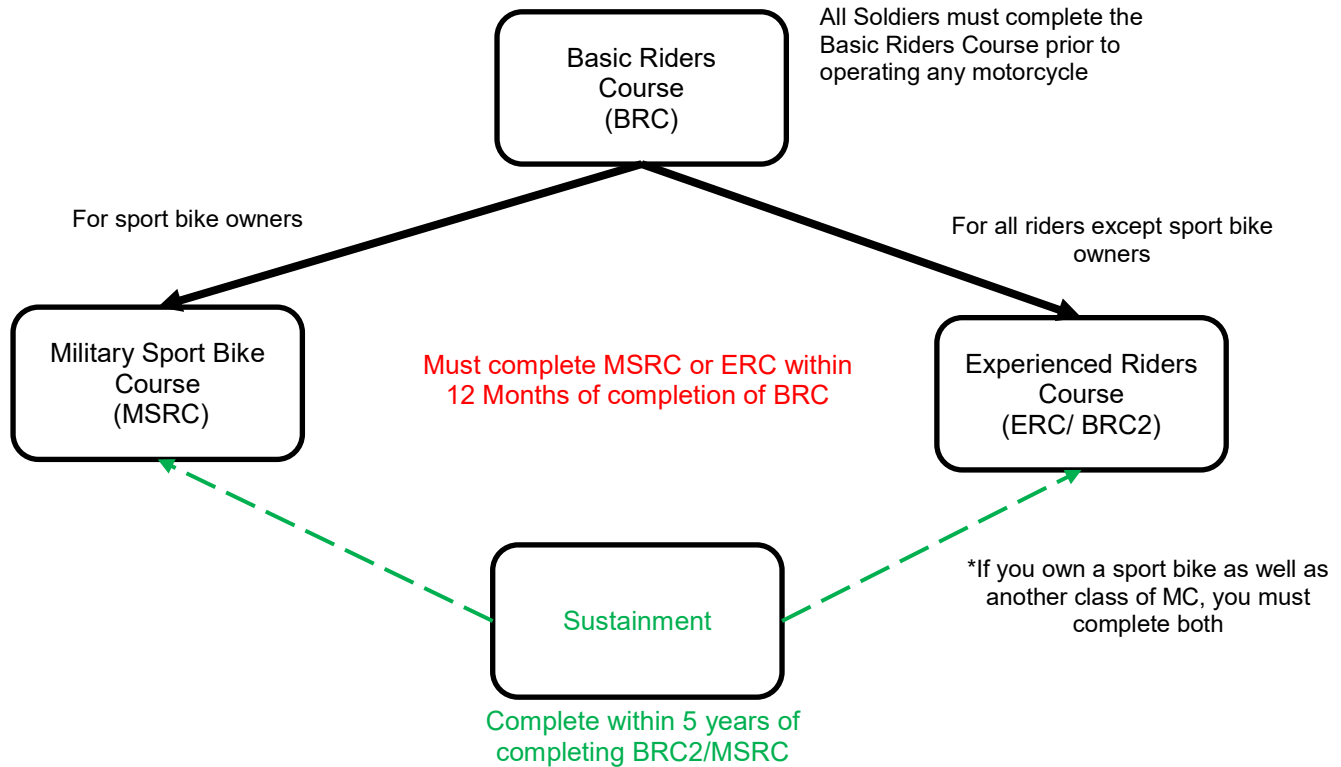

MOTORCYCLE SAFETY

It doesn't get much better for year-round motorcycle (MC) riding than Southern Arizona. It is one of the many reasons I moved here. But whether it's here, Timbuktu or Alaska, keeping the rubber side down and all your parts and pieces in the right place, which is what's important.

What do you need to operate a MC? (1) All personnel who wish to operate a MC on the installation roads, must possess a valid state MC endorsement on their license. No exceptions. (2) If you are a Soldier, you must complete the Army Progressive Motorcycle Program. This program is designed to improve rider's skills in a timely manner. (3) If you are a Soldier, requirements are mandatory both on **and** off the installation, not just on installation roadways. You are a Soldier 24/7!
