Holiday Safety

Helpful tips for securing your home while away-

- Make sure all the locks on the doors and windows function properly.
- Ask neighbors to keep an eye on your residence while you are away.
- Leave your vacation address and telephone number with the neighbors so you can be reached in an emergency.
- Arrange for a neighbor to pick up your deliveries: mail, newspaper, and any other packages.
- If you leave your car at home, park as you normally would ensure it is secured.
- Consider taking valuables that you cannot live without to a safety deposit box.
- Call Military Police to advise them that you are on vacation.

Fire Safety

- Cooking fires remain the # 1 cause of residential fires. U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) data show that there are about 360,000 home fires every year, leading to about 2,400 deaths and nearly 10,400 injuries each year.
- Dry Christmas trees and unattended candles can lead to dangerous fires.
 From 2016 to 2018, there were about 100 Christmas tree fires and about 1,100 candle fires in November and December each year

TRICARE Bill

 Sometimes patients who receive care at non-MTFs may receive a bill directly from the hospital or clinic they visited. If you receive a bill, please contact the Managed Care office at Tripler Mon-Fri 7:30am-4:30pm at 808-433-7074

Other Health Insurance (OHI)

 When you check in for your visit, you may be asked to complete an Other Health Insurance form. This form lets us know if you have additional health insurance that may reimburse the cost of care. We've collected over \$1M in OHI funds which goes directly into things like purchasing new equipment, hiring staff, and other services that help provide you with the best care possible. DEERS

 All patients must be enrolled in DEERS before enrolling in TRICARE. Because the clinic uses information from DEERS, such as phone numbers and addresses, it is important to make sure your DEERS information is up to date! You can update DEERS by visiting https://www.tricare.mil/deers

TRICARE Open Season 2022

- November 14 December 13/Federal Benefits Open Season: Nov 14-Dec 12 (Vision & Dental)
- Open season is an opportunity for TRICARE eligible patients to review and update their health care plans. You can make changes or additions to your benefits without the need of a qualifying life event.
- During this period, you can switch between TRICARE Prime, where you receive care at an MTF, and TRICARE Select where you receive care from a civilian provider within the community. Please note that there are out of pocket fees associated with TRICARE Select.

Emergency vs Urgent Care Visits

- Any TRICARE beneficiary experiencing a medical emergency can call 9-1-1 or proceed to the nearest Emergency Room (military or civilian) if able.
 - ADSM will not incur a fee for seeking care at a civilian or non-MTF Emergency Room
 - ADSM do require a referral to visit civilian or non-MTF
 Urgent Care Centers (UCC). You should seek care at a
 military hospital or clinic when/where available or contact
 the Nurse Advice Line at 1-800-TRICARE for assistance
 with urgent care questions, help finding a doctor, or
 scheduling a next day appointment at an MTF.
 - Active Duty Service Members must follow up with their PCM when they receive care outside of a military hospital or clinic, in accordance with DoD and Service regulations.
 - TRICARE beneficiaries not on active duty do not require referral to be seen at any TRICARE-authorized Urgent Care Center or network provider. For a list of TRICAREauthorized UCCs call 1-800-TRICARE Option 1 to talk to a registered nurse or visit

This means any Family member living in government quarters providing child care for more than 10 child care hours per week on a regular basis may be penalized.

Requirements to Become a HBB



- **✓** HBBs Applicants must obtain approval from the USAG-HI, Garrison Commander.
- ✓ HBBs are required to comply with and are subject to inspection by the appropriate city, county, state, or USAG-HI, Federal agency, office or department for compliance with applicable laws, codes, regulations and requirements.
- ✓ HBBs DOES NOT pertain to <u>on-post home childcare</u>. Interest in providing childcare in on-post housing must register, receive training, complete background checks and home inspections, as well as receive certification by the installation Child, Youth, and School (CYS) Services office as part of the Family Child Care (FCC) provider system. Contact CYS Office at (808) 655-1521.
- ✓ Exceptions: If you work remotely from your home or exclusively through online means, you probably don't need approval. Contact the Business and Nonprofit Liaison to review proposed business.

