





Good News:


- + **Inclusion Cup** Participation has been consistently increasing.

MONTGOMERY GI BILL-ACTIVE DUTY (MGIB-AD) SELECTION

S1s/G1s, all newly recruited Regular Army (RA) Soldiers must make an IRREVOCABLE “opt-out” selection from the 38 USC, Chapter 30 Montgomery GI Bill-Active Duty (MGIB-AD) via DD Form 2366 180 days after entering the Army (Basic Active Service Date or BASD) or be automatically enrolled into the education incentive, which will initiate pay deduction.

At 180 days, IPPS-A will notify these Soldiers that they have 90 days to make an IRREVOCABLE “Accept” or “Opt Out Of” election via a DD Form 2366 and uploading it to IPPS-A to complete the selection. If no selection within 90 days, the Soldier will be AUTOMATICALLY enrolled into the MGIB-AD. It is critical that the RA Soldier make an informed decision because there are two types of GI Bill education programs – MGIB-AD and the Post 9/11 GI Bill (PGIB). Both are VA managed education programs. However, in more than 95% of cases, the PGIB is a vastly better education program that has no participation cost; therefore, it is very important the RA Soldier makes the right selection. RA Soldiers can visit their installation's Education Center to educate themselves on each program's nuances or compare them by navigating to the VA website





Tuition Assistance:

- The current Continuing Resolution (CR) ends on 22 March, and funding is available for Tuition Assistance Requests (TAR) prior to this date.
- ACCESS will delete TARs for classes starting 22 March and will continue each day until the government shutdown ends.
- Retroactive TA and CA will not be authorized for courses deleted during shutdown.
- SM are responsible for dropping their classes at their respective colleges/ universities








DPW – Pool Repairs

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Today

Historical Pool Issues:

Average annual maintenance: \$850k

Indoor Pools:

- Sand filtrations system
- Chemical feed system
- Water turbidity
- Tile failure

Outdoor Pool:

- Large-scale water loss – safety issue
- Annual recoating of concrete surfaces
- Annual retiling of the pool surface

Outdoor Pool Repair Work To Date:

- Multiple leaks found in the main drain around the basin of the pool; continuing repairs to various leaks.
- Repair for the leaks within the water drain line is ongoing; early Jun 24, will test swimming pool basin for leaks.

Note: Repair by Replacement project contingent on Project #1 **NOT** locating/mitigating the problem which caused the significant water loss in 2022.

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DPW – Heating and A/C Season Change

- Heating season will be terminated **from 1 Apr to 19 Apr 2024**
- The Air Conditioning turn on target start date for critical buildings, housing areas, including the barracks, is **22-Apr-2024**.
- All facilities on USAG Humphreys will be switched over by **24-May-2024**.

DPW: Traffic Circle at Pacific Victors Ave & American St / Millet Gate ACP

DPW will install a traffic circle at the intersection of Pacific Victors and American Street to improve traffic flow and safety. 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

Personal Transportation Devices (PTDs)

Bicycles, Personal Transportation Devices (PTDs), and Play Vehicles: IAW USFK Regulation 190-1, CH. 7, para. 7-1, 7-2, 7-3, & Section II. Terms.

- **Korean law mandates PTD must comply with the road and traffic regulations that govern motor vehicles.**
- Traffic laws apply to persons **operating or riding a PTD** while on a public roadway, street, bicycle path or any right-of-way **under USFK jurisdiction**. **Operators are required to comply with every rule and regulation on the road.**



Brochures for PTD Vendors, Newcomers Briefs, etc.

- **Personnel operating a PTD must pass the standard motor vehicle driver licensing test and receive a USFK PTD Operator's Permit or a separate endorsement for PTD operations on their USFK Form 134EK.**
- **Personnel must take the U.S. Forces Korea Driver Licensing Course and pass the exam on JKO.**
- **Service members wishing to operate a PTD require counseling and endorsement by a member of their chain of command - The USFK endorsement form (USFK Form 190-1P)**
- **The above requirements do not apply to use of play vehicles intended for use on sidewalks and pathways**
- **Powered or motorized unicycles/monocycles (Ryono, Airwheel or Mobbo), powered or motorized skateboards, hover boards and other powered or motorized devices not equipped with a hand-operated steering device. "Play Vehicles" may not exceed speeds of 20 kph.**

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is required when operating a PTD



3. **Fill your prescriptions.** Make sure you have enough medication to last throughout your move.
4. **Request copies of your medical and dental records.** In preparation for your move, you may need to ask for copies of medical/dental records from any civilian providers, if applicable. For care received at a military hospital or clinic, your electronic health records will transfer to your new duty station.

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
