

**MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION**

**SUBJECT: POLICY 20-49, Unreasonable Noise**

1. Any unreasonable noise, which disturbs the peace and quiet of Fort Huachuca Community, is considered contrary to good order and discipline and is prohibited.
2. Unreasonable noise may include, but is not limited to, loud music and other sound amplifications, disruptive behavior, and offensive or abusive language. Sounds emitted from vehicles or from items carried by pedestrians such as stereos, radios, and similar devices that can be heard 30-feet from the source or which disturb the peace are also considered unreasonable noise.
3. The provisions of this policy pertain to all persons assigned to, in temporary duty status, or employed on Fort Huachuca and their family members/guests on the installation. This policy is punitive in nature. Failure to follow this policy is a violation of Article 92 Uniform Code of Military Justice or Arizona Revised Statute 13-2904 and may result in imprisonment up to six (6) months and a fine up to \$2500.
4. This policy does not generally apply to mechanical, maintenance, and/or construction noises. The use of power tools, yard maintenance equipment, and similar items by residents or guests of family housing may violate this policy if used in such a manner and at such times as to disturb the level of peace expected in family housing areas.
5. The proponent for this policy is the U.S. Army Garrison, Directorate of Emergency Services.
6. This memorandum supersedes USAG, POLICY 015, Unreasonable Noise.
