CLDP I

The primary objective is to provide a comprehensive overview of Garrison operations through interactive discussions with Garrison Directors, Office Chiefs and Supervisors, culminating in team building exercises that focus on developing networking skills/opportunities and basic leadership skills required for the transformational leader.

CLDP II
