTS-MPD
- 5. SFTS-MPD then provides the final order to S-1 and Service Member

Transportation and Carlson Wagon-lit (SATO) will require a copy of the final orders and signed Travel ETP to book HHG shipments and flights

Early Return of Dependents

 Only used for unusual/emergency circumstances like marital difficulties, financial difficulties, divorce, hardship, etc.

Dependent Travel

 The Soldier acquired a Family member (married) before the effective date of the PCS order & is entitled to transportation of the Family member at Government expense.

Space Available Travel

•Soldier acquired a Family member (married) after the effective date of the PCS order and is not entitled to transpiration of Family members at Government expense but may be authorized space-available transportation once command sponsorship is approved by the overseas command.

Command Sponsorship

- Must meet eligibility requirements to qualify 36-month tour or 12 months remaining after approval
- Dependent(s) must be on island to qualify
- Exceptions given for bona fide local residents

Student Travel

- An entitlement for Command Sponsored children of Active-Duty Soldiers stationed overseas (Hawaii) who are full time students attending an accredited college/university.
- One fully-funded round trip per fiscal year for dependent student between the student's school and the sponsor's duty station.
- Application should be submitted no later than 60 days
