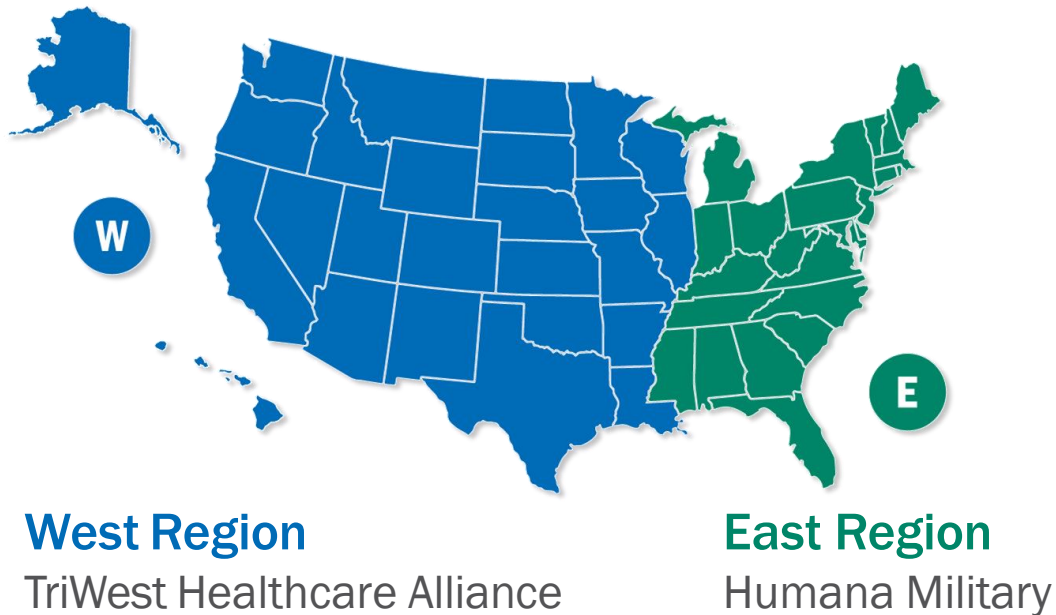

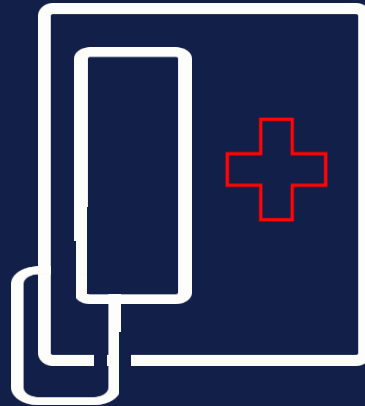

Can I live on Post?



Eligibility and Who Qualifies: Active Duty, Active Reserve, and Active National Guard Soldier with eligible dependents.

Types of homes: 2-, 3-, 4- and 5-bedroom non-rank specific homes. SNCO 4-bedroom homes. CGO, FGO and GO/SO 3- and 4-bedroom homes.

Cost: With dependent BAH rate.

Wait Times: Varies by waitlist. Talk to the assigned Leasing Consultant for updates to the wait times.

Process: Apply with **official orders to Fort Hood**, most recent end of month **LES, DEERS 1172** verified by the DEERS office, **IPSAA leave form** if applicable. Be added to the waitlist according to eligibility date and advise the Leasing Consultant of the community preferences and availability date. Be offered a home, notified of estimated move in date, walk through home, sign the lease, pay the prorated rent and pick up the keys.

➤ **Contact Cavalry Family Housing for Residential Recycling Program (R3P) & Curbside Container**

➤ **Cardboard Exchange Program**

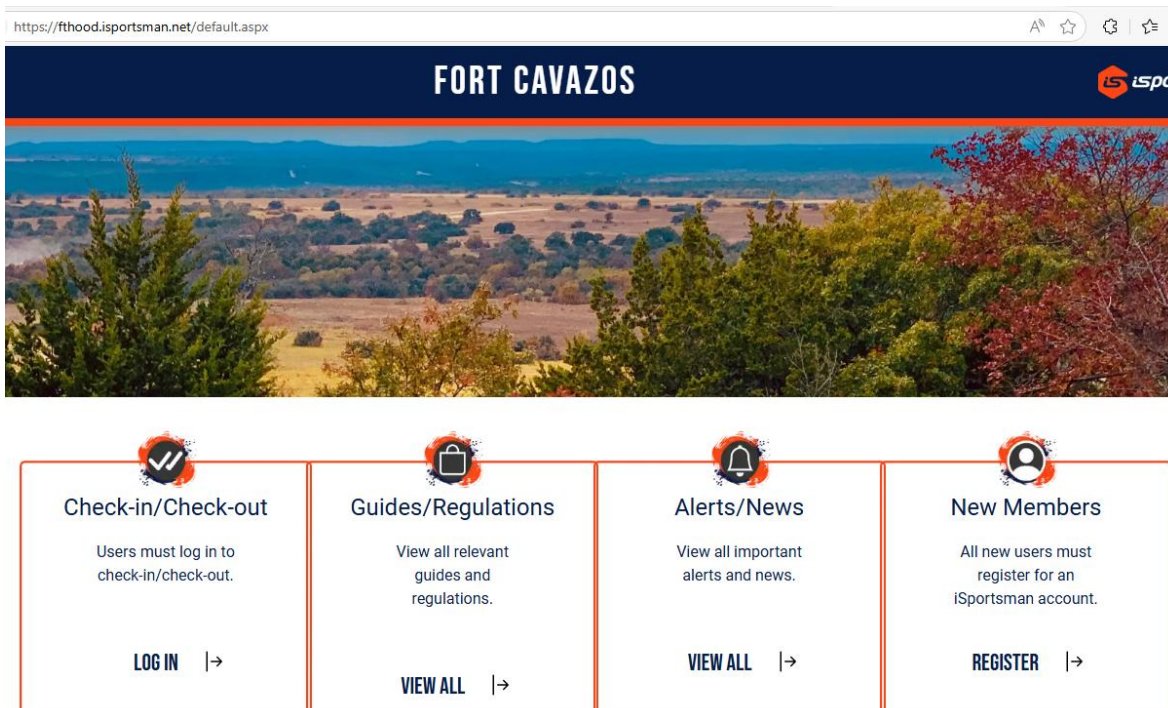

FC Reg 210-25, FC Cir 210-22, and the Hunting, Fishing, and Natural Resource Use Guide
- **Possess a permit and vehicle access pass printed from the website**
- **Recognize it's their responsibility to know and understand all the information before recreating at Fort Hood**

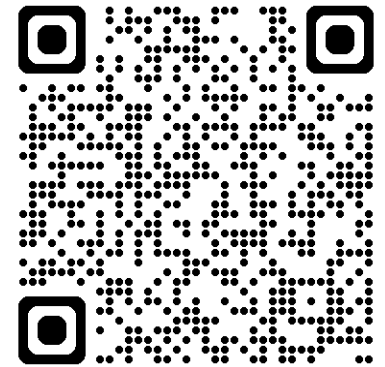
