

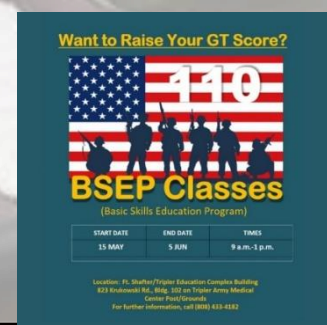

For Family Returning to the Main Land

- Notify TRICARE of your move (if over 60 days) by calling (844) 866-9378 if you require a local Primary Care Manager
- Obtain prescription medications to cover the timeframe of your move (up to 90 days)
- Keep copies of medical records, prescriptions or referrals provided by non-Military Treatment Facilities to ensure continuity of care upon return to Oahu
- Mental Health Resources

- ✓ HBBs DOES NOT pertain to on-post home childcare. Interest in providing childcare in on-post housing must register, receive training, complete background checks and home inspections, as well as receive certification by the installation Child, Youth, and School (CYS) Services office as part of the Family Child Care (FCC) provider system. Contact CYS Office at (808) 655-1521.

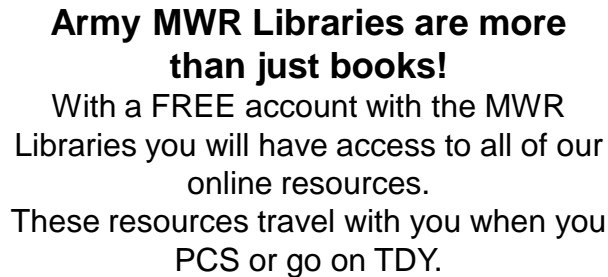
