

LTC Brett Fuller was recently assigned to the U.S. Special Operations Command South (SOCSOUTH) in Homestead, Florida where he served as the Command Engineer for the past two years. Prior to that assignment, LTC Fuller served as the Deputy District Commander in the US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Albuquerque District in New Mexico.

LTC Fuller spent three years in Hawaii from 2018 to 2021 where he held the position of Operations Officer (S3) for the 130<sup>th</sup> Engineer Brigade, S3 for the 29<sup>th</sup> Brigade Engineer Battalion, and Project Manager for the USACE Honolulu District.

Since his commissioning in 2007 from the University of Washington (UW), LTC Fuller has also served in command and leadership positions in the 18<sup>th</sup> Engineer Brigade in Germany and the 101<sup>st</sup> Airborne Division. LTC Fuller deployed in support of combat operations to Iraq (Operation Iraqi Freedom), Afghanistan (Operation Enduring Freedom), and as the Theater Reserve Force in Kuwait (Operation Freedom's Sentinel). He holds a Master of Science in Human Centered Design and Engineering (HCDE) from UW, a Master of Science in Engineering Management from Missouri University of Science and Technology (MS&T) and a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering from UW. He is a licensed Professional Engineer (PE) in the state of Missouri and a Project Management Professional (PMP).
