General OCOLA Information

OCOLA is a non-taxable allowance designed to help offset higher prices of non-housing goods and services and equalize purchasing power with members stationed in CONUS. It does not reimburse expenses, compensate for remoteness, hardship, loss of spousal income, or non-availability of goods and services.

The Department updates OCOLA rates based on assessment of three primary data points:

- 1) The Living Pattern Survey (LPS) conducted every 3 years
- 2) The annual Retail Price Schedule (RPS)
- 3) And, for foreign locations, changes in currency exchange rates.

The OCONUS LPS and RPS data collected is compared to the average of the same data collected in CONUS to establish OCOLA for the OCONUS location

The next LPS for Oahu is scheduled for February 2025

General OCOLA Information

CONUS inflation has a major impact on OCOLA. If CONUS prices rise at a greater rate than OCONUS, then OCOLA rate may decrease.

OCOLA is not a fixed amount and should not be considered in household budgeting.

- Fixed expenses should be based on what a Service member can afford without the allowance (car payment)

OCOLA rate varies based on pay grade, years of service and number of command sponsored dependent on island.

9 – Assigned to barracks with DFAC

0 – Service member themselves – single, member without command sponsored dependents on island (dependents departed or never arrived) or barracks Service member with no DFAC

1 – 1 command sponsored dependent on island

2 – 2 command sponsored dependents

Max rate is 5

November 2023 OCOLA Adjustment

On December 23, 2022, the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year 2023 enacted restrictions limiting the Department's implementation of OCOLA decreases to no more than once every six months.

Decrease was set at 50%

The first phase (25%) of the OCOLA decrease was implemented May 15, 2023 and the next 25% is scheduled for November 15, 2023.

Service members will see the decreases in their December 1, 2023, paychecks.

The Department provides an OCOLA calculator Service members may use to compute current or future OCOLA payments based on changes in a Service member's OCOLA rate, PDS, pay grade, years of service, or number of dependents.

Overseas Cost-of-Living Allowance

Service members serving outside of the continental United States (OCONUS) where the cost of living is higher than CONUS receive an Overseas Cost-of-Living Allowance (COLA). Overseas COLA is a non-taxable allowance designed to offset higher prices of non-housing goods and services OCONUS and equalize purchasing power with members stationed in CONUS. It does not reimburse expenses, compensate for remoteness, hardship, loss of spousal income, or non-availability of goods and services.

OCONUS COLA is not a fixed amount and should not be considered in household budgeting. Fixed expenses, such as car payments, should be based on what a Service member can afford without the allowance. Overseas COLA can fluctuate based on the exchange rate, as COLA is paid in U.S. dollars, but some expenses are typically paid in foreign currency. FAMILY MEMBER STUDENT TRAVEL

What is it and who is eligible?

Command Sponsored dependents of Active Duty Service Members stationed OCONUS may be entitled for one fully funded round-trip per fiscal year and up to 350 lbs. of unaccompanied baggage (UAB) between the student's school and the sponsor's duty station

- Unmarried
- Less than 23 years of age
- Must be attending (or will be attending) full time (12 semester hours or equivalent) a school in the Continental United States (CONUS) to obtain a formal education that is accredited by a state, regional or nationally recognized college/university

Requests should be submitted to the DHR Family Travel Office no later than 30 days prior to the departure date and no earlier than 60 days of the start date.

