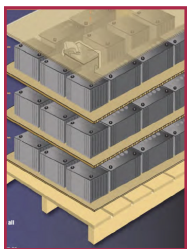

PALLETIZING BATTERIES

- Stack batteries no more than 3 rows high on a pallet.
- Separate rows with 1" of cardboard and secure batteries to the pallet using shrink wrap.
- If cardboard or shrink wrap is not available, bring batteries to the Recycle Center and these materials will be provided.
- Recommend covering terminals with non-conductive caps or tape.



Damaged or leaking batteries must be placed in a closed, leak-proof container made of compatible material and turned in directly to the DPW Classification Unit (CU). Contact the CU prior to turn-in at 254-288-7627.

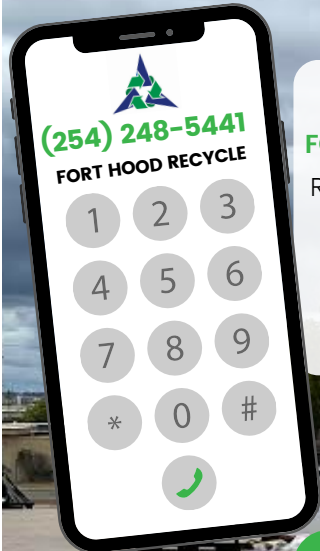
