\$10,000 REWARD

FOR INFORMATION REGARDING DISAPPEARANCE

The Department of the Army Criminal Investigation Division is offering a reward of \$10,000 for credible information leading to the recovery of Mrs. Mischa Mabeline Kaalohilani Johnson.



Army CID was notified on 01 Aug 24 that Mrs. Mischa Johnson was reported missing from her home on Schofield Barracks, O'ahu, Hawai'i. Mrs. Johnson was reportedly last seen on the evening of 31 Jul 24 inside her home. Mischa is described as 5'2", approximately 170 lbs., six months pregnant, and of Filipino descent. Mischa has a large dragon tattoo on her back. It is unknown what clothing or footwear she might be wearing.

Dependent Student Travel

Dependent Student Travel authorizes the Soldier one Government funded round trip per fiscal year (1 October to 30 September) for his or her dependent student between the student's school and the sponsor's duty station or other such location to meet the Family for vacation, not to exceed the cost to the PDS.

Additionally, maximum of 350 pounds of unaccompanied baggage (UB) may be transported in connection with dependent student travel. Baggage may only be shipped when the transportation is provided by or reimbursed by the Government and may not be shipped independent of travel (for example, UB must be shipped within 60 days of the travel date).



To be eligible the dependent must be:

- Command Sponsored under the sponsor.
- An unmarried dependent child under 23 years old.
- Attending or will be attending a school in the United States to obtain a secondary (grades 9–12) or undergraduate college education.
- Enrolled in a full-time course of study or program. Full-time is defined as 12 semester hours.

