SUBJECT: POLICY 20-17 – Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board (AFDCB)

1. REFERENCE. Joint AR 190-24 (Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Boards and Off-Installation Liaison and Operations), 27 July 2006.

2. POLICY. The AFDCB will review reports considered detrimental to the health, welfare, safety, morals, morale, and discipline of the Fort Huachuca community. The AFDCB recommends to the Installation Commander actions to eliminate adverse conditions.

3. PROCEDURES. The AFDCB will meet periodically to review current off-limits establishments/areas and the President of the Board may call special meetings when circumstances warrant. The President of the AFDCB is the Garrison Commander or, in his/her absence, the Deputy Garrison Commander.

4. The AFDCB normally consists of the following voting members:

5. The Board President will appoint a recorder to maintain the minutes of each meeting. Other agencies, organizations, or individuals as designated by the Board President may attend the meetings as nonvoting members. An updated memorandum will be published listing current off-limits establishments and posted on all unit bulletin boards.

6. Commanders of assigned and tenant organizations will ensure all military personnel are aware of off-limits establishments/areas. Military personnel observed in off-limits establishments/areas are subject to disciplinary action under the UCMJ.

7. This memorandum supersedes memorandum, HQ USAICoE, ATZS-CG, 15 October 2019 subject: POLICY 19-17 – Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board (AFDCB).