DHR - Total Army Sponsorship Program

 Sponsorship is <u>required</u> in order to process permanent change of station (PCS) orders to Hawaii and other regions.

Soldiers (E1-O6)

- ✓ Soldiers must log onto the Army Career Trackers Total Army Sponsorship Program to initiate DA Form 5434 and request a sponsor.
- ✓ Units are required to assign a sponsor 120 days prior to report date.

Department of Army Civilians

✓ DA Civilians can fill out the PDF version of the DA Form 5434 and email it to their gaining organization.

ACS Sponsorship Classes

- Classes held every Thursday at 1200 hrs via MS TEAMS.
- Required for all assigned sponsors and volunteers.






DHR - Transition Assistance Program (TAP)

- Un-programmed losses need to begin ASAP
- · Spouses eligible

 - ✓ Internships and apprenticeships available if qualified!








DHR - Career Skills Program

DHR - Reassignment Office

- Process & Publish the Following:
 - ✓ PCS Orders
 - ✓ IPCOT/COT Travel Orders
 - ✓ Excess Leave Orders
 - ✓ Confinement Transfer Orders
 - ✓ Deletion or Deferment of Assignments- Non PSDR units



- Levy Notifications are sent within 5 days of MPD receiving notification of assignment via CAP Cycle. MPD notifies via email to the Soldier, S1, and SGM/CSM. Soldiers are to complete the Levy Packet NLT 30 days from notification.
- Orders are published up to <u>6 Months</u> from departure date, if all required documents are submitted to include the PCS ETP. S1 submits completed Levy Packets to: usarmy.schofield.id-pacific.list.reassignments-hi@mail.mil
- Reassignments Office provides S1's and SGM/CSMs a Missing Documents log weekly.
- It is Army policy that if an individual has a government travel card, it will be used for all relocation expenses up to the limit of their entitlements. A centrally billed account is only available for Soldiers who do not have a government travel card. Account type must be indicated to Reassignments Office prior to orders being cut.

DHR - Family Travel Office

Due to the COVID travel restrictions, the process to request orders for all Government Funded Travel now requires additional steps. (Early Return of Dependent, Dependent Travel, Space A Travel and Student Travel.)

All Government Funded Travel requests are processed as follows:

- 1. Service Member submits the packet to their Chain of Command (packet checklists provided on the Garrison Webpage)
- 2. Chain of Command submits the packet to Schofield Family Travel Section Military-Personnel Division (SFTS-MPD)
- 3. After tentatively approving the request for travel, the SFTS-MPD provides the S-1 a Memorandum to be used as a justification to request a Travel Exception to Policy (ETP) signed by the first General Officer in the Chain of Command.
- 4. Chain of Command submits the signed ETP to SFTS-MPD
- 5. SFTS-MPD then provides the final order to S-1 and Service Member

Transportation and Carlson Wagon-lit (SATO) will require a copy of the final orders and signed Travel ETP to book HHG shipments and flights

Early Return of Dependents

 Only used for unusual/emergency circumstances like marital difficulties, financial difficulties, divorce, hardship, etc.

Dependent Travel

 The Soldier acquired a Family member (married) before the effective date of the PCS order & is entitled to transportation of the Family member at Government expense.

Space Available Travel

•Soldier acquired a Family member (married) after the effective date of the PCS order and is not entitled to transpiration of Family members at Government expense but may be authorized space-available transportation once command sponsorship is approved by the overseas command.

Command Sponsorship

- Must meet eligibility requirements to qualify 36-month tour or 12 months remaining after approval
- Dependent(s) must be on island to qualify
- Exceptions given for bona fide local residents

Student Travel

- An entitlement for Command Sponsored children of Active-Duty Soldiers stationed overseas (Hawaii) who are full time students attending an accredited college/university.
- One fully-funded round trip per fiscal year for dependent student between the student's school and the sponsor's duty station.
- Application should be submitted no later than 60 days
