





Know the Rules

A **10-hour child care limit** has been established by the Department of the Army to protect children from being in unregulated child care settings on a regular basis.

This means **any Family member living in Government** Quarters providing child care for more than 10 hours per week on a regular basis may be penalized.

FACTS ABOUT HAWAI'I'S PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM

- All public schools are managed by the Hawaii Department of Education (there are no Department of Defense schools in Hawaii) and policies are set forth by the Hawaii Board of Education.
- The Hawaii Department of Education is one school district which consists of 295 schools and approximately 168,000 students.
- There are five public schools located on Army installations in Hawaii: Daniel K. Inouye Elementary, Shafter Elementary, Solomon Elementary, Wheeler Elementary and Wheeler Middle.

OCONUS to OCONUS moves & Command Sponsorship

Dependent Trave

• The Soldier acquired a Family member (married) before the effective date of the PCS order & is entitled to transportation of the Family member at Government expense.

Command Sponsorship

- Must meet eligibility requirements to qualify 36-month tour or 12 months remaining after approval
- Dependent(s) must be on island to qualify
- Exceptions given for bona fide local residents




Dependent Student Travel

The Dependent Student Travel program is an entitlement for Command Sponsored children of Active-Duty Service Members stationed OCONUS.

One fully funded round-trip and up to 350lbs. Unaccompanied Baggage (UAB) per Fiscal Year to dependent's school and the sponsor's duty station.

- Must be attending (or will be attending) college/university CONUS at an accredited college/university
- Must be enrolled full-time (12 semester hours or equivalent) in a course of study.
- Application should be submitted no later than 60 days.

Online (USID) Card Renewal Pilot

What's Changed?



Supporting Our Military Families



Sponsors can request renewal of Uniformed Services Identification (USID) Card online through ID Card Office Online (IDCO). The cards will be mailed to the card recipient via U.S. mail.



Requirements

- Sponsors must be a CAC holder and requesting a renewal of an active USID Card.
- Sponsor and Cardholder must have email addresses listed in DEERS that they have authorized DoD to use for contacting them.
- The Cardholder has a photo saved in DEERS taken in the last 12 years.
- The Cardholder's mailing address is present in DEERS and is in United States.

Process for Renewing a USID Card

- The Sponsor will request a USID Card renewal in IDCO/Select "Family ID Cards" then "Renew Family Member ID Card" option.
- Once the request is successfully processed, the card will be created and mailed to card recipient's address on file in DEERS via U.S. mail. (will NOT ship to PO Box).
- The Sponsor must acknowledge receipt of the card via IDCO for the new USID card to be activated and prior card will be terminated.
- The prior card should be returned to the government.

Note: If the request is not approved or fails, the card recipient will receive an email and depending on the reason, the sponsor will be instructed to submit a new request in IDCO or visit a RAPIDS site for issuance of the card

Access Control Point (Gate) Operations

- > Personnel require DOD issued CAC identification card or authorized pass (with valid reason) to enter.
- Schofield Barracks area: McNair Gate, Lyman Gate, Kunia Gate all open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- Fort Shafter area: Buckner Gate, Fort Shafter Flats Gate and Tripler Army Medical Center gates all open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- Other gate hours vary-check for availability.
- Speed limit on Schofield Barracks during PT hours (0630-0800-weekdays) is 15 MPH throughout the installation.

 - May be authorized NTE 10 days from the AVAL date on PCS/Separation/Retirement Orders.
 - Prior to start of leave
 - Household goods must be picked up
 - Flight itinerary required.
- Arrival TLA:
 - May be authorized once solider signs into PDS.
 - Housing agreement must be secured within 30 days with an occupancy date no later than the sixtieth (60) day of TLA.






