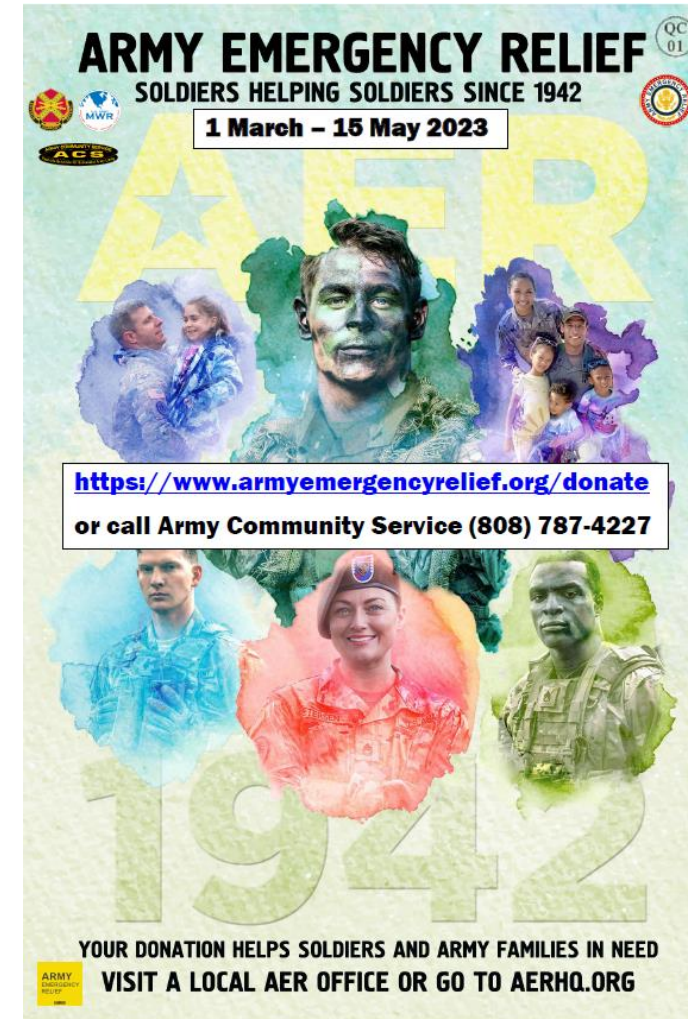


Army Emergency Relief

Family Travel

OCONUS to OCONUS moves & Command Sponsorship

❖ E-EFMP (Medical Screening)

- <https://efmp.army.mil/EnterpriseEfmp/>
- Required for all dependents traveling OCONUS
- Dependent Travel and Command Sponsorship
- Travel orders processing

❖ Dependent Travel/Command Sponsorship

Dependent Travel

- The Soldier acquired a Family member (married) before the effective date of the PCS order & is entitled to transportation of the Family member at Government expense.

Command Sponsorship

- Must meet eligibility requirements to qualify 36-month tour or 12 months remaining after approval
- Dependent(s) must be on island to qualify
- Exceptions given for bona fide local residents

❖ Outbound Assignments (Transoceanic Travel of dependents on PCS orders)

- Streamlines assignment order process
 - HRC->Soldier->MPD->Soldier
- Members Elections
- Soldiers will have the ability to print their PCS orders from IPPS-A

