
Motorcycle Access Card (MAC)

EFFECTIVE 1 July 2021 at all U.S. Army Hawaii Entry Control Points

Applies to <u>ANY Service Member</u> assigned to U.S. Army Hawaii Installations. Includes Active, Guard, Reserve, U.S. Air Force, or others that work on U.S. Army Hawaii Installations.

Does not apply to **Service Members VISITING**

Does not apply to <u>Army Civilians, Contractors, or Family Members</u> living or working on U.S. Army Hawaii Installations.

METHOD:

- 1. When CAC is presented by a motorcycle rider at any U.S. Army Hawaii entry Control Point, determine if they are <u>assigned Service Member</u> (whether in or out <u>of uniform).</u>
- 2. <u>If assigned **Service member**</u>, must produce this Motorcycle Access Card. Verify name, photo, and expiration date.
- 3. If <u>Service Member</u> without Motorcycle Access Card, deny access to the installation. If situation warrants, Soldiers may be detained at the access control point and released to their unit leadership.

Service Members whom are <u>newly PCS'd</u> gain temporary access to USARHAW installations through the Visitor Control Center. Riders provide their current state driver's license with motorcycle endorsement, valid registration, proof of insurance, and comply with the PPE requirements in this policy. Riders will be granted a 30-day pass and will be required to obtain the MAC within that 30 days.