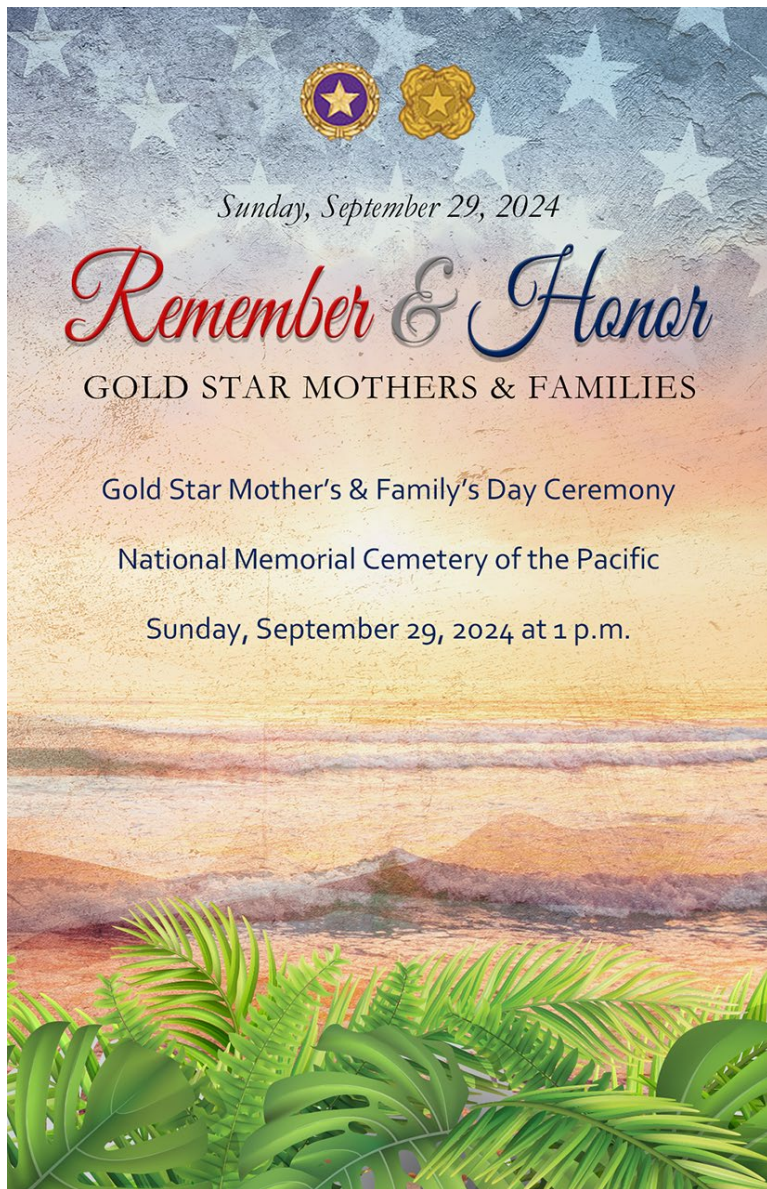

E-Bike Rules



-  Helmets are MANDATORY
- ☐ Must have headlight if riding during limited visibility
- ☐ Must have a red reflector mounted on rear of bike
- ☐ Must have a reflector mounted on each side of the bike
- ☐ Reflective body-wear gear is recommended
- ☐ Bicyclists using roadway have all the rights/duties applicable to the driver of a motor vehicle and must follow same rules/laws
- ☐ Carry one rider only
- ☐ Ride single file and far right of lane
- ☐ All bicycles with 20-inch wheels or greater diameter are required to be registered on Oahu (\$15.00)

**Properly fitted helmet is
most important piece of safety gear
IAW The National Safety Counsel**

- ☐ Hawaii electric bicycle law: An E-bike is a low-speed electric bicycle whose assisted maximum speed on a paved level surface, when powered solely by its motor, is less than 20 mph"
- ☐ MUST BE 15 YEARS OR OLDER to legally operate

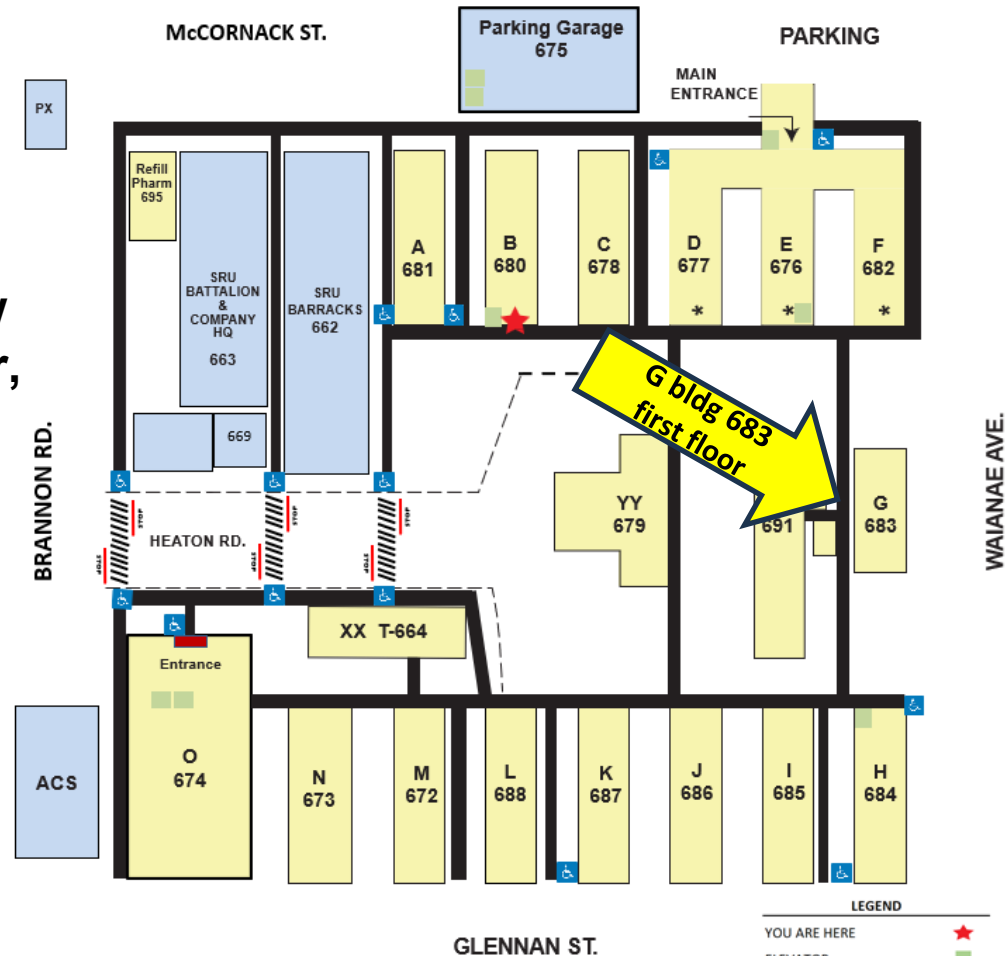

- * Has significant behavioral health concerns
- * Receives early intervention or special education services through an individualized education plan (IEP) or individualized family service plan (IFSP)

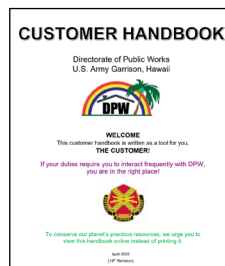
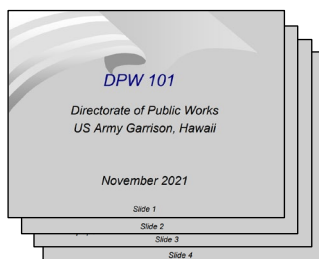

We encourage everyone to respect these guidelines to ensure compliance with DoD regulations.

