
- E-bikes are not allowed at HDOE elementary and middle schools. This includes schools on Schofield Barracks and Wheeler Army Airfield.





- Gift cards available to support eligible commissary patrons for their purchases of groceries, essential home item
- <u>Gift cards</u> are available at all commissaries worldwide. In-store gift card purchases range from \$5 to \$300 per card. There are no fees when the card is purchased in a store
- Cards can be purchased individually online in standard denominations of \$10, \$25 and \$50 through the DeCA website at https://www.decacards.com/product/commissary-gift-card/. Cards purchased online incur a shipping and handling fee
- Cards can be purchased <u>online in bulk</u>. Bulk orders can be requested in customized amounts even with an organization's logo attached. Further details are worked out before the order is finalized
- There is no limit to the number of gift cards that a purchaser can buy. It's recommended that organizations and activities consider buying their gift cards online if they plan to make bulk purchases
- Cards are good for five years from the date of purchase and can only be redeemed for authorized merchandise at DeCA commissaries. They also cannot be redeemed for cash or credit
- Commissary Gift Cards are also available in military exchange stores
- Cards can be shipped anywhere in the United States. When shipping outside the United States, an APO, FPO or DPO address must be used

E-Bike Rules

- Helmets are MANDATORYMust have headlight if riding during limited visibility
- ☐ Must have a red reflector mounted on rear of bike
- Must have a reflector mounted on each side of the bike
- ☐ Reflective body-wear gear is recommended
- Bicyclists using roadway have all the rights/duties applicable to the driver of a motor vehicle and must follow same rules/laws
- ☐ Carry one rider only
- ☐ Ride single file and far right of lane
- ☐ All bicycles with 20-inch wheels or greater diameter are required to be registered on Oahu (\$15.00)

- Hawaii electric bicycle law: An E-bike is a low-speed electric bicycle whose assisted maximum speed on a paved level surface, when powered solely by its motor, is less than 20 mph"
- MUST BE 15 YEARS OR OLDER to legally operate
- SHEIMETS ARE MANDATORY
- Must have headlight if riding during limited visibility
- ☐ Must have a red reflector mounted on rear of bike
- ☐ Must have a reflector mounted on each side of the bike
- ☐ Reflective body-wear gear is recommended


