

Course Title: **Basic Rider Course**

Course Number: BRC

School: Army Traffic Safety Training Program - Fort Hood

IMPORTANT NOTE: Effective 25 March 2025. Attendance now requires supervisory approval during registration to attend the course. **As of 20 Nov 2023**, the MSF eCourse completion is now required. You must provide the completion certificate to the instructors. **Effective 01 MAY 2025** Only walk-ons require a supervisor memo to attend.

Description: Motorcycle Safety Foundation Basic Rider Course. Required by AR 385-10, The Army Safety Program.

Notes: Open to Active-Duty Military assigned to/or supported by Ft Hood. Two-day course. Class size maximum is either 6 or 12 students. May be cancelled if contractual minimums are not met to hold class 5 or 11 respectively.

Scheduled normally twice a week.

Class starts at 0700. Building 90074, West Ft. Hood motorcycle driving range on Mohawk Rd (approx. ¼ mile east of the Clarke Rd/Mohawk intersection/traffic light - look for sign on left side of Mohawk (sign is hard to see in early morning darkness – slow down)). Be on time please, class start promptly at 0700. Late arrivals are not accepted into class.

Participant to provide the following (PPE): DOT or Snell approved motorcycle helmet. Eye protection designed to meet or exceed American National Standards Institute Standard Z87.1-2003 for impact resistant eyewear or full-face shield, full fingered gloves, sturdy over the ankle footwear*, durable pants with no holes, no sweat pant material authorized, and long sleeves. Limited number of helmets available.

Check the weather and dress for it.

* Affords protection for the feet and ankles; durable leather or ballistic-type (Kevlar, Spectra, etc.) fabric athletic shoes that cover the ankles are acceptable. (AR385-10 DTD 20250723, 13-16 c. (3).

Course Number: **Advanced Riders Course**

School: Army Traffic Safety Training Program - Fort Hood

Description:

- Motorcycle Safety Foundation Advanced Rider Course. Required by AR 385-10, The Army Safety Program.
- Must be repeated every 5 years

Notes:

- **Effective 25 March 2025.** Attendance now requires supervisory approval during registration to attend the course. **Effective 01 MAY 2025** Only walk-ons require a supervisor memo to attend.
- Open to Active-Duty Military assigned to/or supported by Ft Hood. One-day course.
- Class size maximum 6 students with a minimum of 5 students to hold.
- Class starts at 0700. Building 90074, West Ft. Hood motorcycle driving range on Mohawk Rd (approx. ¼ mile east of the Clark Rd/Mohawk intersection/traffic light - look for sign on left side of Mohawk (sign is hard to see in early morning darkness – slow down)).
- Serviceable Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) must be on.
- **Same dress requirements as for the BRC**
- Be on time please, class start promptly at 0700. Late arrivals are not accepted into class.

Prerequisite:

- Instructor will verify completion of the Motorcycle Safety Foundation by seeing a Basic Rider Course/BRC1 card or a previous MSBRC, ERC/BRC2, or ARC completion card.

At the start of the class, participants must:

- (1) Show a valid motorcycle driver's license,
- (2) Show proof of motorcycle ownership/registration in student's name,
- (3) Show proof of motorcycle insurance in student's name,
- (4) Your motorcycle must pass the following inspection items:

Operating headlight high/low beam; Operating horn; If equipped with turn signals, they must function fully; Operating tail/brake lights; Tires in good condition.

Course Title: **Remedial Driver Training**

Course Number: RDT

School: Army Traffic Safety Training Program - Fort Hood

Description:

- **Effective 25 March 2025.** Attendance now requires supervisory approval during registration to attend the course.
- Remedial Driver Training/Driver Improvement Training. Required IAW AR 385-10, The Army Safety Program.

Notes:

- Time: 0730; Building 90076, West Ft. Hood motorcycle driving range on Mohawk Rd (approx. ¼ mile east of the Clark Rd/Mohawk intersection/traffic light - look for sign on left side of Mohawk (sign is hard to see in early morning darkness – slow down)).

Required for a Service Members referred by the US Magistrate for ON-POST traffic violations/accidents while operating a government motor vehicle or POV. Soldiers receiving off-post citations cannot take this on-post course due to legal reasons. The course reinforces positive driving behaviors and is required to avoid loss of installation driving privileges. Eight-hour course. Late arrivals are not accepted into class.
