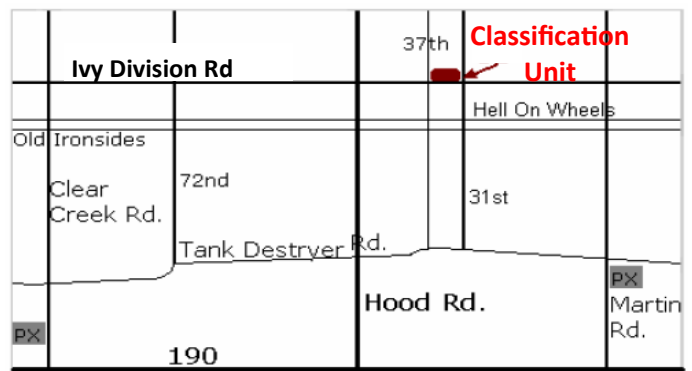

The Classification Unit will NOT accept:

- Ammunition
- Food products
- Medical products
- Unknown and unlabeled items
- Mixture of oil/antifreeze
- Mixture of HHW chemicals
- HHW not in original container (excluding paint)
- Items collected by Fort Hood Recycle
- Property book or government owned items

Did you know? The collection center's easy and free service reduces household hazardous waste going into the environment. Unused leftovers are placed into a storage facility for others to pick up and reuse for free!

The facility is available to DoD ID cardholders and their Family members, over 18 years of age, for the safe disposal or recycling of household hazardous waste and residential electronic waste.