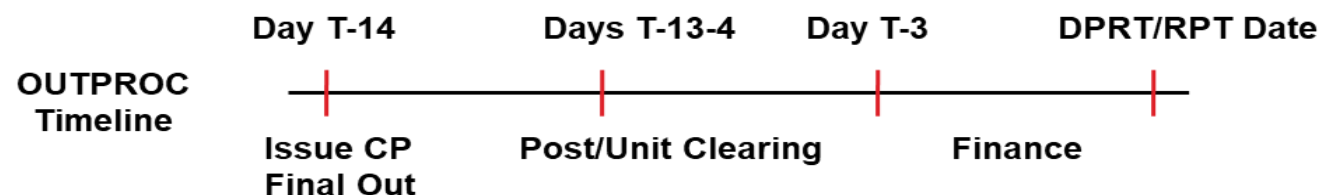

4 Overall Steps to Installation/Unit Clearance





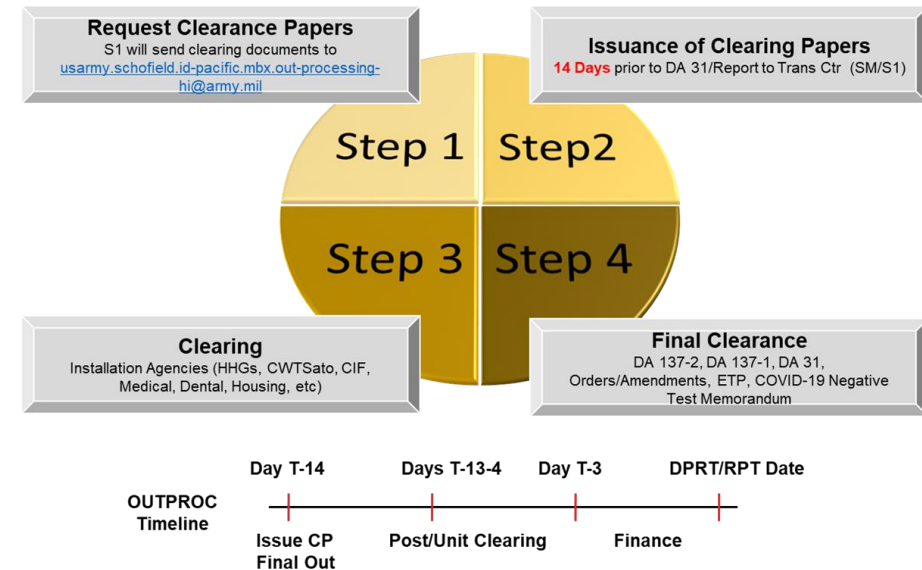

Family Member Out-Processing for a Absence Service Member

- Family members require a Special Power of Attorney (SPOA) stating the Soldier authorizes the Family member to clear the Installation (DA 137-2).
- Unit Commanders must designate a Service Member to clear the Unit (DA 137-1) in the absence of a Service Member.
- Family member should have multiple copies of orders, any amendments, and DA-31.

4 Overall Steps to Installation/Unit Clearance



***SM cannot out-process if they have exceeded their Separation Date**

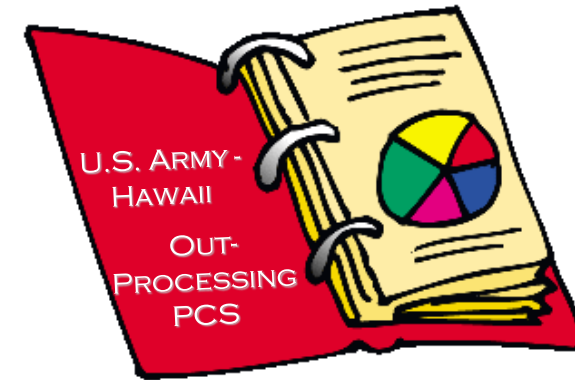




Out Processing

Installation/Unit Clearance

- ❑ All Soldiers within 30 days of Approved DA 31 Start Date
 - ISSUANCE of CLEARANCE PAPERS
 - 14 Days prior to DA 31 Start Date
 - Soldiers do not need clearing papers to initiate House Hold Goods or Plane Tickets
- ❑ Unit Commanders must designate a Service Member to clear the Installation and Unit (DA 137-2, DA 137-1) in the absence of a Service Member.

Preparing for PCS Moves

- ✓ EFMP Family Support provides customized assistance and warm-handovers to connect outgoing EFMP Families with gaining installation resources.
- ✓ Soldiers should attend Levy Briefing and complete the EFMP Family Needs Assessment to initiate their warm hand off.
- ✓ Keep EFMP enrollment info current – Submit EFMP renewal packet at efmp.army.mil if there's a change in condition, or if set to expire (enrollments are good for 3 years)
- ✓ ALL accompanied OCONUS to OCONUS tours require command sponsorship (submit for Family Travel Screening at efmp.army.mil)
- ✓ EFMP Family Support's Sensory Lending Closet Kits
 - Borrow Sensory Items for up to 30 days (weighted blankets, sensory socks, pressure foam rollers)

Know the Rules

A **10-hour child care limit** has been established by the Department of the Army to protect children from being in unregulated child care settings on a regular basis.