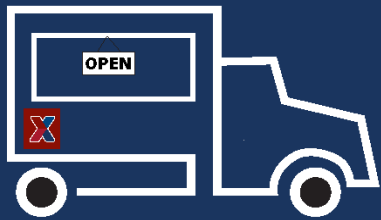

Know the Rules

A **10-hour child care limit** has been established by the Department of the Army to protect children from being in unregulated child care settings on a regular basis.

This means **any Family member living in Government Quarters** providing child care for more than 10 hours per week on a regular basis may be penalized.

Home-Based Business (HBB) On-Post Housing, USAG-HI



Requirements to Become a HBB



- ✓ HBBs Applicants must obtain approval from the USAG-HI, Garrison Commander.
- ✓ HBBs are required to comply with and are subject to inspection by the appropriate city, county, state, or USAG-HI, Federal agency, office or department for compliance with applicable laws, codes, regulations and requirements.
- ✓ HBBs DOES NOT pertain to on-post home childcare. Interest in providing childcare in on-post housing must register, receive training, complete background checks and home inspections, as well as receive certification by the installation Child, Youth, and School (CYS) Services office as part of the Family Child Care (FCC) provider system. Contact CYS Office at (808) 655-1521 or (808) 787-4393.
- ✓ Exceptions: If you work remotely from your home or exclusively through online means, you probably don't need approval. Contact the Business and Nonprofit Liaison to review proposed business.



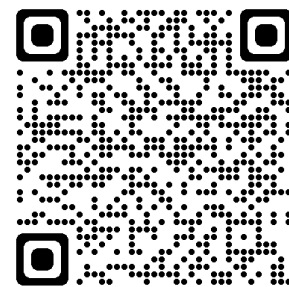

Transitional Compensation Program

A temporary resource that provides financial support and other help to dependent victims of abuse for a maximum of 36 months.

- This resource provides temporary:
 - Monthly payments to abused spouse/children
 - Military benefits - use of the commissary and exchange
 - Medical care - TRICARE benefits from either a military treatment facility or an approved TRICARE provider, including behavioral health services
- Eligibility:
 - Current or former spouse of an abusive service member
 - Service member separated from active duty under a court-martial sentence resulting from a dependent-abuse offense;
 - Service member administratively separated from active duty if the basis for separation includes a dependent-abuse offense; or
 - Service member sentenced to forfeiture of all pay and allowances by a court-martial which has convicted a member of dependent-abuse offense

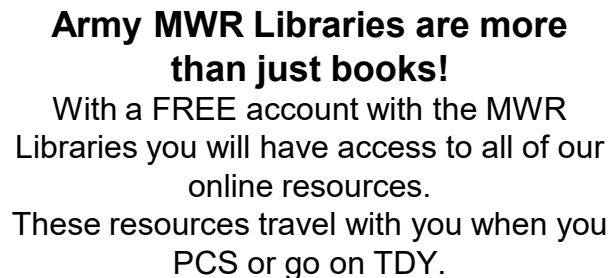

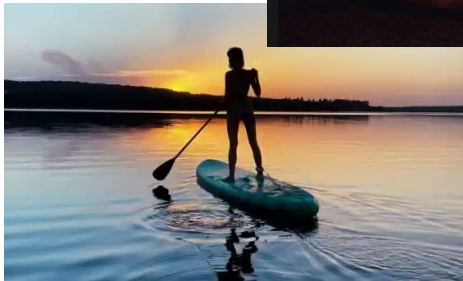
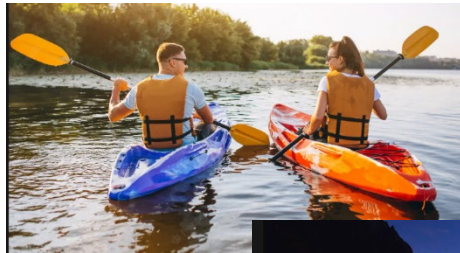