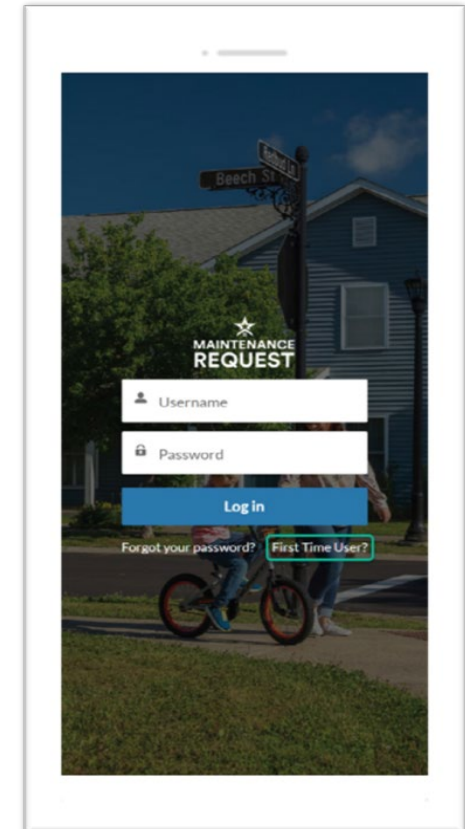

Service Order Self-Scheduling

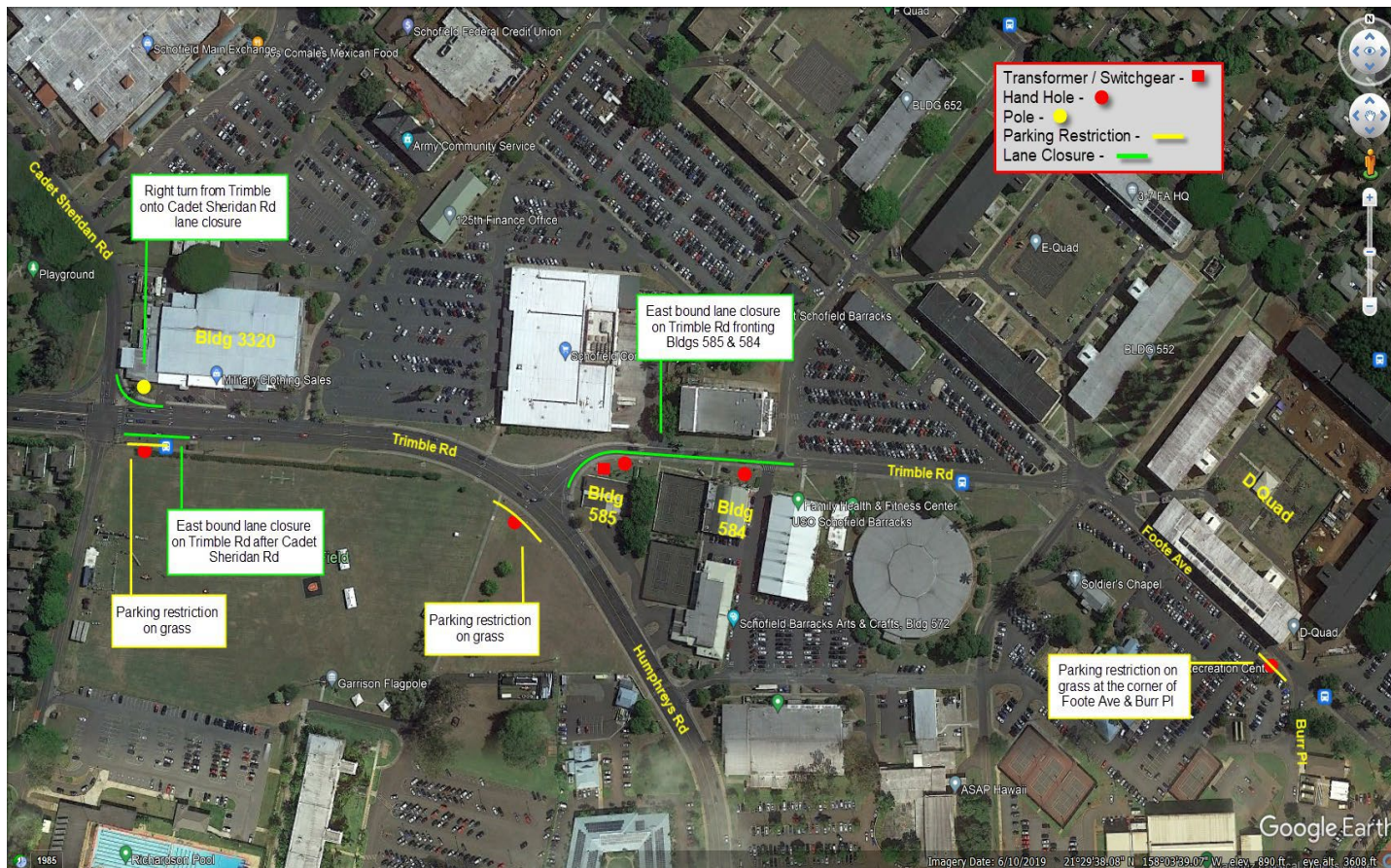

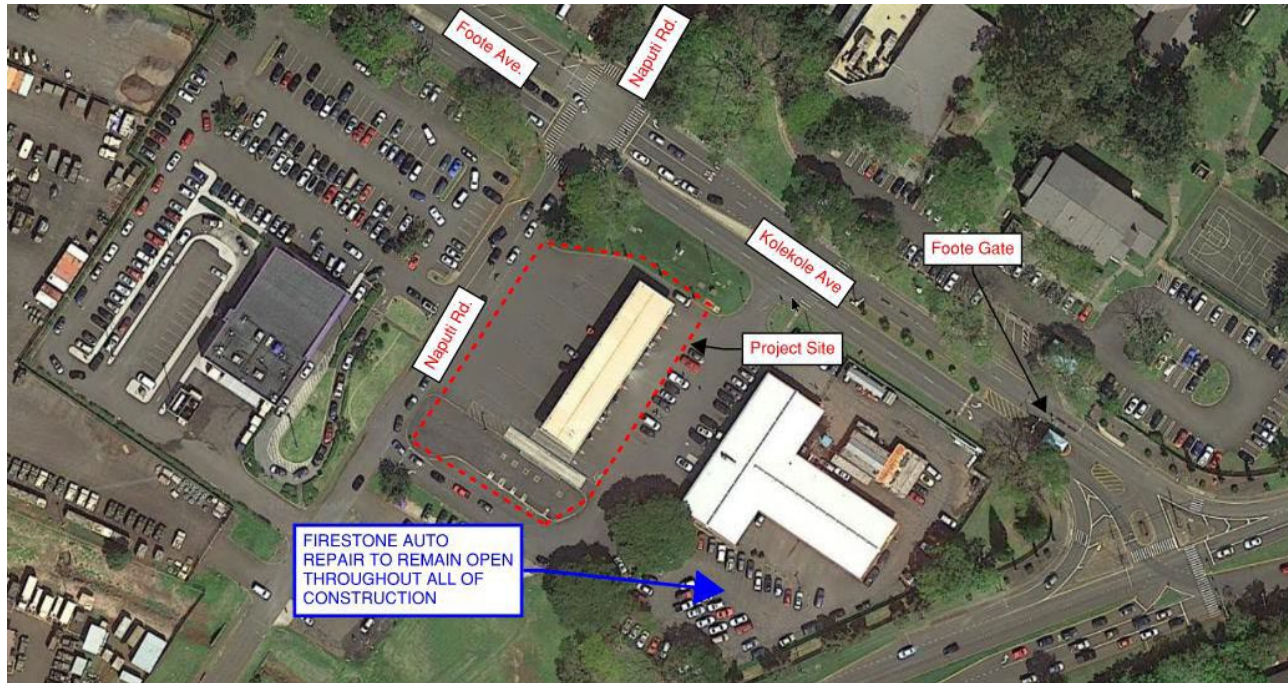

PURPOSE: Replacement of underground fuel storage tanks, fuel piping, and vent lines at the Foote Gate AAFES Gas Station (Building 80)

The Firestone Auto Repair is to remain open throughout all of construction. The fuel dispensers will be closed starting May 15th, 2023, and the AAFES shoppette will be closed starting May 27th, 2023. The closest AAFES Gas Station is the Kole Kole Express at the intersection of Trimble Rd. and Beaver Rd (approx. 2 miles away).

Schofield Barracks gas station project is on track to complete the upgrade of the Foote Gate AAFES Gas Station (Building 80) as planned. Includes installing new underground fuel storage tanks, fuel piping, vent lines, and state-of-the-art fuel dispensers, all aiming for completion by May 2024.

Once complete Schofield Barracks will have two functional 2 million gallon water tanks for providing potable water to Schofield and Wheeler.