This means **any Family member living in government quarters** providing child care for more than 10 child care hours per week on a regular basis **may be penalized**.

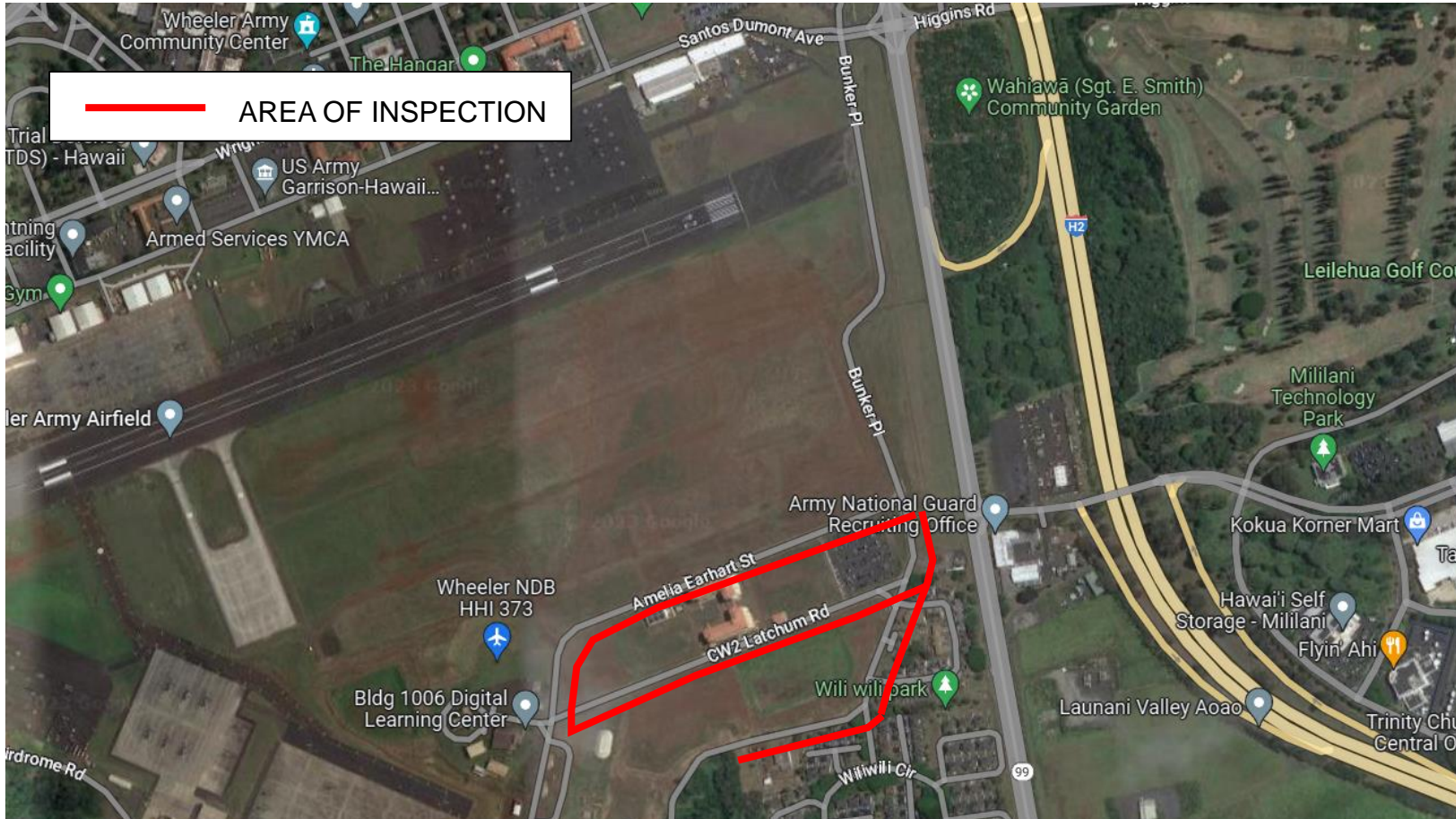

- ✓ Please give your Landlord or On-post community center 30 Days written notice to vacate your home once you received your orders to leave the PDS Vicinity.
- ✓ Need assistance with giving appropriate notice to end your housing agreement?

