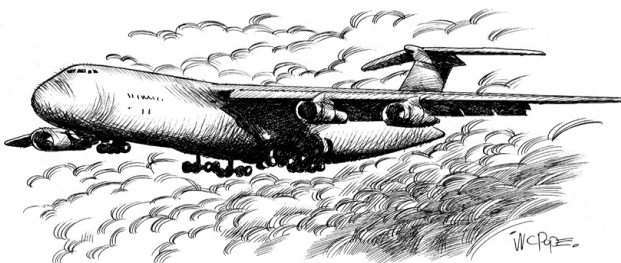

- \* Verify load plans meet mission intent
