MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Policy 21-59, Canyon Areas Off Limits After Dark

1. All canyons on Fort Huachuca are off-limits during the hours of darkness.
2. Traveling in and through the installation's canyons during hours of darkness jeopardizes the safety of installation personnel by increasing wildlife encounters and injury risk due to limited visibility. Violations of this policy pose a significant danger to both personnel and property and will not be tolerated.
3. The provisions of this policy pertain to all persons visiting, assigned to, in temporary duty status, or employed on Fort Huachuca and their family members/guests on the installation. This policy is punitive in nature. Military members who fail to abide by this policy are in violation of Article 92 of the Uniform Code of Military Justice. In addition, other persons may be subject to a bar from the installation under 18 USC section 1382.
4. Personnel visiting the canyons and/or recreational areas will sign in/out at the MP station due to events such as inclement weather, increased fire danger, lost or injured personnel, and/or sightings of dangerous or rabid animals.
5. Exceptions to this policy may be requested through the Directorate of Emergency Services, the Family Morale and Welfare Recreation Directorate, or the Directorate of Public Works (Environmental Division). Directorate of Emergency Services must be notified of all approved exceptions.
6. The proponent for this policy is the Directorate of Emergency Services, U.S. Army Garrison (USAG), Fort Huachuca, Arizona 85613-7012.
7. This memorandum supersedes policy memorandum USAG, IMHU-ZA, subject: POLICY 19-20, Canyon Areas Off-Limits After Dark, dated 14 NOV 18.