Temporary Lodging Allowance (TLA)

- ✓ Eligibility
 - Service members who are single E6 and above
 - Service members with command sponsored dependent(s)
 - Service member with a valid Certificate of Non-availability (CNA)
 - NOTE: If your CNA is expired, see your Barracks Unit Representative ASAP
- ✓ Departure TLA:
 - May be authorized for the last 10 days the Service member is on island.
 - TLA is NOT paid for any day the Service member is on leave
 - Household goods must be picked up
 - Flight Itinerary required
 - A Service member who retires or separates from service and stays in the PDS and moves at a later date is not eligible for TLA
 - If you are leaving your command sponsored dependent(s) on island, a Secretarial Waiver is needed for your dependents to receive Departure TLA

Move-Out Basics

Notice to Vacate

- Must provide written notice (minimum of a 28-Day Notice to Vacate)
- Notice must be signed by service member or someone with SPOA

Schedule final move-out assessment

- Clean home per the Move Out Guide
 - Forward mail/provide Community Center new address
 - All trash and bulk items should be removed & bins cleaned
 - Pay outstanding balances
- Visit your Community Center to obtain a Move-Out Brochure

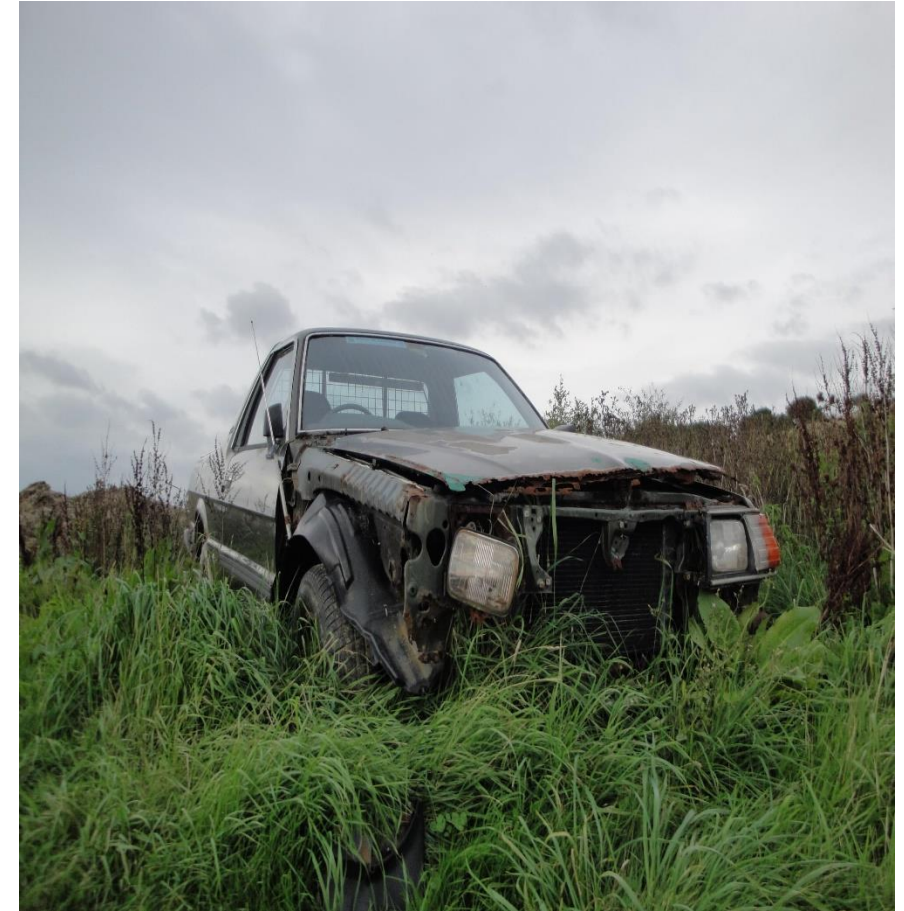

Abandoned Vehicles ICW PCS Moves

- Abandoning a Vehicle on a Military Installation could result in UCMJ or Administrative Action; Off post = monetary fine
- DOD shipped vehicles must meet requirements that a private shipper may not require; preparation is key
- Service members must provide proof that there are no open recalls during turn in before the vehicle will be accepted for shipment
- Service member must present letter of authorization to ship from lien holder if applicable; if no lien holder the service member must show proof of ownership / title
- Per USDA standards, vehicle must be thoroughly cleaned and pass an inspection of both entire and exterior
- Vehicle must be in safe and operable condition
- No cracks/chips on windows that affect safe operation
- Service members who cannot meet requirements to ship a POV or sell it are encouraged to turn in the vehicle to avoid abandonment:

 - log in requires CAC or DS log-in
 - sponsors should create DS Log-in for adult family members without a CAC, and EFMP can share information on how to do this
- Email is the best source to getting questions answered at usarmy.tripler.medcom-tamc.list.pe-efmp@health.mil
- Prior to PCS ensure EFMP enrollments are current by scheduling an appointment with your family member's PCM
- If a new enrollment or update is needed the sponsor or EFMP MTF Case Coordinator can request that action through E-EFMP, to be followed by sponsor completion of demographics and HIPAA release, and then the PCM will be able to complete the enrollment through E-EFMP
- E-EFMP does not send automatic notifications, so feel free to alert your provider that the enrollment/update is ready for completion when you see it has moved to the MTF Provider box in E-EFMP
- Sponsors or adult family members can sign the completed enrollments in E-EFMP after reviewing the forms online

