### Know the Rules

A 10-hour child care limit has been established by the Department of the Army to protect children from being in unregulated child care settings on a regular basis.

This means **any Family member living in government quarters** providing child care for more than **10 child care hours** per week on a regular basis **may be penalized**.



  - Valid government ID card
  - Valid state registration and license plate sticker
  - Valid state safety inspection papers and stickers
  - Valid proof of insurance Hawaii "No Fault" insurance card







**DATE:** Through July 8, 8 a.m.-3 p.m.


### **PURPOSE:**

**DATE:** July 1-15, 6-8 a.m.



### Temporary Lodging Allowance

- ✓ Eligibility
  - E6 and above
  - E1 E5 with command sponsorship for dependent(s)
  - Service Member with a valid Certificate of Non-availability (CNA)
    - NOTE: If your CNA is expired, see your Barracks Unit Representative ASAP
- ✓ Departure TLA
  - When authorized, not to exceed the last 10 days on island
  - TLA is NOT paid while Service Member is on leave status
  - Household goods must be picked up
  - Flight Itinerary required
  - Retirees and Service Members who separate from service and stay on Hawaii, with plans to move at a later date are ineligible for TLA





### **Army Housing Office**

#### Secretarial Process

- ✓ A Secretarial Waiver
  - Is required for Departure TLA for command sponsored dependent(s) who remain on island because of a Soldier's:
    - TDY
    - Unaccompanied Tour
    - Dependent Restricted Tour
  - See ALARACT Message 097/2016 or current policy to request the waiver from HQ DA DCS, G-1
  - The waiver is not <u>retroactive</u>

On Dec. 8, 2020, the Chief of Staff of the Army directed the implementation of a Fusion Directorate Pilot Program. Modeled after the Rape Crisis Center concept used by municipalities across the United States. The USARHAW Fusion Directorate represents a dynamic and innovative approach for combating sexual harassment and sexual assault.

The Fusion Directorate prioritizes victim care by coordinating and synchronizing multiple response function, facilitating transparency of the adjudication process, and providing an additional reporting process outside of the victim's immediate chain of command. This approach implements a comprehensive, compassionate, and coordinated system of intervention and care for victims/survivors as well as serving the larger community as a centralized capability providing comprehensive training and resources.

# **DHR - Total Army Sponsorship Program**



### **DHR - Reassignment Office**

- Levy Notifications are sent within 5 days of MPD receiving notification of assignment via CAP Cycle. MPD notifies via email to the Soldier, S1, and SGM/CSM. Soldiers are to complete the Levy Packet NLT 30 days from notification.
- Orders are published up to <u>6 Months</u> from departure date, if all required documents are submitted to include the PCS ETP. S1 submits completed Levy Packets to: <u>usarmy.schofield.id-pacific.list.reassignments-hi@mail.mil</u>
- Reassignments Office provides S1's and SGM/CSMs a Missing Documents log weekly.
- It is Army policy that if an individual has a government travel card, it will be used for all relocation expenses up to the limit of their entitlements. A centrally billed account is only available for Soldiers who do not have a government travel card. Account type must be indicated to Reassignments Office prior to orders being cut.

### **DHR - Family Travel Office**

Due to the COVID travel restrictions, the process to request orders for all Government Funded Travel now requires additional steps. (Early Return of Dependent, Dependent Travel, Space A Travel and Student Travel.)

All Government Funded Travel requests are processed as follows:

- 1. Service Member submits the packet to their Chain of Command (packet checklists provided on the Garrison Webpage)
- 2. Chain of Command submits the packet to Schofield Family Travel Section Military-Personnel Division (SFTS-MPD)
- 3. After tentatively approving the request for travel, the SFTS-MPD provides the S-1 a Memorandum to be used as a justification to request a Travel Exception to Policy (ETP) signed by the first General Officer in the Chain of Command.
- 4. Chain of Command submits the signed ETP to SFTS-MPD
- 5. SFTS-MPD then provides the final order to S-1 and Service Member

\*Transportation and Carlson Wagon-lit (SATO) will require a copy of the final orders and signed Travel ETP to book HHG shipments and flights\*

Claims: Article 139 Claims in a Commander's Toolbox

- ✓ Art. 139, UCMJ, permits commanders to initiate an investigation into whether a Soldier wrongfully or willfully damages or deprives someone of their property. This does not include accidents.
- A proper claimant can include a military member, civilian, business, or non-profit organization.
- ✓ A template for someone to file the claim with the alleged offender's commander is found online here: <u>https://home.army.mil/hawaii/application/files/4015/6990/0871/Article</u> <u>139\_Claim\_Form\_Template.pdf</u>
- ✓ If the claim is meritorious, damages are deducted from the pay of the offender.