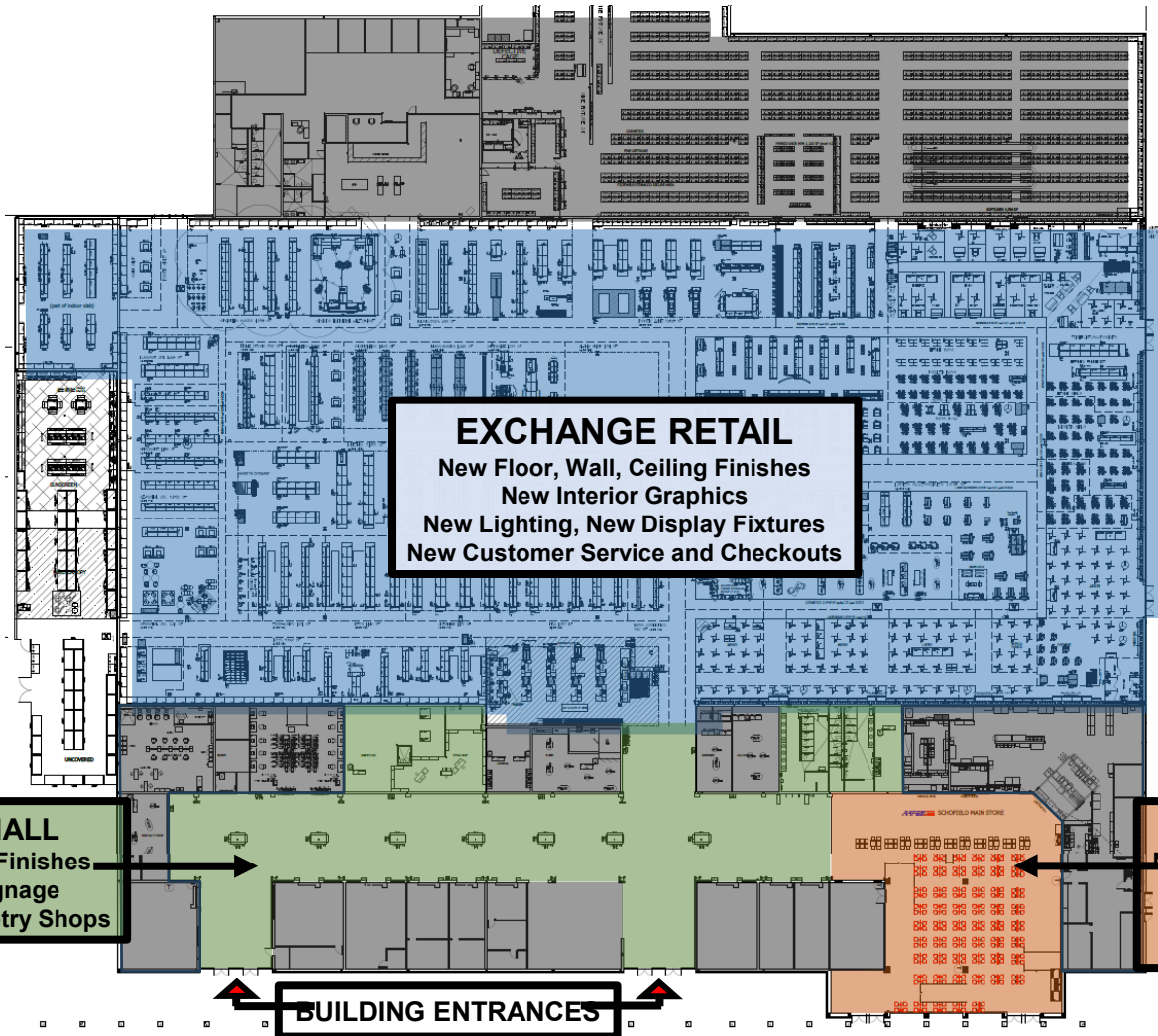

TOP 10 SAFETY TIPS

Know the Rules

A **10-hour child care limit** has been established by the Department of the Army to protect children from being in unregulated child care settings on a regular basis.

This means **any Family member living in Government Quarters** providing child care for more than 10 hours per week on a regular basis may be penalized.

Home-Based Business (HBB) On-Post Housing, USAG-HI



Requirements to Become a HBB



- ✓ HBBs Applicants must obtain approval from the USAG-HI, Garrison Commander.
- ✓ HBBs are required to comply with and are subject to inspection by the appropriate city, county, state, or USAG-HI, Federal agency, office or department for compliance with applicable laws, codes, regulations and requirements.
- ✓ HBBs DOES NOT pertain to on-post home childcare. Interest in providing childcare in on-post housing must register, receive training, complete background checks and home inspections, as well as receive certification by the installation Child, Youth, and School (CYS) Services office as part of the Family Child Care (FCC) provider system. Contact CYS Office at (808) 655-1521.
- ✓ Exceptions: If you work remotely from your home or exclusively through online means, you probably don't need approval. Contact the Business and Nonprofit Liaison to review proposed business.

Transitional Compensation Program

A temporary resource that provides financial support and other help to dependent victims of abuse for a maximum of 36 months.

- This resource provides temporary:
 - Monthly payments to abused spouse/children
 - Military benefits - use of the commissary and exchange
 - Medical care - TRICARE benefits from either a military treatment facility or an approved TRICARE provider, including behavioral health services
- Eligibility:
 - Current or former spouse of an abusive service member
 - Service member separated from active duty under a court-martial sentence resulting from a dependent-abuse offense;
 - Service member administratively separated from active duty if the basis for separation includes a dependent-abuse offense; or
 - Service member sentenced to forfeiture of all pay and allowances by a court-martial which has convicted a member of dependent-abuse offense