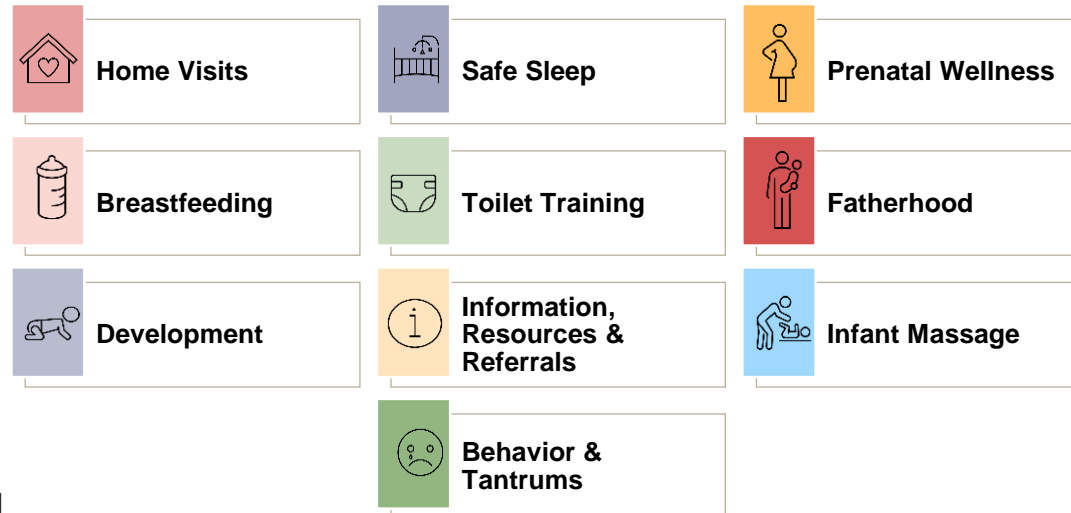

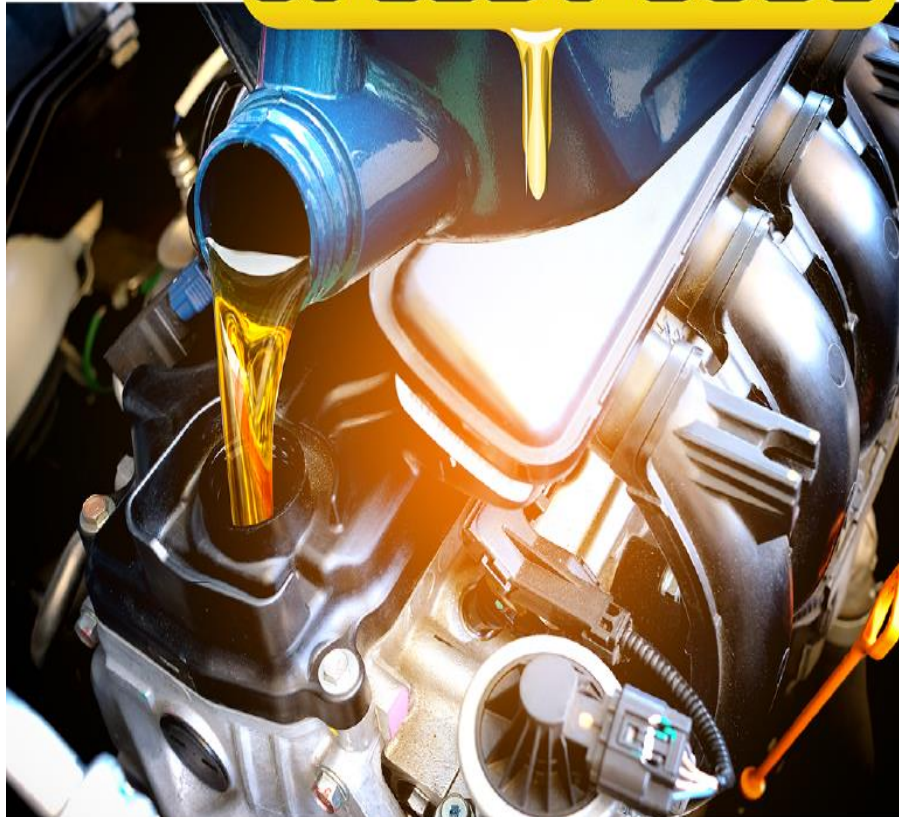

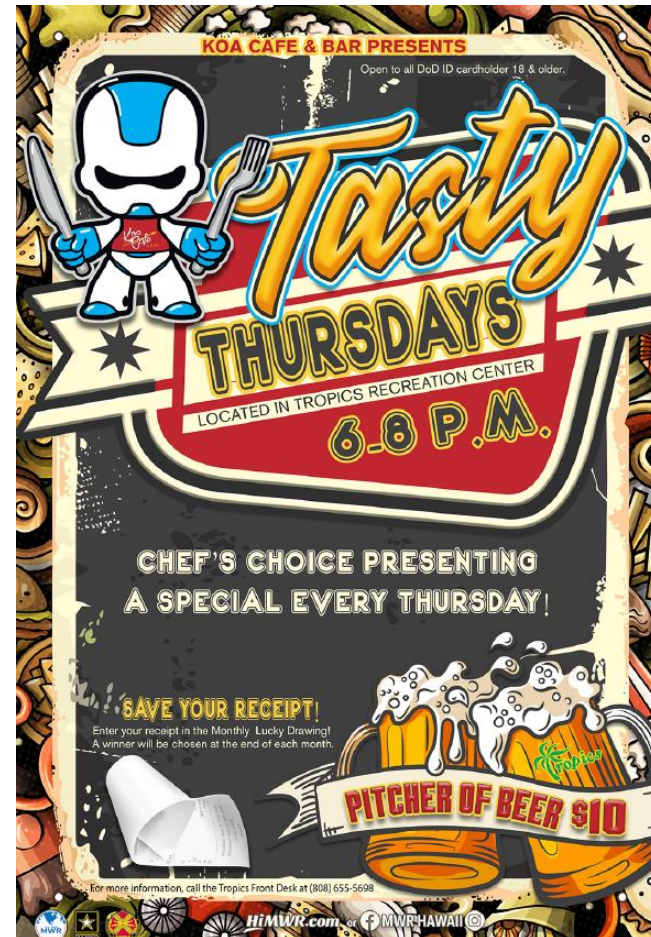

A **10-hour child care limit** has been established by the Department of the Army to protect children from being in unregulated child care settings on a regular basis.

