**U.S. Army Garrison Hawai'i Publishes Environmental Assessment  
and Draft Finding of No Significant Impact  
to Relocate Schofield Barracks Deep Wells Above Ground  
on the Island of O'ahu, Hawai'i.**

In accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the Hawai'i Environmental Policy Act (HEPA), the Department of the Army (Army) published an Environmental Assessment with a Draft Finding of No Significant Impact (EA-Draft FONSI) to Relocate Schofield Barracks Deep Wells Above Ground on the Island of O'ahu. The Proposed Action would replace critical water infrastructure to reduce maintenance burdens, ensure water quality, and enhance long-term system resilience in support of Army operations.

The Army invites public comments on the EA-Draft FONSI during a 30-day public comment period beginning February 8, 2026.
