

## GI BILL INFORMATION



All new Soldiers have between 180 and 270 days after their BASD to decide whether to opt-in or opt-out of the MGIB. If no selection is made, Soldiers will automatically be enrolled into the MGIB on day 271. Once enrolled, a Soldier cannot dis-enroll so we can provide a GI Bill brief to your Soldiers to help them decide whether to opt-in or opt-out of the MGIB.

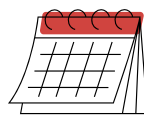
Soldiers interested in enrolling in BSEP must attend our mandatory BSEP brief Mondays @1045

Classes may be held at the Education Center or the unit's footprint as long as the proposed location meets the required standard and provides the necessary equipment. If a class is held at the Education Center, our classrooms can seat a maximum of 20 Soldiers.

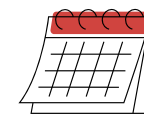