This means **any Family member living in Government Quarters** providing child care for more than 10 hours per week on a regular basis **may be penalized**.

Home-Based Business (HBB) On-Post Housing, USAG-HI



Requirements to Become a HBB



- ✓ HBBs Applicants must obtain approval from the USAG-HI, Garrison Commander.
- ✓ HBBs are required to comply with and are subject to inspection by the appropriate city, county, state, or USAG-HI, Federal agency, office or department for compliance with applicable laws, codes, regulations and requirements.
- ✓ HBBs DOES NOT pertain to on-post home childcare. Interest in providing childcare in on-post housing must register, receive training, complete background checks and home inspections, as well as receive certification by the installation Child, Youth, and School (CYS) Services office as part of the Family Child Care (FCC) provider system. Contact CYS Office at (808) 655-1521.
- ✓ Exceptions: If you work remotely from your home or exclusively through online means, you probably don't need approval. Contact the Business and Nonprofit Liaison to review proposed business.

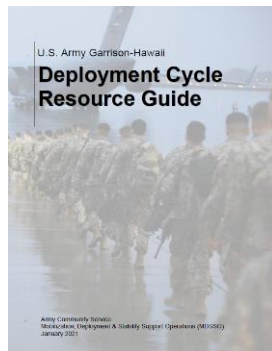

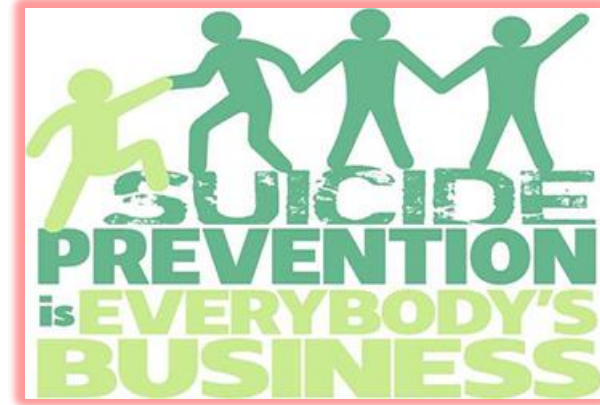

 - ✓ Units are required to assign a sponsor 120 days prior to report date.
- **Department of Army Civilians**
 - ✓ DA Civilians can fill out the PDF version of the DA Form 5434 and email it to their gaining organization.
- **ACS Sponsorship Classes**
 - Classes held every Thursday at 1200 hrs via MS TEAMS.

