Monthly emails sent out. Make sure families are connected with EFMP Navigators for individualized service. Playgroup option discussed with a parent volunteer to keep parents connected to each other.</i></p> <p>Osan Families concerned that they are not getting all the information on playgroups and opportunities: <i>NPSP (Sunny Moon) as a resource at OSAN. Post flyers at various locations. EFMP Navigators. Parent to parent connections.</i></p> <p>Wiggles N Giggles - Library room is too open: <i>Concern of parents chasing their children around the library and possibility of children running out of door and down cement steps: Opportunities for an enclosed room space? Pros and cons of separation of EFMP from other children. Splitting groups for 2 smaller groups? EDIS to speak with Library and OSAN EFMP and NPSP for possibilities of room space.</i></p>
