Centering Pregnancy is a program that allows **groups** of 8 to 12 pregnant people, who are all due around the same time, to meet **together** for their prenatal care. Each group lasts 2 hours, you get to see the **same provider** for your prenatal care. The group is led by one Certified Nurse Midwife, Nurse Practitioner, or Physician, plus one Nursing staff member. The usual parts of **prenatal care** are included so you will not miss anything. Centering offers women a chance to **share** their concerns and successes with each other, and provides a **fun** way of learning and interacting that is not possible during clinic encounters. In addition to the many well-researched **benefits** of Centering, you will learn more about pregnancy, parenting, caring for yourself and your family!