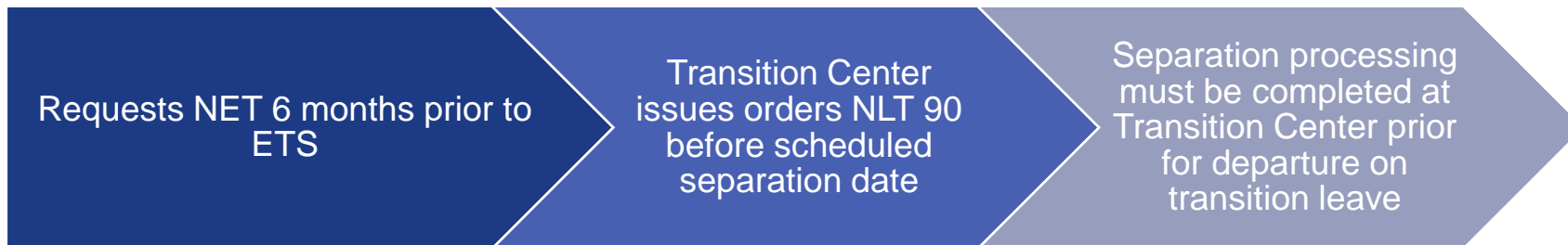

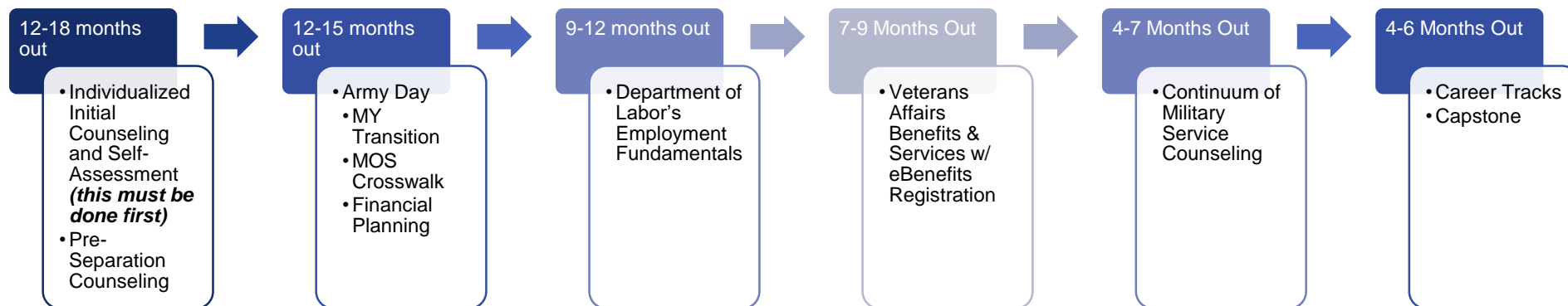

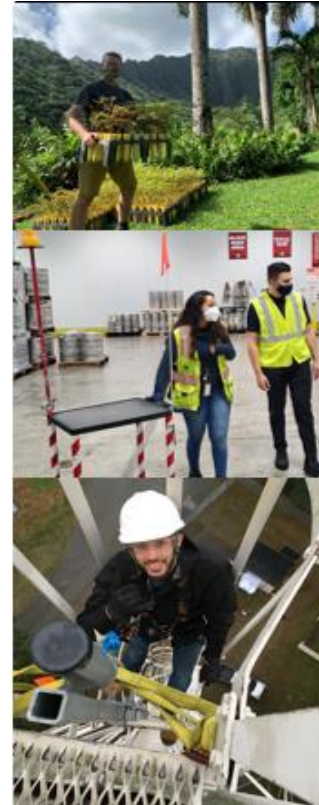

- Levy Notifications are sent within 5 days of MPD receiving notification of assignment via CAP Cycle. MPD notifies via email to the Soldier, S1, and SGM/CSM. Soldiers are to complete the Levy Packet NLT 30 days from notification.
- Orders are published up to **6 Months** from departure date, if all required documents are submitted to include the PCS ETP. S1 submits completed Levy Packets to:
usarmy.schofield.id-pacific.list.reassignments-hi@mail.mil
- Reassignments Office provides S1's and SGM/CSMs a Missing Documents log weekly.
- It is Army policy that if an individual has a government travel card, it will be used for all relocation expenses up to the limit of their entitlements. A centrally billed account is only available for Soldiers who do not have a government travel card. Account type must be indicated to Reassignments Office prior to orders being cut.

DHR - Family Travel Office

Due to the COVID travel restrictions, the process to request orders for all Government Funded Travel now requires additional steps. (Early Return of Dependent, Dependent Travel, Space A Travel and Student Travel.)

All Government Funded Travel requests are processed as follows:

1. Service Member submits the packet to their Chain of Command (packet checklists provided on the Garrison Webpage)
2. Chain of Command submits the packet to Schofield Family Travel Section Military-Personnel Division (SFTS-MPD)
3. After tentatively approving the request for travel, the SFTS-MPD provides the S-1 a Memorandum to be used as a justification to request a Travel Exception to Policy (ETP) signed by the first General Officer in the Chain of Command.
4. Chain of Command submits the signed ETP to SFTS-MPD
5. SFTS-MPD then provides the final order to S-1 and Service Member

Transportation and Carlson Wagon-lit (SATO) will require a copy of the final orders and signed Travel ETP to book HHG shipments and flights
